him if she could come to my office and do it; that I had a typewriter that she could use, and he said "No" that she would have to stay in the office as both he and Mr. White would be in court. I then asked him if he would supervise the work and see that she did it properly, and he said "No" that he knew nothing at all about making transcripts. Then, simply to gratify him, I said "Well, Mr. Watts let her come up here and get some of the papers, and I will direct her how to make the transcript." She came by herself.

Q I didn't quite understand your testimony, did you tell Mr. Watts or Mr. White that you would employ her?

A No, I didn't care to employ her. I had already employed Miss Menefee; she had this work, and I had promised her both transcripts. She did all of my transcript work, and I didn't need any extra help. I reminded him that he had sixty days and that I could have the transcript made in my office in ample time for him to assign errors, long before the time for filing the transcript.

Q Now, we have gotten down to the point where the plaintiff came to your office to get instructions, now tell what transpired?

A Yes, I told her to come, simply because Mr. Watts was so impatient to get the transcript, and it was not convenient to put down the other transcript, and I agreed to it just to gratify him, - agreed to let her begin on it. When she came to my office I got out the papers and selected the bill, the exhibits, the demurrers and the answers. Then I showed her the Code and explained to her ~~and~~ on which side of the paper she must write, and that she must not write be-

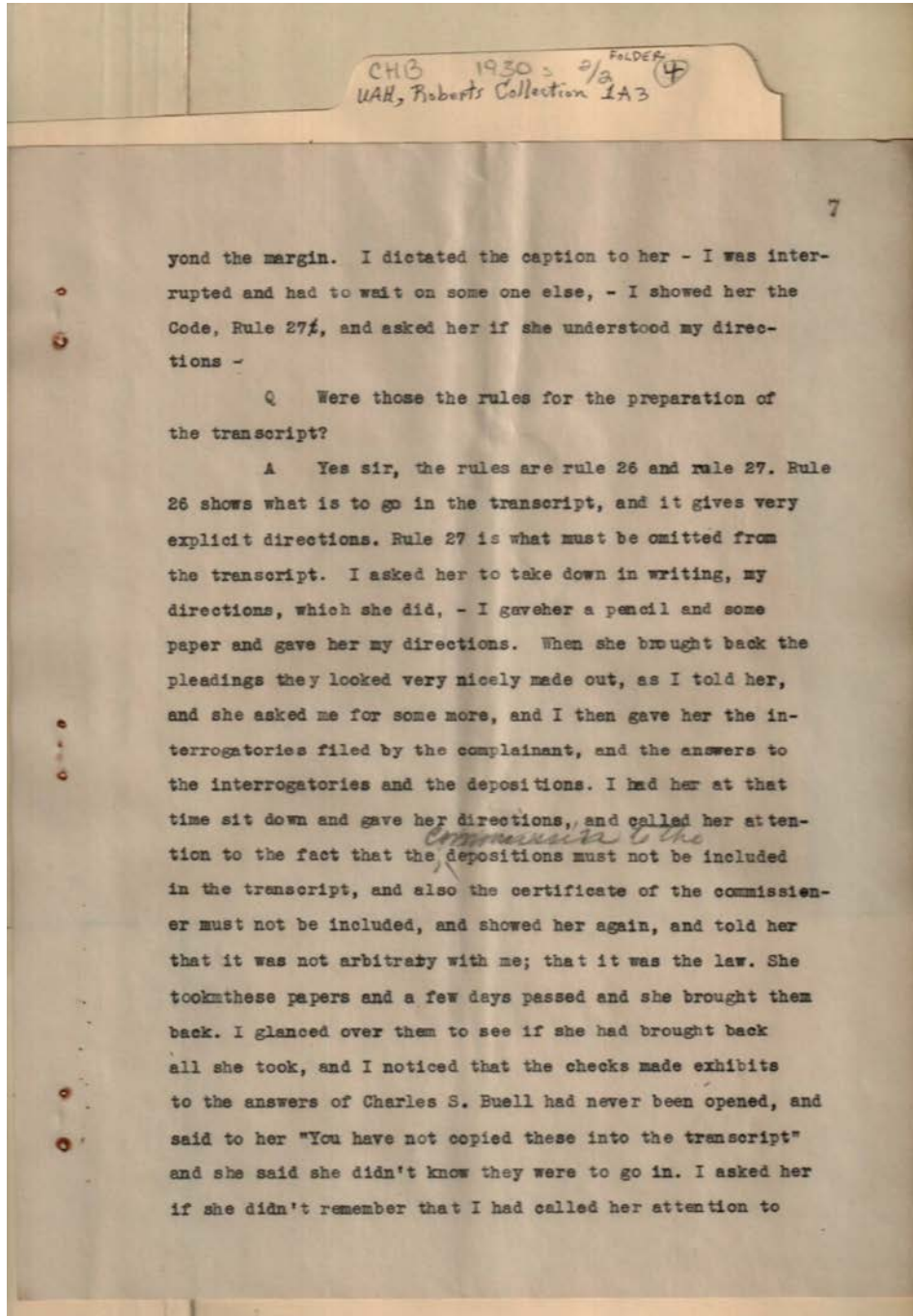

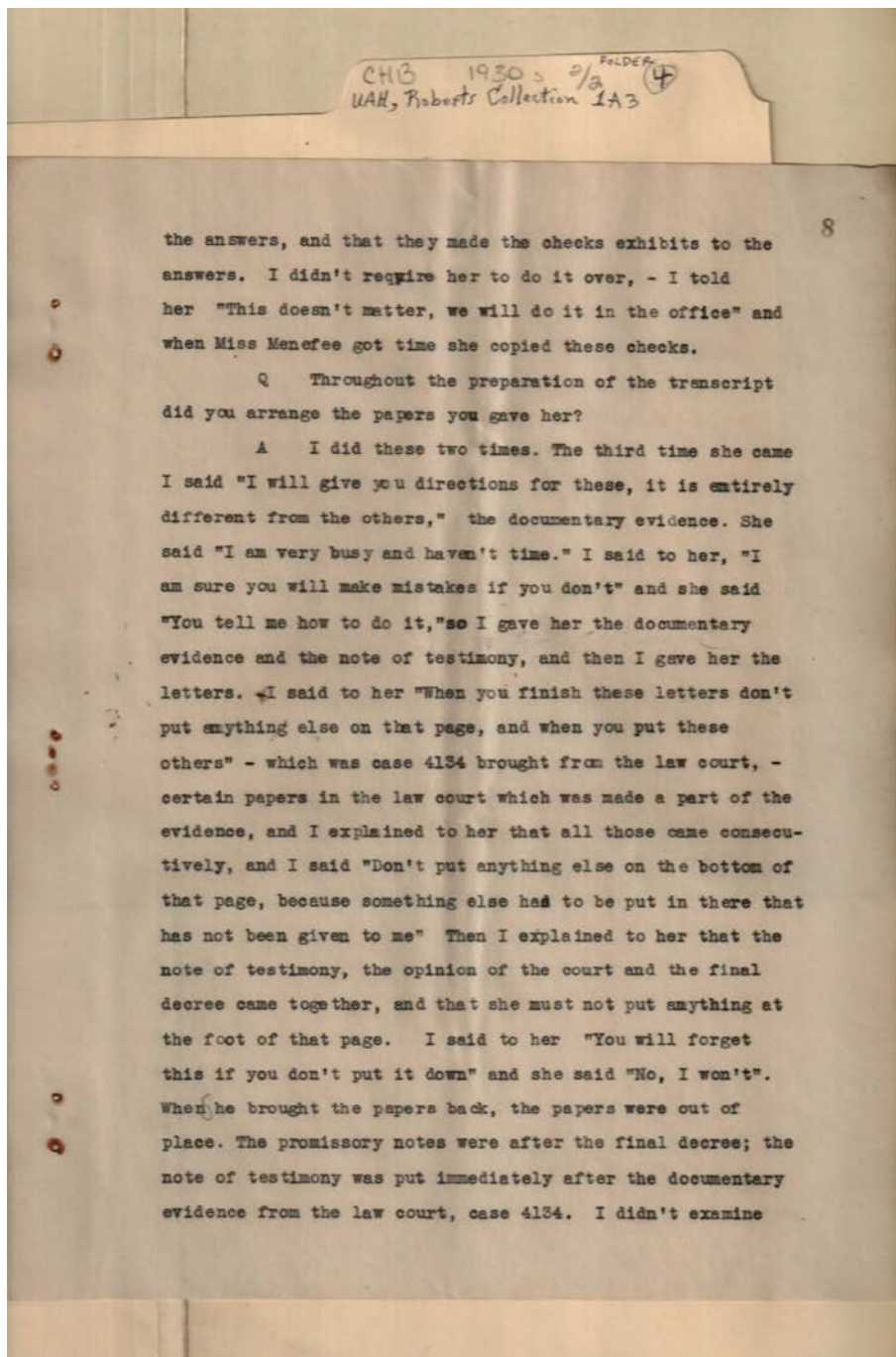

it then as I was ^{my} pushed in the Smith case, and I put it aside and didn't do anything for several days. Finally we went to work on it and I commenced to compare it from the papers and read them all over and found what the discrepancies were, and as far as I could, dovetailed it with our work that was done in our office. What we did, was done on the Royal Typewriter so as to make it as much alike as possible and make it uniform.

Q Did she complete the transcript?

A She did not complete the transcript; she didn't come back for any more papers. I called up finally and asked Mr. Watts if she could correct the mistakes that she had made, and he said that she didn't have time.

Q Did he write you a letter to that effect?

A He didn't write the letter for a week later, or several days later when he was impatient and pushing me to go ahead. I had nearly completed the transcript then.

Q When Miss Everett came to your office to get instructions, did you offer to employ her to make this transcript?

A No.

Q Anything said about compensation?

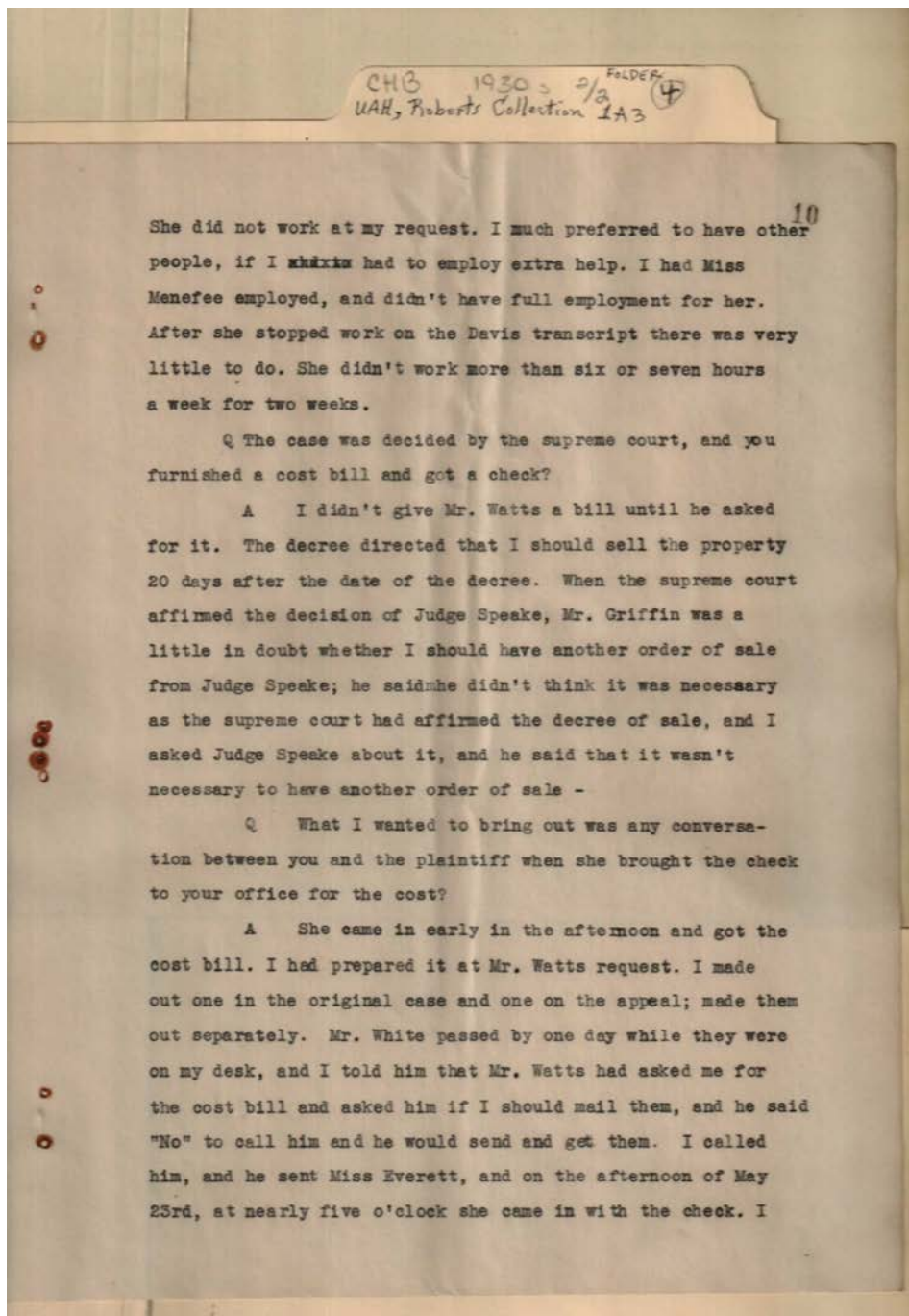

was alone in the office, and I said to her "That is very kind of Mr. Watts to advance me the money on this; I didn't expect him to do it". I told her that I expected his client to pay it. I wrote her a check, and I said "You know I told you" - when she brought back the second installment of the work I said to Miss Everett "I will pay you just as I pay Miss Menefee or any one else who helps me, whenever I get my costs in this case; I don't ^{in it} except you to do this work for nothing." I had never had any conversation with Mr. Watts then as to her compensation. That is all I ever said to her. I didn't pay her because I owed her, simply because I told her I would pay her; that I didn't want any one to work for nothing. When I started to write the check I thought it was worth about \$15.00, but I said to her "As you have had to wait for this, I will pay you \$17.50." When I handed her the check for \$17.50, she

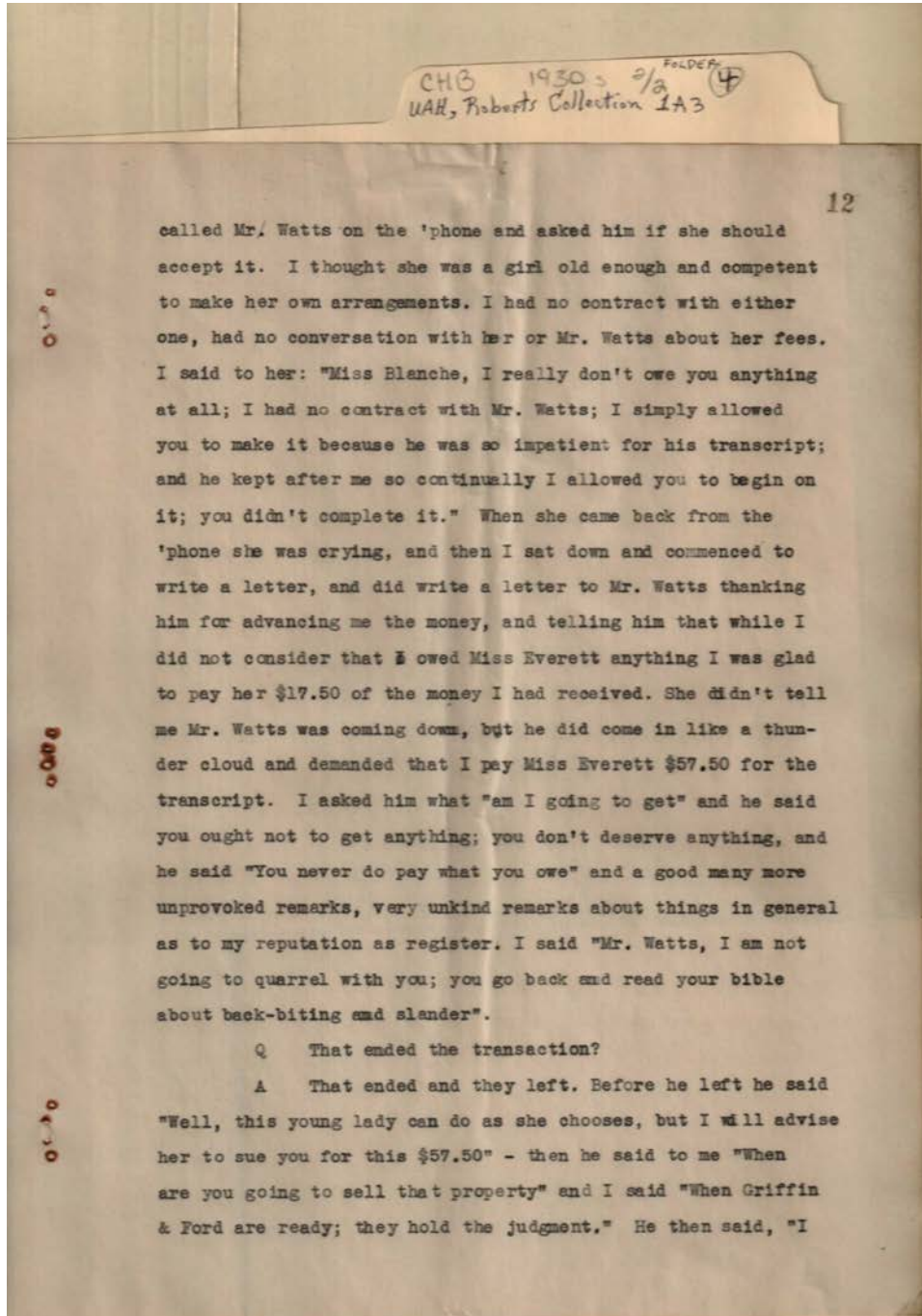

am going to report you to Judge Speake and have you cited for contempt of court, if you don't sell it next week". I said "I am going to follow the directions of the court and sell it."

Q Later, did you make a tender to Miss. Everett?

A After Mr. Watts and Miss Everett left my office I sat down and wrote a letter to Mr. Watts returning Mr. Watts and also enclosing a ^{check} check to Miss Everett, which I had handed to Miss Everett and she refused to accept. I stated in that letter that I considered that \$17.50 was all Miss Everett's work was worth; that no one was entitled to the perquisites, emoluments or fees of the register except myself, and I returned Mr. Watts' check, and enclosed check for Miss. I had no change in the office and I couldn't hand her the cash, because the money was in three twenty dollar and three one dollar bills. As soon as I could leave the office, I called up Mrs. Lowry and asked if she was busy, and went down and explained to her that I wanted to make a tender. He said I brought that witness because I was afraid Miss Everett wouldn't
