Mrs. Connutt would be entitled to hers at once, without becoming of age under a recent act of legislature, which provides, that upon becoming married a woman has all of her rights at law, as if she was 21 years of age, provided she is over 18 years of age. You will find this act, I think on page 938 of the acts of 1892-3 the last session of legislature. I think it is entitled an act for the relief of the disabilities of non-age to married women. I think if you will look at this act that you will see at once that Mrs. Connutt is entitled to receive whatever may be due her, from the estate of her grandmother.
