POSTAL RATES

Postal Rate (Act Oct. 3, 1917)

Effective November 3, 1917.

Drop letters of the first class (i. e., for local delivery), 2 cents per ounce.

Post cards, 2 cents each.

All other mail matter of the first class shall add to the existing rate 1 cent for each ounce or fraction thereof.

Letters written and mailed by soldiers, sailors or marines assigned to duty in a foreign country, engaged in the present war, may be mailed free of postage.

Newspapers and periodicals when mailed by a person not a publisher or his agent, shall have the same rate as heretofore.

Publishers and their agents and shippers of second-class matter, should consult the law for zone rates.
