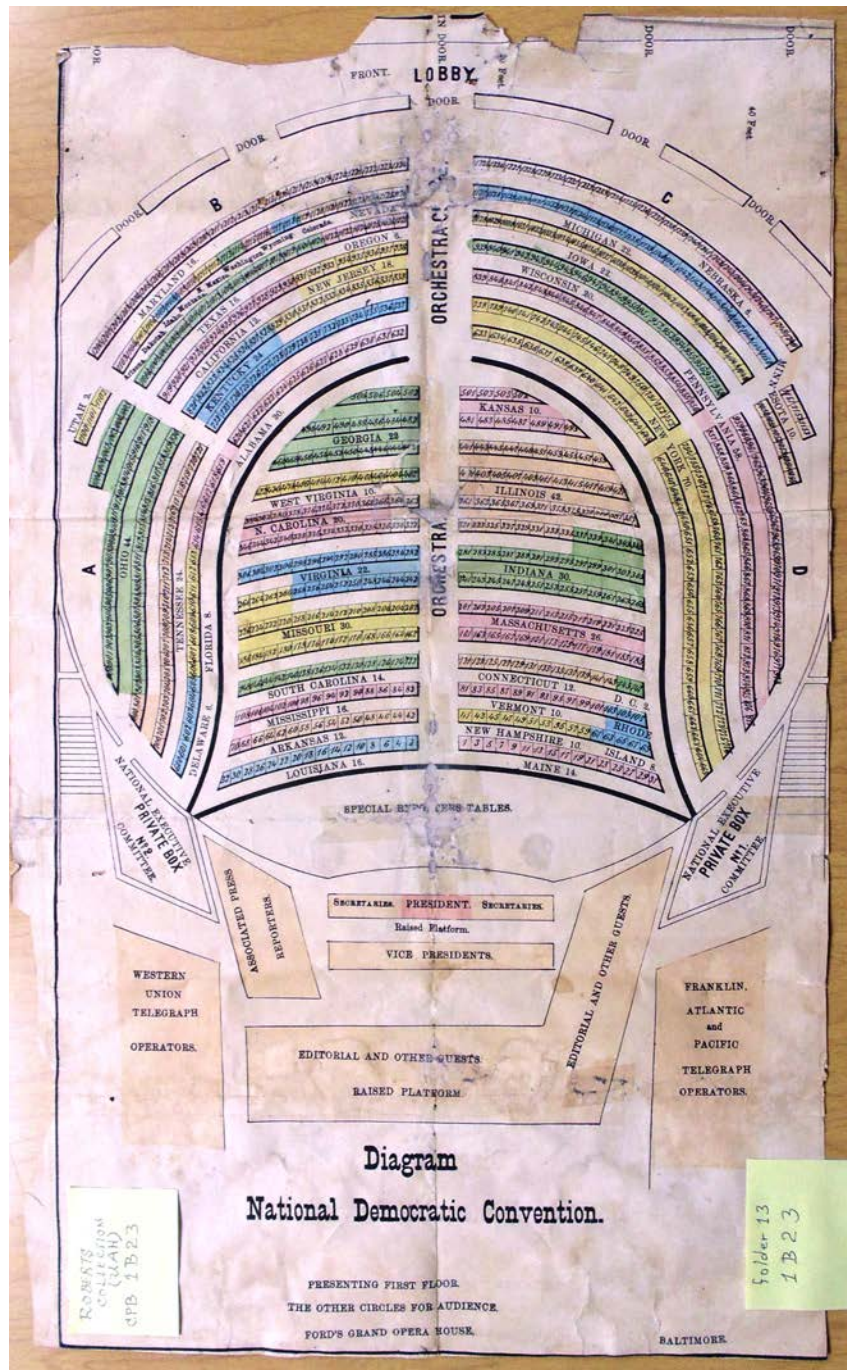

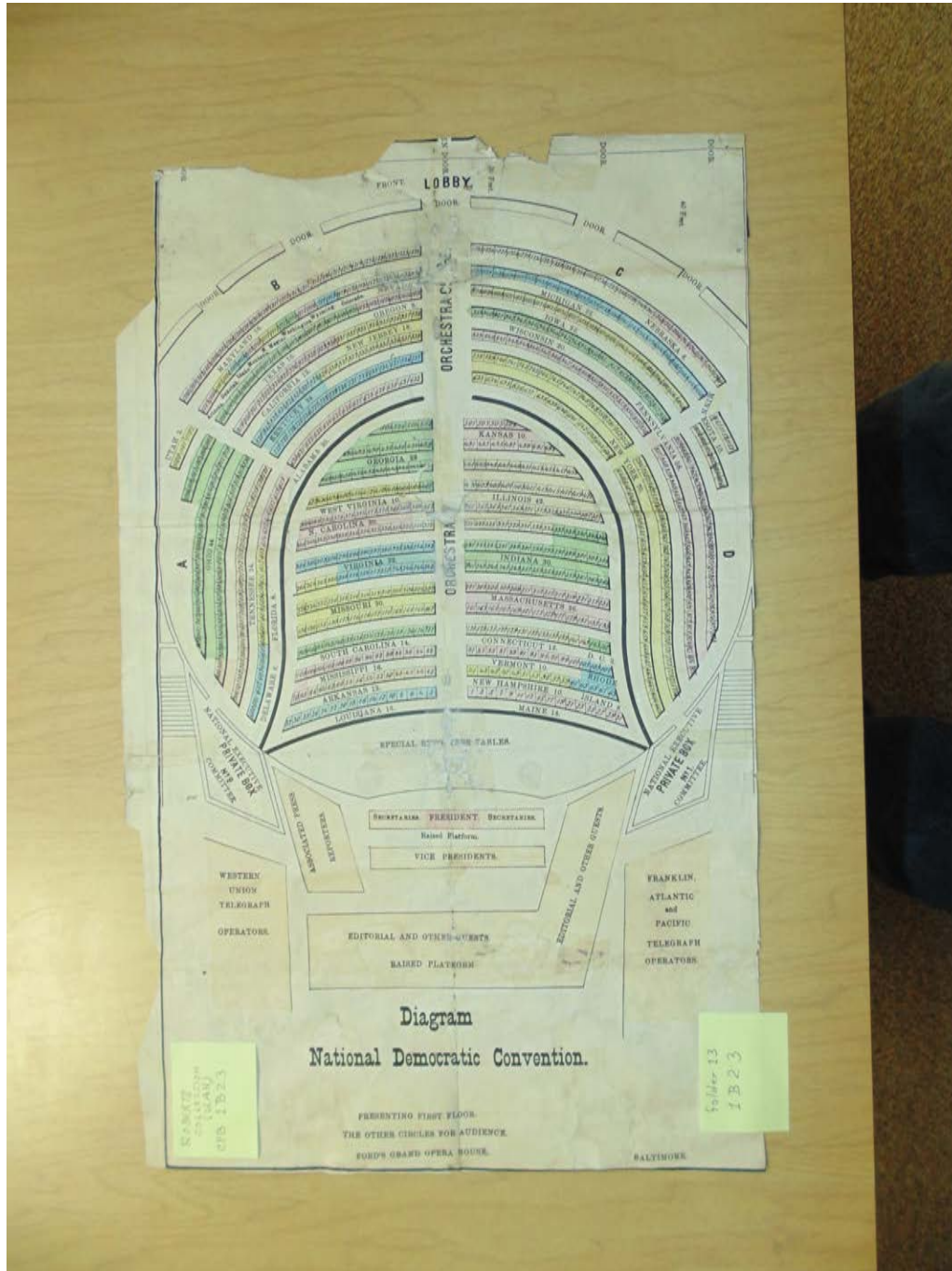

Report of the Committee on Credentials.

Hon. D. D. DYKEMAN, Chairman of the Committee on Credentials. — The Committee on Credentials is now ready to report.

The Secretary then read the report as follows: —

TO THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION AT BALTIMORE ASSEMBLED: — Your Committee on Credentials do respectfully report that on a call of the States they all report their delegations full, with no contested seats; that the total number of delegates entitled to seats in the Convention is 732; that Texas reported twenty delegates, and your committee recommend that they be allowed seats on the floor, but only to cast the eight votes to which she is entitled.

Your committee further recommend that the delegates present from the several Territories be entitled to seats on the floor of the Convention, without any vote.

Your committee, through their Secretary, herewith transmit to the Convention, an accurate and corrected list of the delegates from the several States of the Union.

All of which is now respectfully submitted.
