# CONSOL,

Imported by *E. H. Boardman*, 1835, is now offered to the public, to improve the breed of Horses in the South West; he makes his first season, the present year, commencing 1st March and ending 1st July, at **BOARDMAN'S MILLS**, Madison County, Alabama, 9 miles South West of Huntsville, and 7 miles North East of Triana, at \$600, within the season, or \$70 paid at the end of the year.

**DESCRIPTION.**  
A full bred English Race Horse, imported from England, and bred by the late Mr. Boardman, who was one of the best breeders of the kind in that country. He is of a fine, compact, and powerful build, with a well proportioned head, large eyes, and a strong, muscular neck. His legs are clean, and his feet are hard and well shaped. He is a true English Race Horse, and is well adapted for the purpose of improving the breed of Horses in the South West.

He has been bred by the late Mr. Boardman, who was one of the best breeders of the kind in that country.
