IN THE MATTER OF _____ BANKRUPT.

11. B.—When the Name and Residence (or either) of any Maker, Endorser, or Holder of any Bill or Note, be, are Unknown, the fact must be stated, and also the Name, Residence, and Occupation of the Last Holder known to the Petitioner. The Debt due to each Creditor must be stated in full, and any claim by way of set-off stated in the balance of Property.
