DEAR MADAM:

In the matter of your claim for widow's pension under the Act of June 27, 1890, there is required the following evidence:

1. Your statement, under oath, showing the CHARACTER, LOCATION, AND VALUE OF ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL, OR MIXED, owned by you, or in which you have any interest, and the full amount of your income per month from all sources since 1904 and whether any person has been legally bound to provide for your support, and your means of support.

In making the required statement you will understand that by real property is meant land and dwelling houses or other improvements; personal property will include household furniture and any investments bearing interest. In the event that you own any real property your statement should show the amount of rent derived therefrom, if any; in the event that you derive any income from invested money your statement should show the amount of such investment, the nature of the same, and the amount derived therefrom.

2. Testimony of two credible witnesses showing the CHARACTER, LOCATION, AND VALUE OF ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL, OR MIXED, owned by you, or in which you have had any interest since 1904 and also the AMOUNT OF YOUR INCOME FROM ALL SOURCES and your means of support since the above date.

3. In the event that you have disposed of any real estate since 1904 a transcript from the public records should be furnished showing the date of such transfer, to whom made, and for what consideration.

4. A duly verified statement from the officer having custody of the tax records, describing all taxable property borne on the rolls in YOUR NAME OR THAT OF SOLDIER for the year 1905 showing the assessed value of such property, and the ratio which such assessed value bears to the cash or selling value. If such officer has an official seal the same should be impressed upon his certificate. In the event that he has no official seal by which to authenticate his certificate he should appear before a Notary Public or other civil officer having a seal and make oath to his statement.

If any property shown in the certificate of the officer as being assessed in your name or that of the soldier is encumbered by mortgage or otherwise, there should be filed a duly authenticated transcript from the public record of such encumbrance, showing the property covered thereby and the amount of such encumbrance.

We enclose forms for the above called for evidence (other than the certificate of officer in charge of tax records) and would impress upon you the importance of furnishing the same, and that called for by any other circular letter herewith, as soon as possible, in order that your claim may be completed and placed in condition for favorable official action.

## SPANISH WAR.

Extra Pay! Arrears of Pay!

### NEW LAWS.

**EXTRA PAY.**—Due (1) Naval Reserves, Marines, Revenue Marine, and others, both officers and men, serving in the temporary force of the Navy; (2) Regulars enlisted or re-enlisted in the Army from April 26 to October 26, 1898, and since discharged; (3) the Astor Battery; (4) Volunteers discharged with or without preliminary furlough and without extra pay, before or since January 12, 1899; (5) heirs or legal representatives of volunteers who died in the military service; (6) Volunteers transferred to the Hospital Corps or otherwise to the Regular Army. (Acts of March 3, 1899; decisions of February 28, 1899, March 17 and 27, 1899.)

**ARREARS OF PAY.**—Due (1) volunteer companies from formation, before assembly at State, regimental or battalion rendezvous; (2) if U. S. pay for period before muster refused because paid by the State for the period; (3) if amount of State pay for period before muster deducted from U. S. pay; (4) due company and regimental officers of special or immune regiments from reporting of company at rendezvous or from muster of regiment, respectively; (5) officers of temporary naval force, for period *to* on date of actual entry on duty. (Acts of July 1, 1898, and March 3, 1899; Comptroller's decision, January 11, 1899.)

**FINES REFUNDED.**—All fines or forfeitures imposed by summary court-martial, from April 21, 1898, to August 16, 1898, inclusive, may be recovered. (General Order 174, A. G. O., November 2, 1898.)

**REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRANSPORTATION AND BURIAL EXPENSES.**—If since January 1, 1898, the remains of deceased officers, enlisted men, contract surgeons, or trained

nurses, dying in U. S. employ away from home, have been transported home and buried at private expense, limited reimbursement can now be collected. (Acts of March 3, 1866.)
