Item 15 After the execution & removal of the
aforesaid legacies of the first class, whose
names are mentioned in item 4 & also in
item 3, I wish my executor to apply from
time to time, so much of said residuary

The first class should not be considered as being
incorporated, should again become class, it shall be
extended for them or as much thereof as shall re-
main unexpended, is to be distributed as a part of
