Dear Sir - I inclose a letter rec'd to day from Dr Natchez - so as you may think best about the matter - remembering that she will expect the \$200 guaranteed by Browne, a satisfaction ~~to~~ I would like to see of the decree for favor of Complainants against Natchez in case 256, and hope for satisfaction of the Circuit Court judgment transmitted by W. R. L. to J. W. R. Larkin dec'd in Henry Answer in case of compromise & costs of suit -

It is but just that it should be accorded. The land was put on Natchez at about double its value - Geo. Larkin & myself \$1506. of Compts separate ^{estate} and \$409. got of Snodgrass under that compromise. Mrs N. would get only 200\$, unless land should bring more ^{than \$200 in market} than enough to pay Snodgrass & costs of suit; and invol claim on her insolvent husband - The latter might however be of use to her many days since if her husband should fall then to an estate -

Under the authority you read at last term, Geo Larkin and Natchez are unquestionably bound to her for the \$1506 -

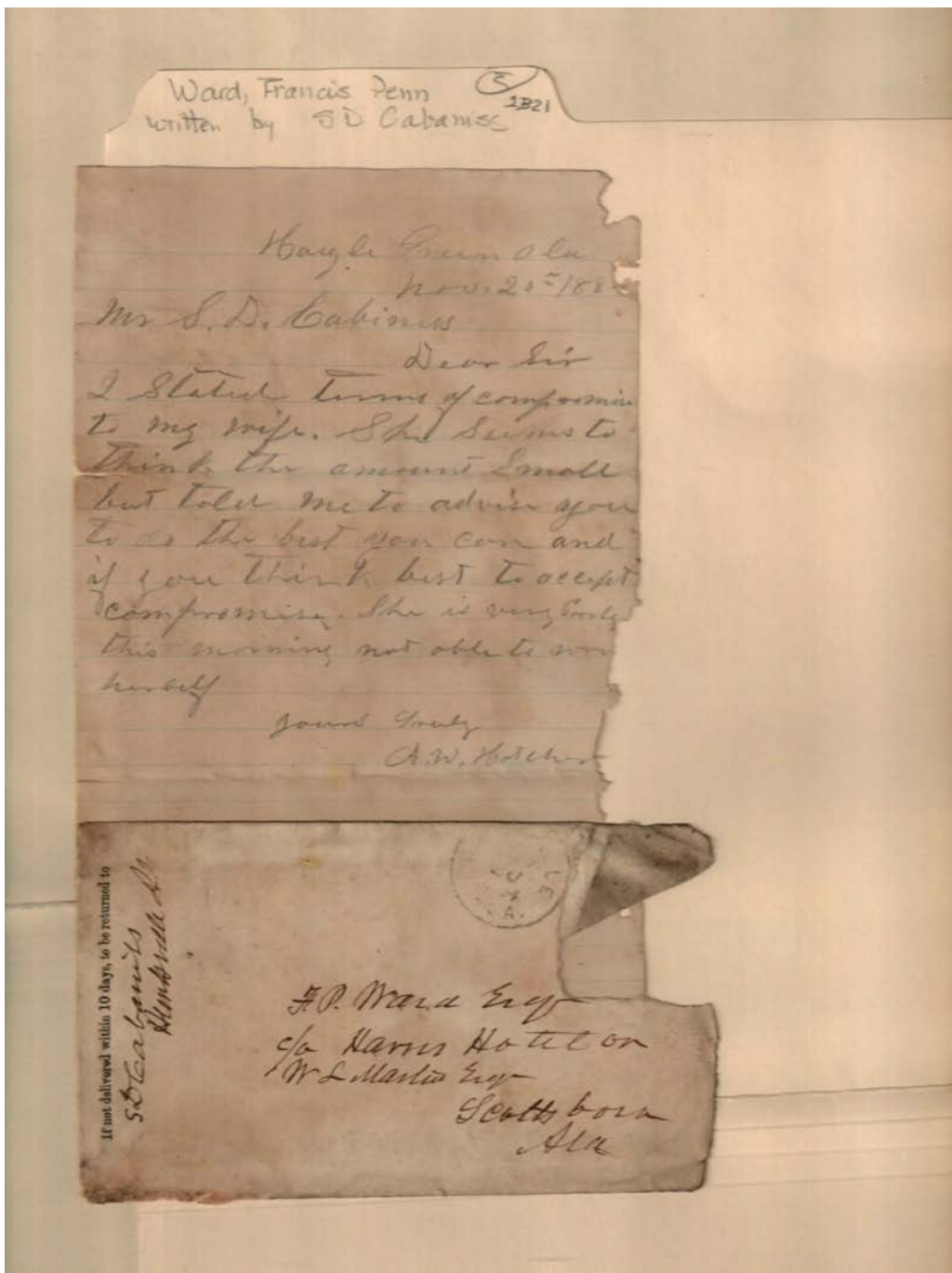
