Dear Billy I now rest myself  
to drop you a few lines which leave me and  
the old Lamm both well and I hope when the  
boys come to home they will find you all right  
I will Billy when I return home I commens  
set myself on Tuesday and when I was gone  
to move and pack myself down to William Lane's  
Haile who bought my Lamm and up he was  
gone and smoked all my things that belonged  
to him and left the place and says that he will  
not have it. He has been trying to get me to take  
the Lamm back two or three times and I would not  
as for he has paid me three hundred dollars on  
the first payment and there is two hundred and  
the first day of January and seven hundred and  
fifty will be due the first day of January 1863  
and seven hundred and fifty and the first  
day of January 1864 which he has give me a  
Deed of Trust upon the Land to secure  
the payment of the balance of the purchase  
money which is seventeen hundred dollars to  
be paid in three payments there is two hundred  
and fifty and the other two payments of seven  
hundred each and annually until Billy I want  
you to give to G. D. Cabaniss or B. B. Brickel  
or some good lawyer or James Robinson and  
ask them what will be the right way to proceed  
on the Deed of Trust I would like a right to  
the Land and he moved on the Land and went  
to work on the Land and now the first payment  
is due two hundred dollars now I want to see  
if it would be right to roll the Land on the  
first note or I want until all the notes are  
and I am in possession of the Land I have  
never a room to live in until I get my busi-  
ness all settled and before he would pay the  
balance on the Land he moved off and left  
the note Billy gave quick and get me under

the Lawyer that he shall executed by notes  
to me for the amount of seventeen hundred  
dollar in three notes one one the first day of  
Jan 1862 for two hundred dollar and one one  
the first of Jan 1863 for seven hundred and fifty  
dollar and one one the first of Jan 1864 for  
seven hundred and fifty for the land and I  
make him a right to the Land and give him  
one room of his house and give him up  
the plantation to grow to work on and he  
come a live on the Land one month or  
more and asked me two or three times to  
take it back and I would not do it and he  
has left it and I want to see now what to do  
the way to give me two thousand dollar  
for two hundred acre and paid me three  
hundred down and give him notes for the  
balance of the two thousand which is seventeen  
hundred dollar now Biller gave to some  
good Lawyer now a Jack leg Lawyer and let  
them read this letter and then let them write  
to me with what to do and I will  
pay them for their counsel
