executrix prior to the filing of the bill had taken possession in her right as executrix.

3. The bill does not show that complainant has ever filed an inventory.
4. The bill does not show what claims exist against said estate.
5. The bill does not show that the claims referred to by the executrix were ever legally presented to the executrix, or filed in court in such a way as to avoid the statute of non-claims.
6. The bill does not show that the claims referred to were not barred by the statute of non-claims.
7. The bill does not aver that the estate has no real estate which in equity should first be appropriated to the payment of its debts.
8. The bill on its face shows that the executrix has been guilty of laches.
9. The bill on its face shows the creditors, if any, have been guilty of laches.
10. The bill on its face shows that the complainant is not the real party in interest.
11. The bill shows great laches and it does not aver that there had not been enough personal property of said estate with which to pay its debts.
12. The bill does not show that the estate has no other real estate with which the debts might be paid.
13. The bill is one by the executrix and does not aver that she ever took possession of the real estate against herself in her individual capacity, and the bill shows that she is presumed to be in possession in her individual capacity.
14. The bill does not show that inventories have been filed and that the properties have been appraised.
15. The bill shows only conclusions of the pleader and does not aver facts from which the court can conclude that it is necessary or proper to appropriate the property in question to the payments of debts.
16. The bill does not set forth the amount of the debts nor the names of creditors nor is any explanation made as to why the application to sell has been so long delayed.
17. The complainant does not offer to do equity.
18. The long delay shows complainant has not come into court with clean hands.
19. The bill does not show that valid claims duly presented exist against said estate. The allegations in the bill being the mere conclusion
