On January 6th our Equity Docket was called, and a case, which has remained on the Docket about ten years, a Bill of Interpleader, was heard by Hon. R. E. Smith, Special Judge, and dismissed, the costs being taxed against the Birmingham Trust and Savings Co. The Money from the sale of Cotton, held by the Farmers Warehouse Co. in storage was sold for 38 cents, and the proceeds, instead of being paid into the registry of the Court, was collected by your Attys, Messrs Cooper & Cooper, and the costs were not paid and the case remained on the Docket term after term, by one pretext or another, until Judge Speake was appointed, and he being unable to act, having been of counsel, Mr. Smith, by agreement of counsel, acted as Special Judge, and ~~the~~ ~~encl~~ ~~with~~ ~~Bill~~ ~~of~~ ~~costs~~ a copy of his Decree is herewith enclosed with Bill of costs. A check for the costs, will be greatly appreciated. The money was collected by Mr. Cooper under an agreement to pay the costs out of the proceeds of the sale of the cotton. I wrote you about it five or six years ago, as soon as I learned of the irregular transaction, but you did not reply to my letter. I was not only deprived of my lawful commissions of one per cent on the amount of the proceeds of the sale, but the Sheriff and I have had to wait all this time for our fees. My Dear Mrs. Owen,

Your letter of January 29th received to day. Several days ago, Mr. Grayson turned over to me what appears to be a valuable hand written book, which appears to be a collection of copies of letters and memoranda, written in 1814 - 16 which he said belonged to Mr. R. E. Spragins, and that he was not willing to have it sent to Montgomery, and that as the Director of Archives and History wanted the book copied by a C.W.A. worker, he asked if I would superintend the work.

In your letter received to day, you offer to pay for material used, but fail to state whether or not you have secured the services of a worker from the Civil Works Administration. You will probably require a special requisition from head quarters. There are several Typist here, who are competent to make the copy, but as I have now, several workers under my supervision, besides my own work to do., I would rather wait until after the 15th of Feb. to take up ~~the~~ this matter, as the manuscript is rather difficult to read, and my office is now too crowded with C.W.A. Workers, to add another desk for your worker. *I would be glad to give my time to it after the 15th*
