Since that hearing two years ago, a piece of property opposite our house was sold for \$6000.00 and that was the price paid for it in 1919 by the owner before the street was paved. In the block below us three houses and lots have been sold without any increase in value. If Mr. White had made the issues something more than increase in

Q What did they do to that Macadam Street in connection with making these alleged improvements?

A Two years ago they commenced improving Randolph Street under an Ordinance which we had passed in 1919. *The area from Lincoln to White St.* Mr. Jones drew the specifications and plans as he admitted *He included his property* awhile ago; but in December 1923 Mr. Jones commenced to put those improvements into effect.
