OBJECTIONS AND DEFENSE TO THE ASSESSMENT PROPOSED TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE PROPERTY OF MISS FANNIE S. CABANISS UNDER ORDINANCE 144 WHICH PROVIDES FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ON CALHOUN STREET.

TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF HUNTSVILLE, ALA:

On December 9, 1925, improvement ordinance No. 144 was adopted and finally passed on February 9, 1926, although a majority of the property owners whose property was affected by that portion of the ordinance pertaining to sidewalks, protested thereto. On June 26, 1926, notice was given that the Assessment Roll was made out and that July 20, 1926 was the day appointed to hear objections to the proposed assessment.

The Assessment Roll shows that the property of Fannie S. Cabaniss has a frontage of 303 feet and assessed with the sum of \$1854.01. Said Assessment Roll fails to show how much of this is for sidewalks and how much for driveway and how much for street paving, and a letter to the City Engineer, Mr. Raymond Jones, mailed on June 29, asking for an itemized statement of said proposed assessment was ignored by Mr. Jones and the different items making up the amount of \$1854.01 is still unknown, consequently the undersigned is unable to put in this objection, the several grounds <sup>of objection</sup> for each item, which may be improperly and illegally charged against her property. An effort was also made by letter to the City Attorney to obtain the desired information to which a courteous reply was made stating that he was not in possession of such information. No estimate of the costs of said improvement has ever been placed on file in the office of the City Clerk for examination and inspection by the property owners as required by law and no time was fixed by the City Council for property owners to protest against the character of the material, the manner of making the same, after the Council had decided which kind of street would be built. On the day appointed for hearing protest for the improvement, viz: Feb. 9, 1926, the Council had not decided on the character of street nor the character of the material nor the manner of making same.

The undersigned objects to the amount of said assessment, intoto, and on the following grounds:

1- That said assessment is not in accordance with the provision and regulations of the <sup>Code</sup> ~~Code~~ of Alabama, being greatly in excess of the actual costs ~~thereof~~ of said improvements and greatly in excess of the increased value of said property by reason of any special benefits derived from said improvement, that the ~~assumption~~ increased value is a mere assumption.

2- That in constructing said street the engineer and the contracting company did not comply with the provision of ordinance No. 144 in this: Said ordinance, par. 1, provides for sidewalks four inches thick and four feet wide. The sidewalk made by <sup>5 feet thick</sup> ~~303 feet~~ abutting on the property of the undersigned has been made and constructed under the orders of the City Engineer ~~FIVE FEET~~ WIDE. Said Engineer, Mr. Raymond Jones, has violated the terms of the ordinance, has disregarded the provisions of the code of Ala., under which municipal improvements are made and in building said sidewalk has not conformed to the regulations nor the rules as set out in the City Code on page 95, Section 127, which provides for the character and materials to be used on Calhoun Street and also regulates the width of the sidewalk.

Less than two years ago, the undersigned appeared before the Board with a petition signed by a majority of the property <sup>owners</sup> in ~~the~~ frontage, asking that said street be graded, guttered and curbed and that the ~~roadway~~ base be improved by cleaning and an application of Tarvia, which improvement would have cost much less, but, no attention whatever was paid to said petition.

The sidewalks, the cost of which is unknown to me has damaged my property instead of improving it. 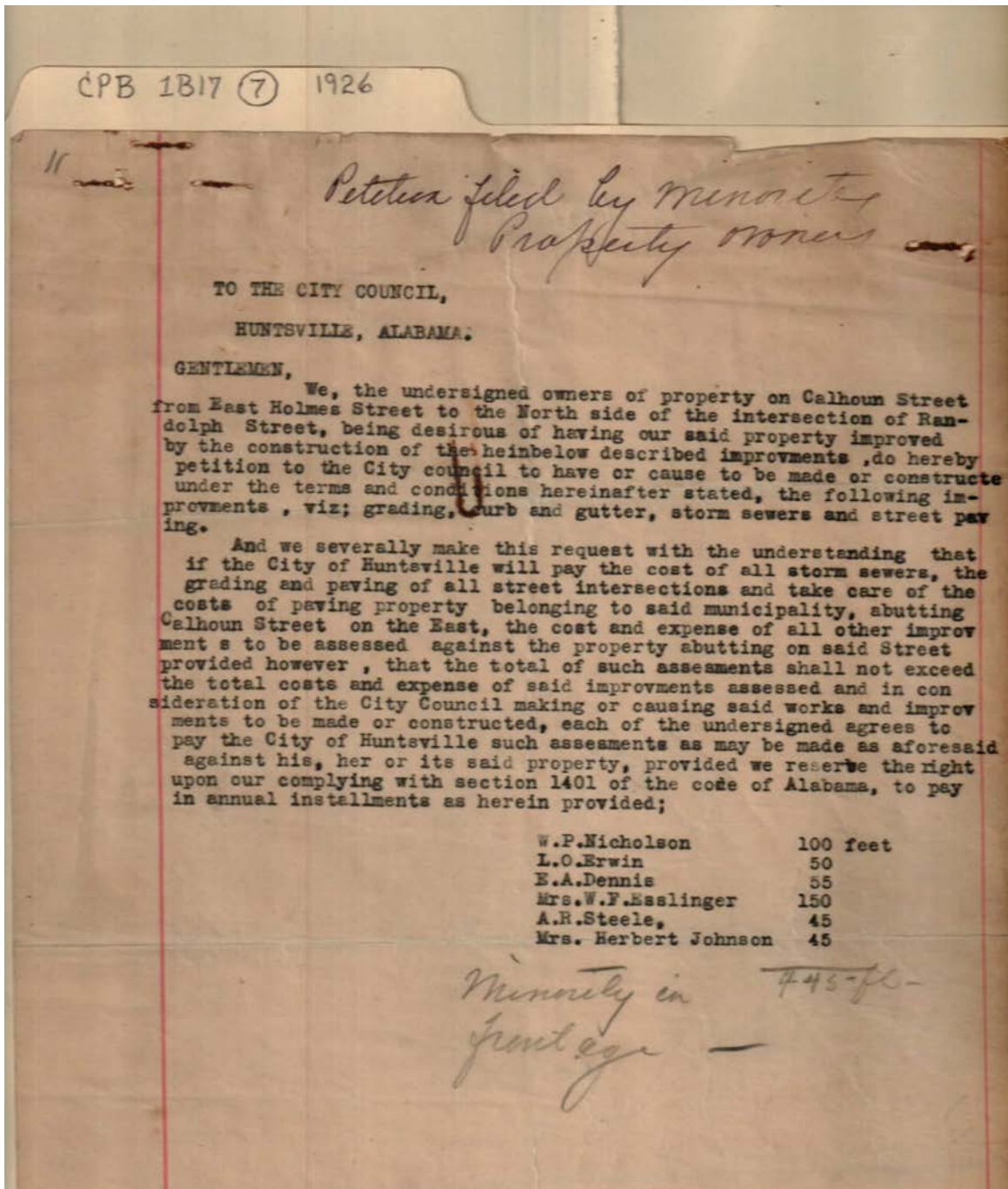

A Protest to Paving Ordinance No. 144. Feb. 9th, 1926.  
To the City Council of Huntsville, Ala.

We, the undersigned owners of property abutting on Calhoun Street, hereby protest and object and remonstrate against the passing of Ordinance No. 144, purporting to Improve Calhoun Street, on the following grounds:

1- Said Ordinance is indefinite and vague in locating the terminals of Calhoun Street, in reciting that Calhoun Street is to be paved from the South line of East Clinton Street, to the North line of Randolph Street or Randolph Avenue. The gentlemen composing the Council seem to be ignorant of the fact that Randolph Street and Randolph Avenue are separate and distinct streets, and that Street and Avenue are not synonymous terms, in respect to Randolph Street as designated in the City Code.

2- We protest to brick sidewalks being replaced with 4 inch concrete Portland cement sidewalks, four feet wide, inasmuch as the brick side walks on Calhoun Street, were laid under a City Ordinance which established the grade, and that said ordinance has not been rescinded. If brick sidewalks are in need of repairs, the City can have the repairs made by giving ten days notice to the property owners, and assessing the costs to the property owners. See City Code, *Page 98-99*  
Brick is much more suitable for the residence portion of the town, on account of shade trees and also for the safety of pedestrians, as they are not frequented by roller skates, scooters and riders of bicycles. They are cooler to walk on in hot weather and are not so dangerous in winter, are more easily repaired with less expense. For a side street of only two short blocks, the brick sidewalks are much more suitable. See page 98 and 99 of the City Code. *Which is the real Code published by authority of City Council for the guidance of the City Officers & Citizens Feb 14/26*

3- We protest and object to the fine Macadam road bed of Calhoun Street being destroyed by the City. It has been in process of being constructed as a macadam street since the years 1843 and 1844, when it was first opened. The depth of this road bed was shown when a storm sewer was built at the intersection of Clinton and Calhoun Streets, *at the time* when Clinton Street was paved in 1925. These two blocks were *that* graded at the time Clinton Street was paved and all Calhoun Street needs now, is to have the trash cleaned off and a good application of Tarvis or other hard surface finish put on to make it equal in every respect

to the intersecting street (Clinton). It would be improvident and extravagant to destroy an old established macadam base to put down the concrete base as has been done on Clinton and Randolph Sts. In connection with this protest we offer for the consideration of the City Council a letter from a member of the State Highway Commission, *made E. Robert H. G. protest* *is a letter to Mr. W. H. Ross* showing that the best roads in the United States are made by putting a hard finish surface on the old macadam road bed, and hope that the opinion of an experienced Engineer may have some weight with the City Council, in determining the character of the improvements to be made which it appears, has not yet been decided.

4- There are no alleys, highways or intersections to be paved on Calhoun Street.

5- In other parts of our town, the property owners have good paved streets and are not taxed with any of the costs of paving. We protest against such unjust discrimination by the governing body of our town, who were elected to represent all classes and all sorts and conditions of men. In refusing to utilize our macadam base, the City not only entails a heavy expense upon us, but wastes what we have already paid for.

6- The protest to the final passage of ordinance 144, because no detail or estimate or specifications of such improvement has been placed on file in the office of the City Clerk as required by law. No estimate of the costs has been placed on file as required by law.

7- We protest to all the various kind of pavements suggested, because the City fixed this day for protesting to the manner, character and material for making said paved street, but has neglected to decide on any one type. Said ordinance fails to describe the type to be used.

8- The Mayor has neglected to advertise for bids, as required by law and the Council has reserved the right to decide until the coming in of the bids. Ample time has been allowed since the adoption of said ordinance to make such decision.

In Re Lamont Sparkman. Motion to quash Fife for collection of costs of suit, taxed against defendant, Lamont Sparkman, Jany.3rd 1927.

In this case Final Decree was rendered Jany.3 1927.

The Decree ordered the Register to issue proper writs for the enforcement of the Decree; If the defendant failed to give the child to its Mother, within five days, from the enrolment of said Decree to issue issue order to the Sheriff to take the child and to deliver her to her Mother; And, that if the costs were not paid, to issue collection of the costs in the order of the Court.

was for defendant to give the child to its Mother and to pay the costs and proper methods for enforcing the orders of the Court were provided by the Court. The Register made out the bill of costs and offered it to defendant's attorney for approval. The Register was told that defendant would appeal the case, and that the costs could not be collected because a supersedeas appeal would be taken by the defendant as soon as the Court fixed the amount, and that said Bond would stay the enforcement of the Decree of Jany.3rd 1927.

The Decree of the Circuit Court was affirmed ~~Sept~~ <sup>April</sup> November 1927. While <sup>appeal</sup> was pending no attempt was made to collect the costs of the <sup>After</sup> suit. ~~At~~ that decision the Register asked defendant for the costs, and gave him an itemized statement of the same, including costs of <sup>at that Term</sup> appeal. No execution was issued, because of promises by the defendant and his father, R.L. Sparkman, to pay what was due without the formality of an execution. After several unavailing efforts to collect the costs <sup>1928</sup> Execution was issued on April 12th against Lamont Sparkman, which the Sheriff returned "No property Found". At the time the execution was stayed in Jany 1927, the defendant by his own testimony on file was well fixed. He owned a tractor and other personal property, which could have been levied on for the costs. The Fi -fa covered the costs that were superseded, set aside and stayed from collection, by the Supersedeas <sup>Costs</sup> and also the costs of the Transcript of the Record on Appeal to the Supreme Court, which was secured by Dr. Chas. Dillard. After the return "no property Found" the Register notified Dr. Dillard Mr. Monroe and Mr. Riddle that Defendant had failed to respond to the execution, and after a long delay, the costs of the Appeal <sup>were</sup> were paid by Dr. Dillard on Sept. 15/28 leaving only ~~the~~ the costs which were due when the appeal was taken by defendant, unpaid. An effort is now being made by the Register for the collection of the costs, the payment of which was stayed by the filing of the supersedeas Bond, amounting to \$70.24.

A motion to quash the Execution against W.P.Monroe and J.M.Riddle, sureties on the supersedeas Bond, is made by defendant's Attorney, R.C.Brickell. The defendant has successfully evaded the payment himself, and now employs counsel to prevent his sureties from paying the debt.

A certified judgment for costs of this suit is on file and recorded in the Probate Court

The defendant's contention seems to be, that the Bond superseded only a portion of the Decree of Jany.3 1927, that it applied only to the possession of the child, and not to the payment of the costs of suit, altho he refused to pay the costs, when he was able financially to pay, because his Bond for \$five Hundred Dollars stayed the execution for the collection of it and his sureties in Jany. 1927, he does not consider his Bond as liable for costs, when the Supreme Court affirmed the Decree of the lower Court.

The defendant claims the right to choose which part of the Decree shall be complied with by him.

The definition of Webster; Supersede to suspend, set aside and stay - A writ of command to suspend the powers of an officer in certain cases, to stay proceedings under another writ.

Supersedeas  
FUNK & Wagnall. A writ or order issued to stay the execution of another order

Supersede. to set aside, suspend, stay and annul, as to supersede a Decree.

A supersedeas Bond can not stay, suspend or set aside something that has not happened. It is purely retroactive in its nature. Its sole purpose is to stay the enforcement of the Decree, which required defendant to deliver possession of the child and to pay the costs, until a higher Court handed down a decision, then if the appeal was wrongfully taken, the former decree had full force and effect, and the sureties on the Bond became liable for the full and complete enforcement of the Decree of Jany.3 1927. Defendant complied only partially to the order of the Court. He delivered possession of the child but has failed to pay the costs, decreed by the Court, and during the pendency of the appeal, has apparently stripped himself of all property upon which the Sheriff could levy for the enforcement of said Final Decree.

The Officers of the Court contend,  
That the sureties on the Supersedeas Bond are liable for the costs, which the Principal, Lamont Sparkman refuses to pay, as decreed by the Court, and for the collection of which, execution was stayed Jany 8/27, the date of appeal.
