Further answering, respondents say that said lands were purchased from one Edd Ikard on Jan. 3, 1921, and as part of the consideration the said Respondents assumed the mortgage in favor of the Prudential Life Insurance Company and paid a large sum in cash, and executed a second mortgage for the remainder of the purchase money, and that the said purchase money mortgage has been paid and satisfied.

Further answering, respondents say that the entire cash payment of the purchase money was paid by them at the time they received a deed of conveyance from Edd Ikard, and that said deed of conveyance, through some mistake contained the name of Harvey C. Green, as a grantee, when it was never intended by the parties that he should take, or receive any interest in said lands, having in no way contributed or paid any of the cash payments upon the purchase price thereof, and having in no way paid or contributed to the payment or satisfaction of the second mortgage, executed as part of the purchase price of said land.

That said respondents paid out of their individual and personal funds the entire cash payment of the purchase price, and paid and satisfied the second mortgage upon said lands executed as part of the purchase price of said lands, and assumed said mortgage in favor of the Prudential Life Insurance Company, and that since the 3rd day of January, 1921, paid out of their individual and personal funds the interest upon said mortgage.

That none of the monies used in making the cash payment upon said lands and for the payment and satisfaction of said second mortgage and for the payment of the interest on the Prudential Life Insurance mortgage was the money of the said Harvey C. Green or any money furnished by him.

That the respondents having paid the entire purchase price and assumed said mortgage in favor of the Prudential Life Insurance Company have a perfect equity in said lands, and are entitled to a resulting trust therein, superior to the claims of the complainants or any other creditors of the said Harvey C. Green.

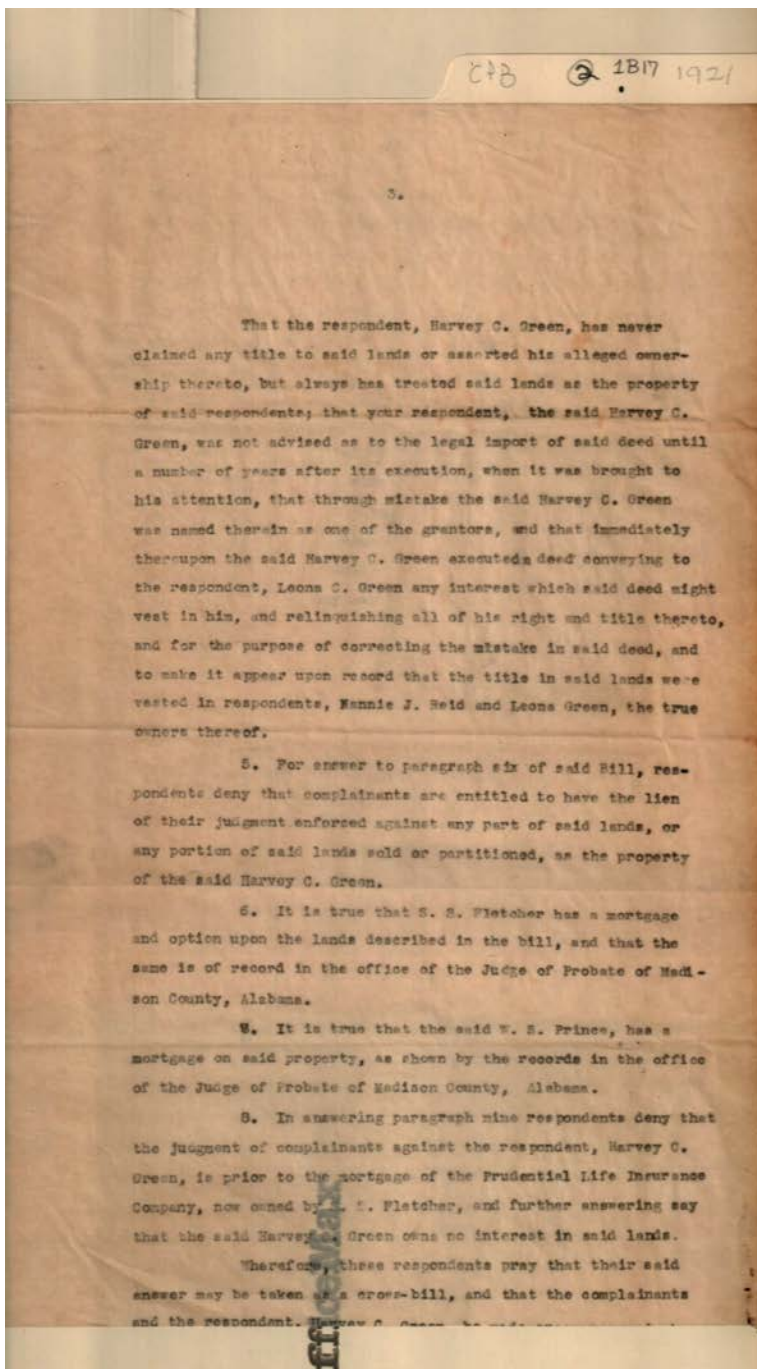

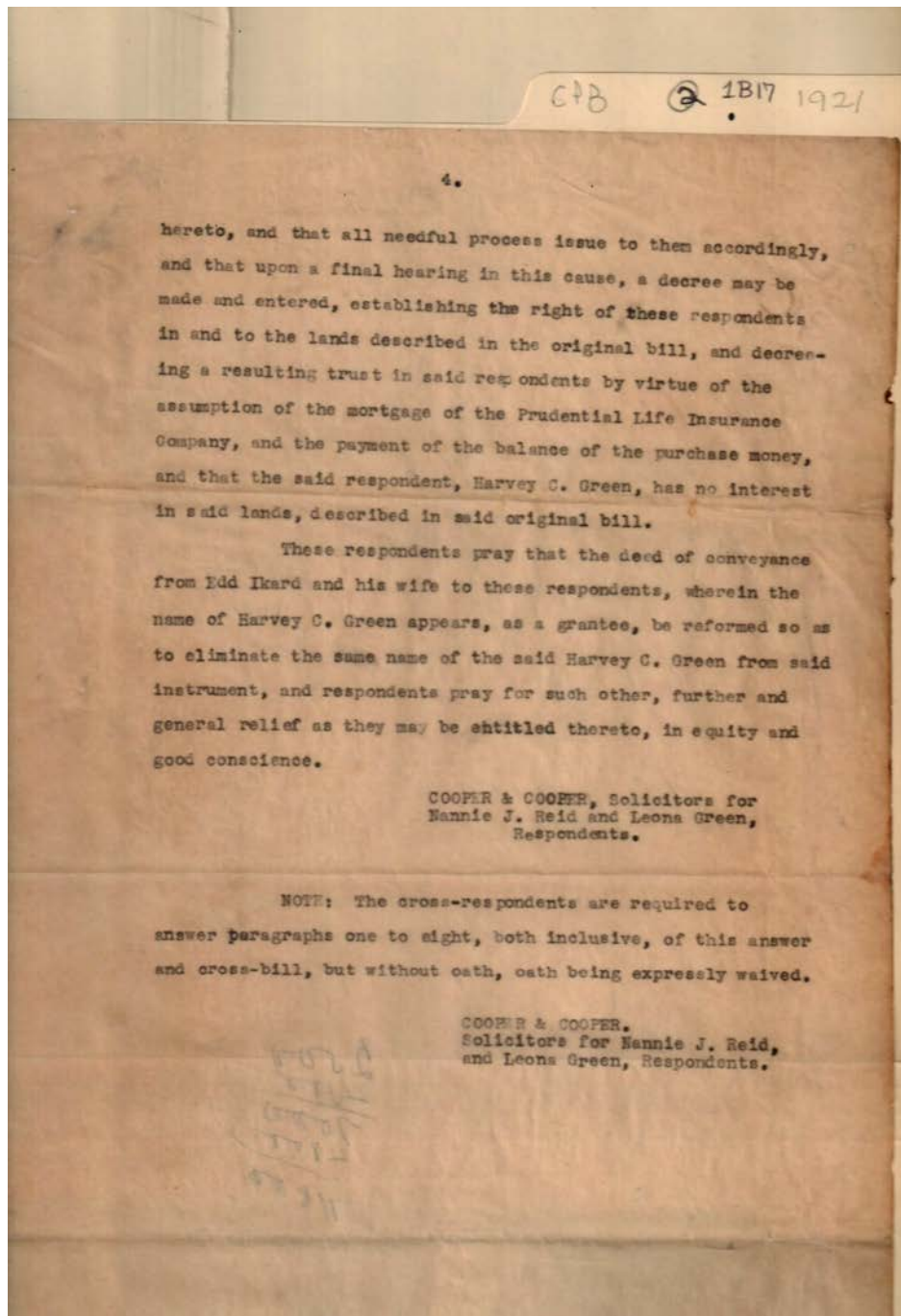

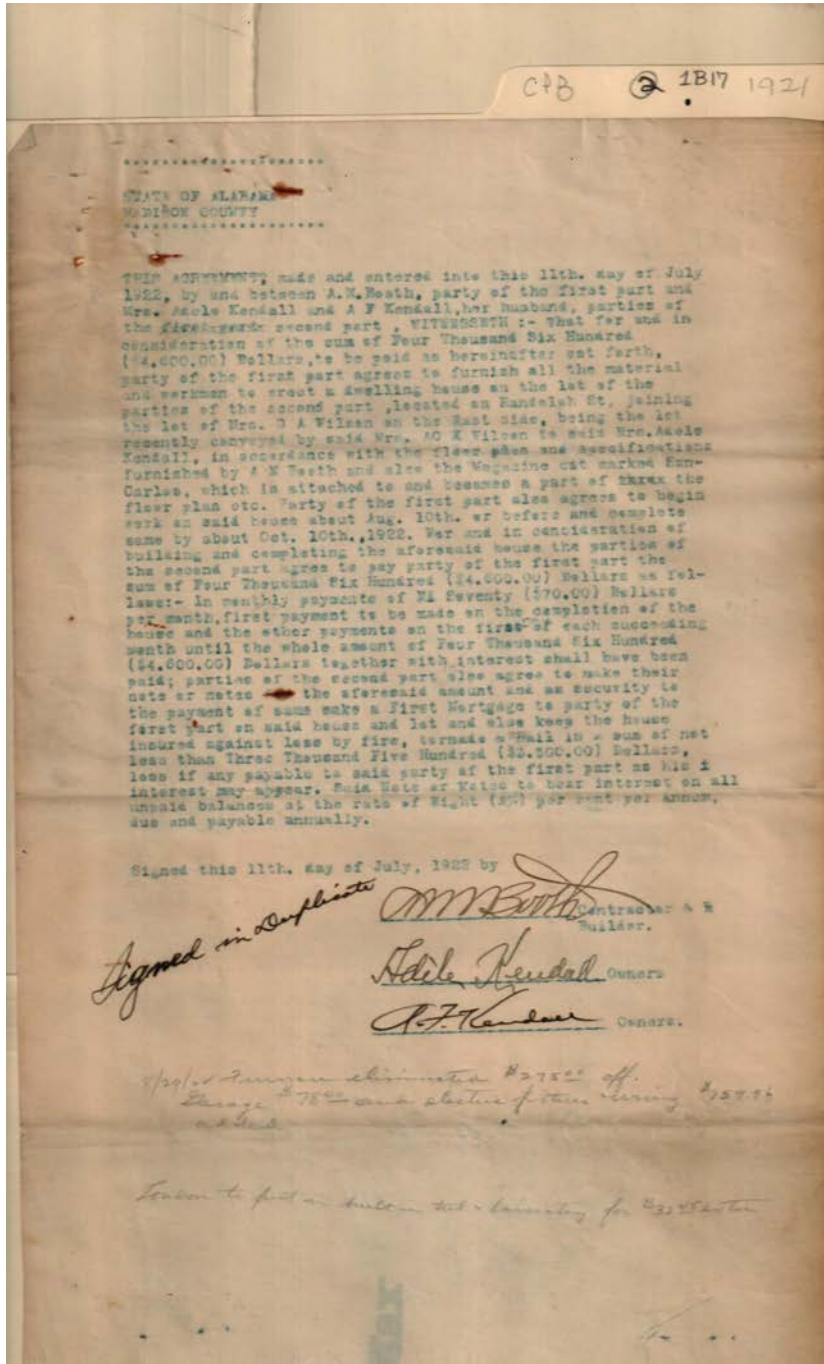

DESCRIPTION FOR A HOUSE TO BE BUILT FOR A F. KENDALL  
By A. W. BOOTH on his lot on N. Randolph St.

**DIMENSIONS of house:**- Front 36'-0", West end or long end 40'-0"  
East end 35'-0"; Front Porch full length of house by 10'  
wide; Back Porch about 8'-0"x10'-0". See Floor plan for  
location of rooms, closets, doors and windows etc.

**FOUNDATION:**- Basement about 12'-0"x14'-0" outside of wall  
and to make 2' clear to floor joist. All other outside  
walls excavated about 6" deep to hard ground, also the  
same for the piers.

**Foundation:**- Walls of concrete 8" thick with a footing 12"  
wide by 6" thick. All inside sills to rest on Concrete  
Piers 6"x12" with Concrete footings 6" thick projecting  
out 2" all around. The average height of foundation  
above top of ground to not over 3'-0".

**Chimney & Flue:**- The chimney to be built as shown on plan  
the body to be 7" brick with 3 Brick Deep run up 12"  
high and taper off to stem size 3 Brick by 2 Brick.  
Furnace and Kitchen flue as shown on plan to be 4" brick  
by 3" brick, the 3 outside walls of furnace flue to be  
lined with extra courses making an 8" wall and the flue  
12"x12", the Kitchen flue will be about 4-x 6", built from  
the basement floor up to 3 courses above nose of roof.  
All brick to kiln run selecting the best for the tops  
and laid in good sharp sand and lime mortar with cement  
addition for the exposed parts; also the exposed part of Kitchen  
Chimney to be the best brick selected.

**WALL VENTILATORS:**- To be 2 in all 12"x12", cast iron.

**Concrete Steps and Basement Floor:**- The steps as shown on  
the plan, rise not over 7" and width of step 12"; and  
wall of front steps 8" thick with Pilaster 12" wide and  
Cap 4" thick by 12" wide with curves as shown in sketch-  
picture of same, these ends and Pilaster of steps to  
be 7" brick same as the porch Pilasters, Columns and Mani-  
sters, the exposed or face brick to be Concrete laid  
back and Cement Plaster on the Steps and Basement Floor  
to have top finish at least 1" thick composed of 1 Part  
Cement to 2 Parts Sharp Sand, the concrete base of  
each to be composed of 7 Parts Crust Gravel, 3 Parts  
of Sand to 1 Part Cement thoroughly mixed.

**CONCRETE BRICK WORK:**- The Pilasters to Front Porch, 4 of them  
as shown to be 24" Brick Square, built up and filled with  
Gravel or Dirt to 10 courses above Floor Line for the  
two at end of steps and up to the Flats for the two at  
the ends thus making the columns. The Columns, Pilas-  
ters and Manisters to have Concrete caps 4" thick and  
projecting 2" on all sides. "NOTE" It is optional  
with the contractor, A. W. Booth whether he use Concrete  
Brick or Concrete Wall up to the Porch Floor Line.

**ALL CONCRETE WALLS** to be finished smooth with Cement coat af-  
ter the forms are removed.

**BRICK MANTEL & HEARTH:**- The mantel in living room to be built  
of Concrete Brick either natural or red color neatly  
set up with hearth to match and have a heavy wood shelf  
and a 24" Portable set with Fire Brick laid in Fire clay.

**PAINTING & WHITENING:**- All walls and ceilings of all rooms,  
halls and closets to be lathed with 1/2" lath then  
have two coats of Cement Plaster, Brown work, then fin-  
ish up with a Skim coat of Lime and Plaster, NOT a HARD  
WHITE Coat.

The Bath room to be finished 4' high with Kenn's Best  
Cement and then blocked off into 24"x36" blocks to imi-  
tate tile.

**CARPENTER WORK:**- Outside or wall sills to be made with 1-x2  
laid flat on wall, 1 1/2"x6" sills set on top of same  
and spike through this into the 2x10 Floor Joist and  
after laying the Sub Floor spike down a 2x4 raising  
or bottom plate for all studding to rest upon.

**CAP-UTER WORK continued-** Floor joist 2x10 set 16" on centers with 1 row X bridging where ever 16 ft. between bearings. Inside sills or girders 6x6 as shown on plan and the sills under outside of beam walls not resting on solid walls but on piers to be 2x8x6x6 with 2x6 spiked on far joist rest where needed. Studing 2x6 -10", sills 1 edge and set 16" on centers, doubled at corners. Top plate 2x4 doubled. Ceiling joist 2x6 set 16" on centers. Rafters 2x6 set 2' centers, rise not less than 1 1/2 ft. Rafters supported by 2x4 curbin slats and 2x4 struts.

**ROOFING-** Sills 2x6 E. L. V. pine. Back porch plate 2x6 and plain and columns 2x4 E. L. V. P., and rafters 2x4 2x6, not nailed. Eave front porch built up as shown in the Magazine picture, ceiling joist 2x4 and all porch floor joist 2x4 set 2' on centers.

**SUB FLOORING-** All sub floors laid with #2 Can. Flooring or boards diagonally across the building.

**FINISHING-** Use 20# Building paper tacked on to studs and then put on 3/4" Better Beveled edge Y. P. Siding showing not over 4" clear of the lap, nailed with cement coated nails. Corner boards 1 1/2x4 1/2" with Cr. Wd. in the angles, and for the angles of walls use angle strips 1 1/2x1 1/2". Siding to cut between all casings of openings and the corner boards.

**ROOF** - Sheath walls with #2 Flooring. Arched side seen over back porch and all roof projections to form the finish of the porch ceiling and the soffit of the cornice.

**CORNICE-** Finish with 2x6 Verge base, up the rake, Rafters points dressed and fascia strip 1x2 for gable and eave; Gable Vridge 1x2" and fill between rafters the same. Support Vridge base with 2x6 brackets set about 2 to each main gable or brackets.

**POOF** covered with Composition Shingles 2x12".

**DRIVING WINDOW** like that shown in the Magazine picture, the valley to be lined with 30" Galv. Iron.

**GARMENT** to be latticed over about 18" and covered inside with 1/2" P. Screen wire as up to let the hot air out of the attic.

**FLOORING-** The top floor of the living and dining rooms to be laid with 3/4x2" Select White Oak Flooring and the other rooms and halls and porch floors laid with #2 Rift Y Pine 3/4" Face Flooring. The Oak flooring sanded smooth to retain the finish of Filler and Floor Varnish and Floor Wax, 1 Ct. of each.

**CEILING-** Front porch ceiling overhead with #2 Can. 1" Cig., and 1" moulding in the angles.

**WINDOWS-** 3 Triple with 30x30-8 lbs in center and 30x30 on each side; 2 wds. 30x30; all 2 lbs. 7" each 3 Vert. Lts. for 20" glass and 3 Vert. Lts. for 20" Glass; 1 Wd. 30x30 3 Lts. 7 1/2" V. Lts. and 1 Wd. 10x20- 7 1/2" V. Lts. 2 Pres. Cement Wds. opening size 2/2x2 1/2"-each each 1/2x2 1/2" 3 Vert. Lts. each. 3 Corner Wash, size 30"x31" O. W. 4 V Lts. each. All 30x30 Glass D. S. and all other glass E. S. All window frames made for hanging windows on weights, with 1 1/2x4" outside casing, 2x4 sills planed for receiving the siding. Inside casing of windows Plain 1x4" with rounded or beveled corners and mitered together. Mesh locks for all but Dormer windows, which of course do not have any inside trim.

**DOORS-** To be as shown and marked on the plans, also size. Outside door jambs to be rabbeted and all inside door J. 7/8" with 1 3/8" steps. Inside Trim of doors same as windows, also the outside casing same as windows. The front door to be 1/2x7/8-1 1/2"-Bottom Rail 1 1/2" with 1 1/2 Lts. Door from living to Hall 2x7 -1 1/2-15 lbs and the doors between living room and dining room to be double each door 2x7-1 3/8 16 lbs to swing back from each side. The door kitchen to back porch 2/10x7/8 and all other 1 1/2x7/8 inside 2/10x7/8-1 3/8 2X Pan. #1 Y Pine and all 1 1/2" cased.

The closet and pantry doors 2/4x6/8-13/8 15 2X Pan Fir; Sills marked on the floor plan. Front door hung on 3-4" butt and other doors hung on 2-3" butts; Front door to have regular Night Lock set and other doors Mortice Locks; the 1 1/2 doors to have Top & Bottom bolts. All finish hardware to be "laid Pull Brass finish.

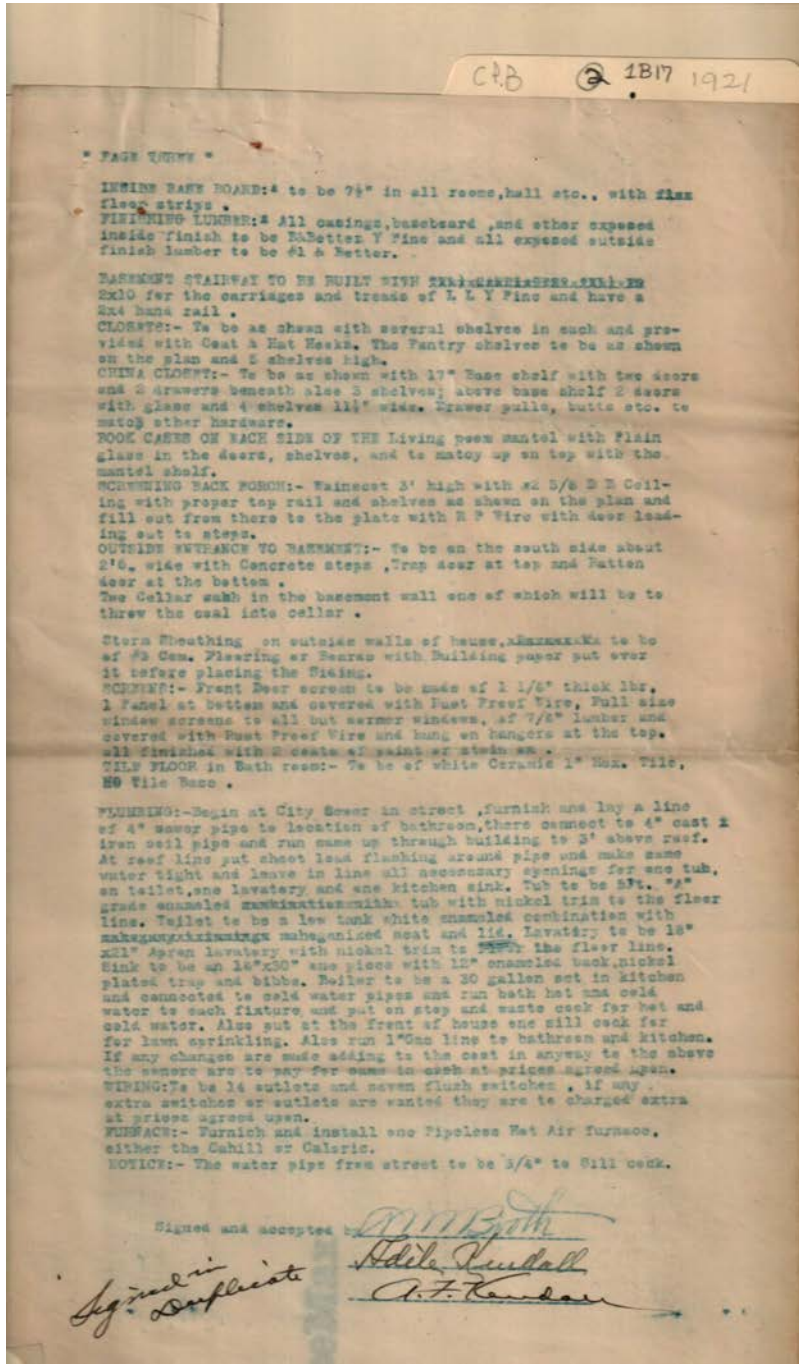

Guttering:- Eye Gutters of proper size with down pipe to the ground and connect with storm sewer if any is put in, this however will be an extra consideration.

PAINTING:- ALL EXTERIOR woodwork to have two coats of True<sup>®</sup> Tagg Paint Co's Paste Paints and Pure Linseed oil in colors to suit the owners.

INTERIOR:- All the trim of windows, doors, baseboard and shelving in Closets, Kitchen & Pantries to have two coats of either paint or stain and hard oil.
