Dear Miss Cabaniss:

In reply to your request of me as Deputy Solicitor, for my opinion as to your duties and liabilities relative to the taxation and collection of the \$3.00 Trial Tax imposed on litigants in your Court by Sec. 4, page 284 Gen. Acts 1918-- I have the honor to advise you as follows:

The language of the Act imposing the tax is as follows:

Sec. 4-- \* That a trial tax of \$3.00 be, and the same hereby is, imposed in each case, civil, criminal, and equity, which hereafter goes upon the docket of any Circuit Court in the state, to be taxed and collected as other costs and when collected to be paid by the Clerk of such Court, into the general funds of the State Treasury. \*

The verbiage of this section is so very plain and unambiguous it scarcely requires an interpretative opinion from me.

The Legislature imposed the tax-- as cost-- and provided that it should be taxed and collected as cost. In as much as the taxation of cost is a judicial function-- you being vested with only ministerial powers in such matters-- have no authority to tax the cost or any part of it against any litigant in your Court.

When a case is docketed in your Court, your only duty under the law, is to perform the clerical act of noting the fact in the proper docket, that a trial tax of \$3.00 is due and collectable therein. No further action with relation thereto is incumbent upon, or proper by, you until the Court has taxed the cost against the parties thereto, or some of them.

It would be unlawful and highly improper for you to require a litigant to pay this \$3.00 trial tax-- as well as any other cost-- as a condition precedent to his right to institute suit. Such would amount to a barter and sale of justice, a denial to the poor and needy of their legal rights in the our Courts. Nor can you attempt to anticipate the judicial action of the Court, by yourself charging this \$3.00 to any of the parties to suits in your Court. Such would be contrary to the spirit and intent of our Laws even tho' you should guess right. The Chancellor has the sound judicial discretion to apportion the cost as he sees fit. until he has acted no fees or costs are taxable or collectable by you from any of the parties to the suit.

By the very language of the Act, this \$3.00 is put in the same class as "other costs". wherefore you can not collect same until taxed.
