parcel of land called for in the Patent from the United States No. Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-six (4866), and dated the 18th. day of August, 1865, and being the lot or parcel of land purchased by E. L. Clay the 10th. day of December, 1868, and recorded in Probate Court in Madison County, February, 8th. 1869, Book J.J. page 398, and being the same land conveyed by E. A. Keenan and Leona Keenan to Sam Fraker, dated the 18th. day of January, 1915, and recorded in Probate Judges Office of Madison County, Alabama, in Deed Book, 103, page 355, containing Forty (40) acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Lucy E. Overton, her heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, appurtenances and hereditaments thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining in fee simple forever, and the said Ambrose E. Overton, party of the first part does hereby warrant and represent unto and covenant with the said Lucy E. Overton, party of the second part, that he is seized and possessed of the above granted premises, and that he has a full and perfect right to sell and convey the same, and the said Ambrose E. Overton, for himself, his heirs, executors or administrators does hereby warrant and represent unto the said Lucy E. Overton, her heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from any incumbrances except the two mortgages set out above, and that he will forever warrant and defend the title to the above granted premises against the lawful claims or demands of all persons whomsoever.
