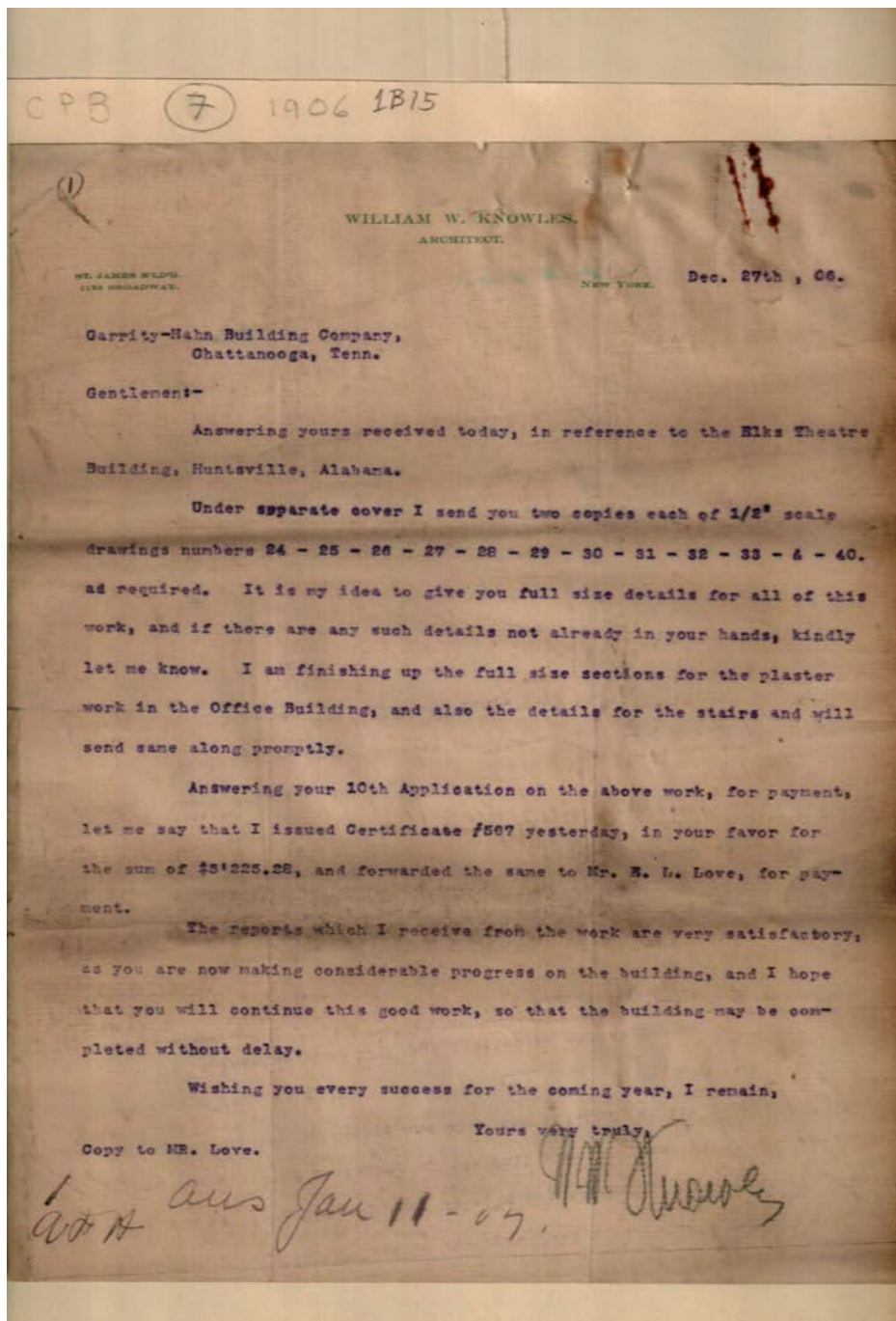

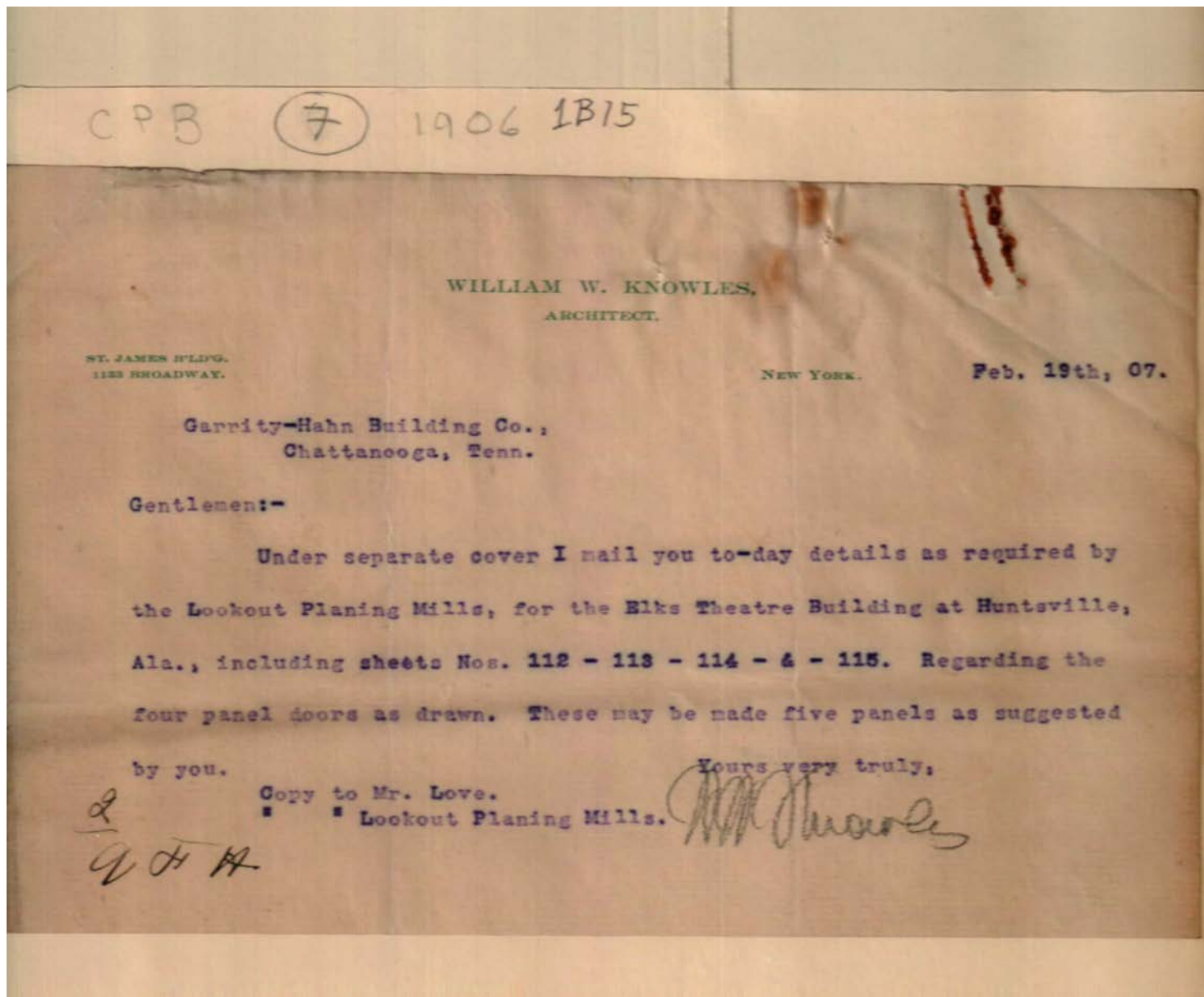

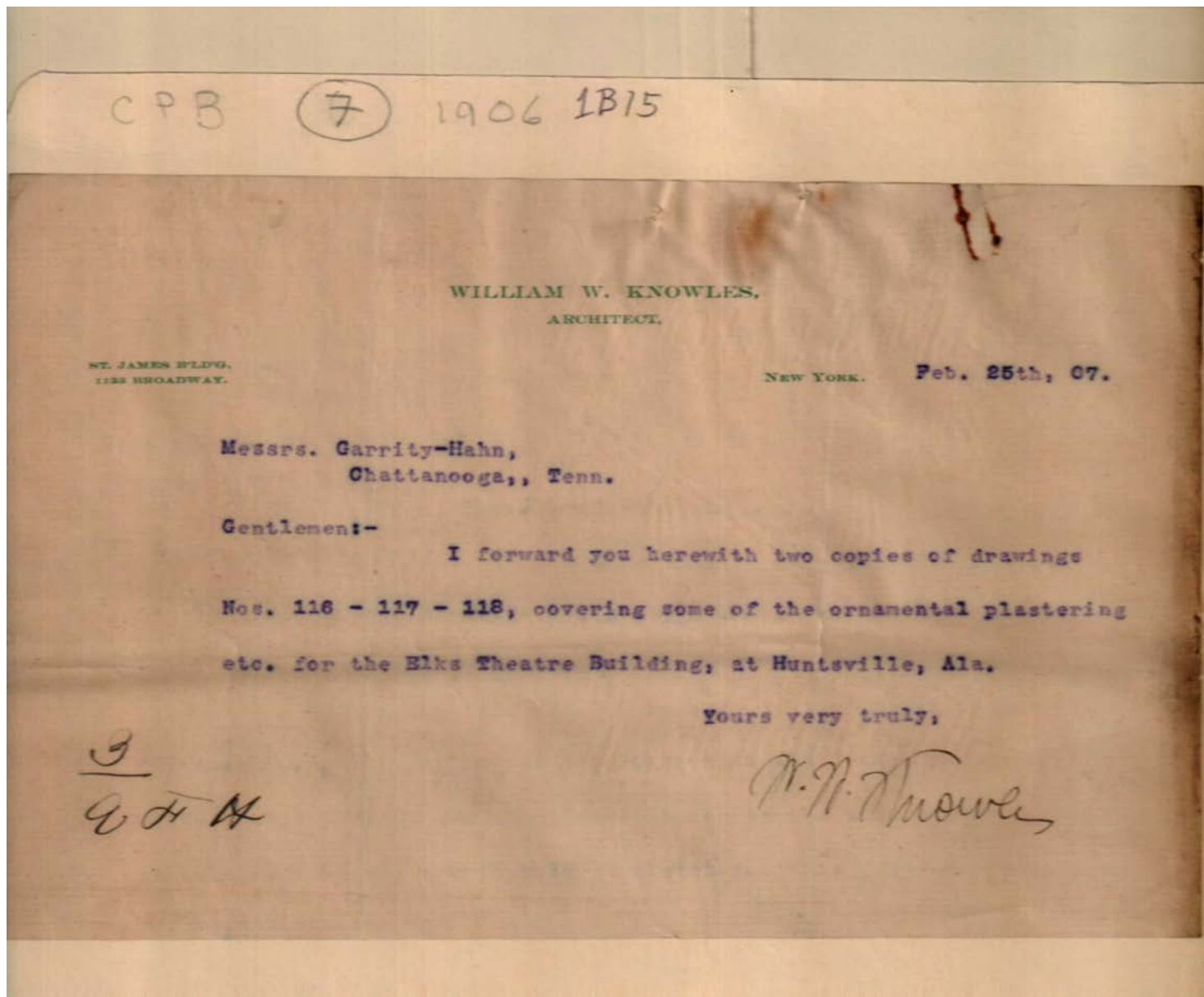

entrance door trim, mullions and transoms. Also sheet #39-A., show-
ing the window transoms, wall moulding, etc. of the Committee Room
as revised, also trim over doors of Lodge Room; also sheet #119,
showing the trim, doors and posts about the elevator and stair case.

I have also sent prints of these drawings to Mr. Love,
so that he will be familiar with everything. You are also to make
the stair details according to specifications, including paneled
newels for main newels and plain newels for sub newels.

The pilasters and columns of Foyer and Lodge Room are
to be of wood, instead of plaster.

A. So far as the outside people were concerned we did not.

Q. Was you present at the meeting held at the office of Walker and Spragins on the 5th or 6th of July 1906 between Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Hahn on the one part and the Elks Building committee on the other?

A. I really do not know, some of these meetings I do not remember.

EXAMINATION BY MR. FLETCHER.

Q. Do you remember being present at a meeting when the Garrity-Hahn Building Company had stopped work on the building on account of money they held from the estimates and your building committee were insisting upon their going on with the work, that meeting held in July, 1906, at which Mr. Hahn and Mr. O'Grady were present on the one hand and some members of the Building committee on the other?

A. I do not remember any dates, there were several of those meetings but I do not remember the two- Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Starnier being present.

Q. Do you recall at the meeting so held, when work had been stopped the time of said meeting to patch up some differences?

A. I could answer that in two or three different ways- we were stopped several times for something, but in all those stops it was a disagreement of the Architect and Contractors, there never was a time that they were held up after we got the estimates to pay.

Q. Well this was the disagreement between the contractor and Architect on account of iron work being held out of the estimate?

A. Yes sir I was there.

The iron was not in the building at that time.

Q. Do you remember the meeting in Elsons Bank in which Mr. O'Grady and the Building Committee figured on the amount of money which would be going to them if they went ahead and completed the work?

A. They did not figure on it, I was at the meeting, they did not figure on it at that time and in that way, at the meeting they did not. I do not know what they did afterwards.

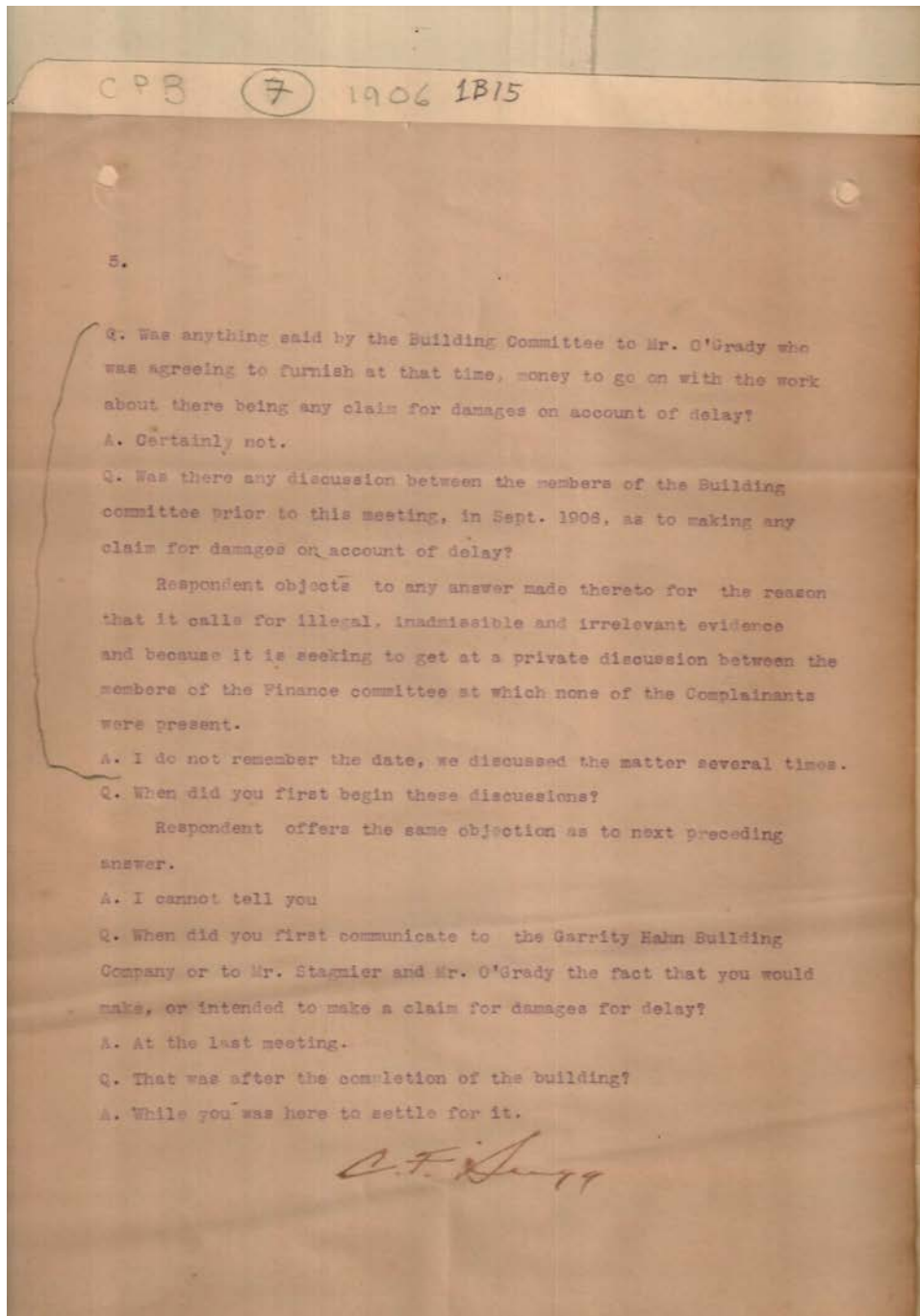

Committee who had charge of contracting for and construction of the
Elks Home and Theatre in Huntsville, Alabama?

A. Yes sir.

Q. What business are you engaged in?

A. Real estate and insurance.

Q. How long have you been in the real estate business in
Huntsville?

A. Twelve years.

Q. Are you familiar with the values of real estate in Huntsville?

A. Yes sir.

Q. With rental values?

A. Yes sir. In that business also.

A. Well I do not remember whether that subject was discussed - it may have been, I suppose at various meetings they talked over the matter and discussed it, but just what the final decision was I do not remember. Of course they often discussed the matter.

Q. Mr. Lowenthal, was you present at a meeting in July 1906, about the 5th day of July, at the office of Walker and Spragins, which was held by the Elks Building Committee and Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Hahn?

A. I cannot say whether I was present or not at that particular meeting I may have been.

Q. Do you remember a meeting prior to the meeting in September 1906, in Rison's bank at which Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Hahn were present and at which Mr. O'Grady agreed in behalf of himself and Mr. Stagnier to advance money to the Garrity Hahn Building Company for the carrying on of the work, at which time the question of payment for some iron material or iron work was also brought up before the committee, and the committee agreed to pay for the iron work- about twelve hundred dollars?

A. I cannot recall that.

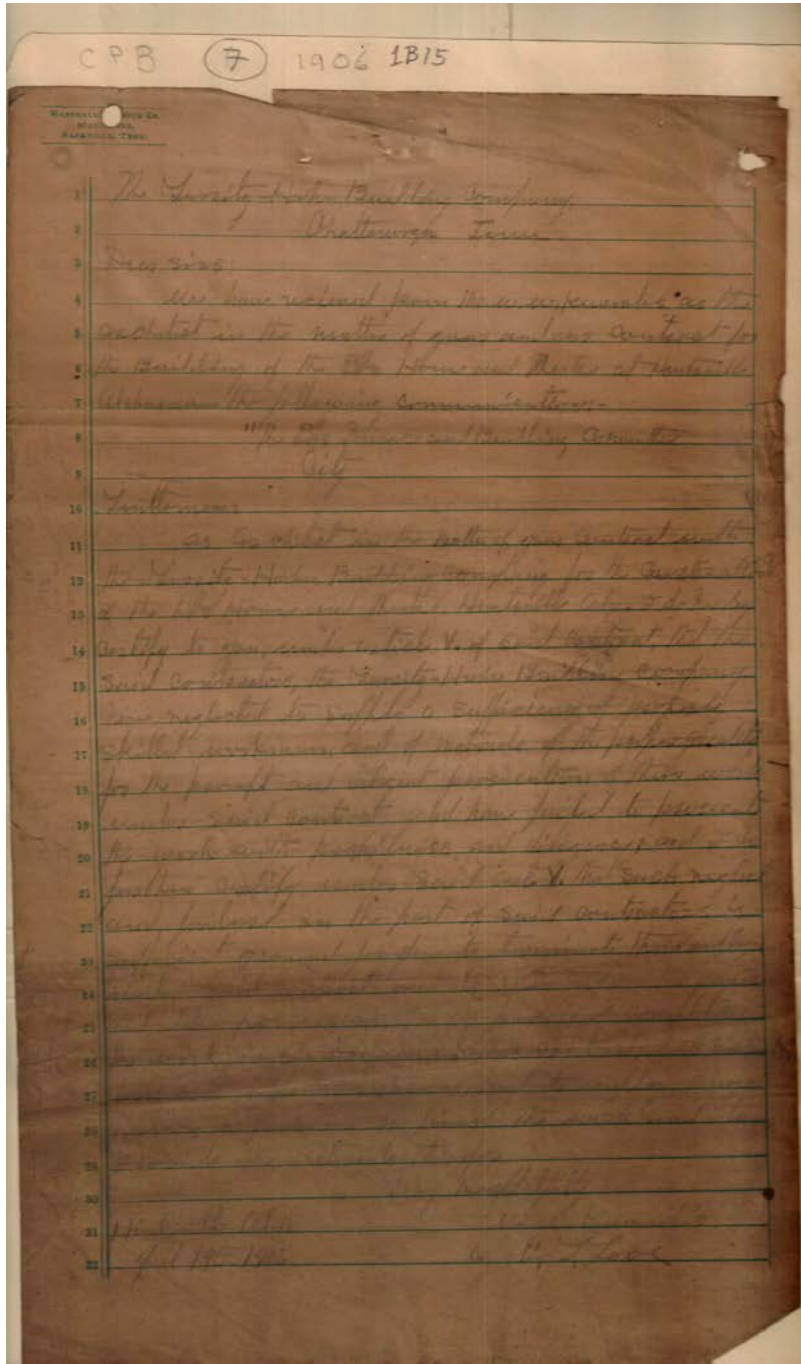

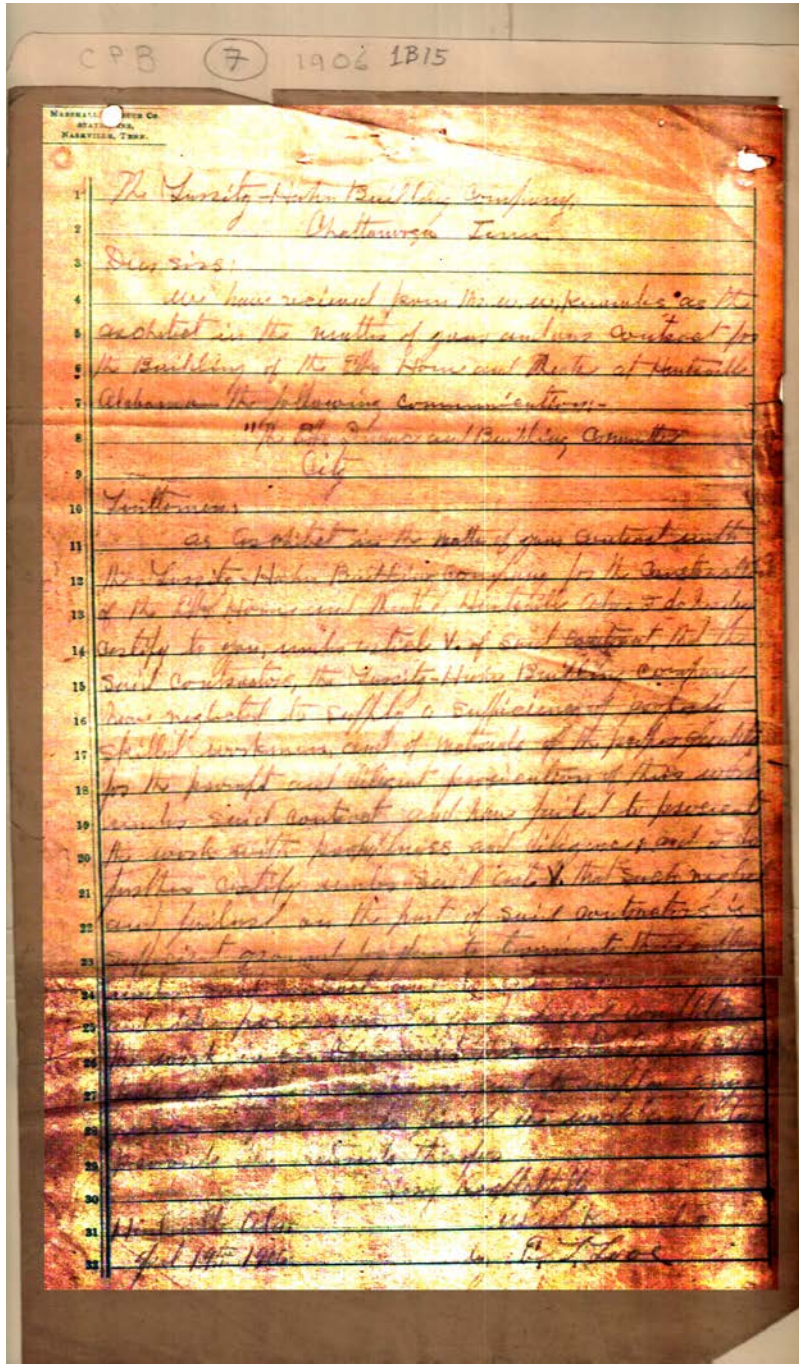

Deposition of Robert E. Spragins, witness for Defendant, said witness being first duly sworn to speak the truth the whole truth and nothing but the truth both before and say as follows:

My name is Robert E. Spragins. I live in Huntsville, Alabama, I was a member of the Finance and Building Committee for the Huntsville Elks Club who had charge of contracting for and looking after the construction of the Elks Home and Theatre in Huntsville, Alabama. I have lived in Huntsville, Alabama all my life and am familiar with the value of real estate in this city, and with rental values in this city. In my judgment a reasonable rental value of the Elks Home and Theatre is as follows:

The Theatre part in my judgment is worth Two thousand dollars a year- the offices in my judgment are worth, with heat and janitor service furnished free of charge, Ten dollars per month. There are twenty four offices in the building. The third story, used by the Elks' Lodge of Huntsville, and consisting of the Lodge room, paraphernalia room, large committee room and Library, in my judgment are worth Fifty dollars per month. The basement of said property which is entirely under the office building, the heating part being under the theatre part of the building in my judgment is worth seventy five dollars per month. To the best of my recollection I have been present at all of the meetings of the Finance Committee at which Mr. O'Grady or Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier were present.

I was at several meetings in Wilsons bank, and was of course present at the meeting in my office. I do not remember the dates of any of said meetings. I do remember that at one of the meetings in question Mr. O'Grady or Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier came here in response to a notice from the Elks Finance and Building Committee that if anyone complains object to the statement of the witness as to the purpose for which Messrs. Stagnier and O'Grady came here, because it calls for the statement and opinion of the witness, because it has reference to the contents of a written statement which is the best evidence and because it calls for illegal, irrelevant, immaterial, incompetent and inadmissible testimony.

Said notice was in writing, a copy of which is attached as an exhibit to the deposition of Mr. Garth in this case.

Complainants object to a statement of the contents of the notice for the notice itself is the best evidence, and moves to exclude the same. - - - -

So that work on the building might progress with more dispatch the contract would be annulled, and other persons employed to complete the building, and that Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier as sureties would be held responsible on their bond for any deficit that may accrue. At that meeting Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier, or one of them stated that they would put money behind the Garrity-Hahn Building Company to buy materials and employ men and would get Mr. Hahn to put in his personal time in the construction of this building, provided the Elks Finance and Building Committee would make payments directly to O'Grady and Stagnier, or one of them, of the moneys so advanced on the assignments or agreements with the Garrity Hahn Building Company to this effect. This was done and the payments thereafter were made to Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier or one of them.

On the assignment by the Garrity Hahn Building Company of this proposition. At that time or some other meeting at which Mr. O'Grady and Mr. Stagnier, one or both were present, one of these gentlemen stated that they would probably lose ten thousand dollars as sureties on this work and offered to pay five thousand dollars to be released from liability as such sureties. There was no discussion at this meeting or at any other meeting as to the extension of the time limit within which the building was to be completed, so far as I know, and to the best of my recollection I was present at all these meetings. This property upon which the Elks Home and Theatre is located, is between my home and place of business and I passed there several times every day. There were times when few if any men were at work on the building, and there were times when fifteen or twenty or more men were at work on the building. For several periods of times there was the foreman of construction with one or two men, and I believe sometimes
