tioned in Exhibit B to the trustee's report filed herein on September 8, 1904. The item of \$66.02 paid by Dave Mayo on December 27, 1905, is part of the balance of \$125.47 then due on his note which is mentioned in the list of undivided personal property which was made Exhibit C to the original bill in this case. \$60.45 of said balance was paid by crediting that amount in payment of a bill due said Mayo for repairs etc., made by him on the farm rented by him from the undersigned trustee. One third of said balance of \$125.47 belonged to Mrs. Lula Harris Johnson, and that one third, \$41.82, was paid to her on August 31, 1906. The voucher representing this last mentioned payment explains the matter. The \$8,646.23, paid by J. W. Woodroof on March 23, 1906, was in full of the balance owing on his note and mortgage mentioned in Exhibit B to the original bill in this case. The items of \$21,220.00 and \$6,533.66, paid by William Richardson, executor, on July 19, 1906, and July 28, 1906, were in full of the note and mortgage of Samuel H. Moore, mentioned in said Exhibit B to the original bill in this case. The item of \$62.50, paid by J. A. B. Stafford on December 17, 1905, represents one half of the price at which eighty acres of land (the west half (1/2) of the Southeast quarter (1/4) Section Eighteen (18) Township One (1) Range One (1) West) belonging to Georgia May Harris and Lula Harris Johnson, two-thirds interest in the former and one-third interest in the latter, was sold to said Stafford. This land is in what is known as the Barrens of Madison County, Alabama, was wholly unimproved, and yielded no revenue. It was sold for \$125.00, more than twice what it cost the late George M. Harris. One third of the amount, less the expense of sale, was paid to said Lula Harris Johnson. The balance of the purchase money is secured by mortgage on the land. Being fully persuaded of the advisability of making this sale the undersigned as trustee, joined with Mrs. Lula Harris Johnson in making this sale, and he respectfully asks the confirmation by the court of his action in that regard.

No changes other than those above mentioned have been made in the investments as held when the undersigned's last report as trustee was filed.

The amount of cash held by the undersigned as said trustee at the date of the filing of this report is \$2,739.89, which is deposited to the credit of the undersigned as such trustee, with W. R. Rison Banking Company, Huntsville, Alabama. A summary of the cash account of the trust estate is filed herewith, marked "Exhibit B", and is prayed to be taken and considered as a part of this report.

The undersigned rented the farm known as the Newman and Cruse farm to B. C. Garner and W. D. Mayo for the year 1906, at the rental of \$350.00, being the same as the rental for 1905.

The farm known as the Clark farm was rented to James Clark and A. A. Clark for the year 1906, at the rental of \$100.00, being the same as the rental for 1905.

The undersigned has been unable to rent the Larkin farm in Jackson County, Alabama, as a whole. W. R. Larkin, who formerly rented the place, and who lives near it was engaged to rent so much of the land as he could get tenants for. The crops on the place in 1905, mostly corn, were greatly damaged by excessive rains during that year, and said Larkin has not yet settled with the undersigned for his collections for that year, having put off a settlement from time to time on account of sickness and for other excuses. The undersigned hopes to get this matter settled soon.

The former lease of Thomas T. Terry of the storehouse heretofore occupied by him expired at the end of the year 1905. The undersigned leased said store to said Terry for a term of three years commencing January 1st, 1906, at a rental of \$600.00 a year, being an advance of one hundred dollars a year on the former rental. In order to secure a renewal of his lease by said Terry the undersigned had to have a new front put in said store, the old front being antiquated and not affording means for a proper display of goods. The new front was put in at a cost of \$150.00. The undersigned was of opinion that this change was of advantage to the property, as is evidenced by the increased rental received.

Proper vouchers for the several disbursements made by the undersigned are in his possession, subject to the orders of the court. They will be filed if the court shall so direct. Unless otherwise directed
