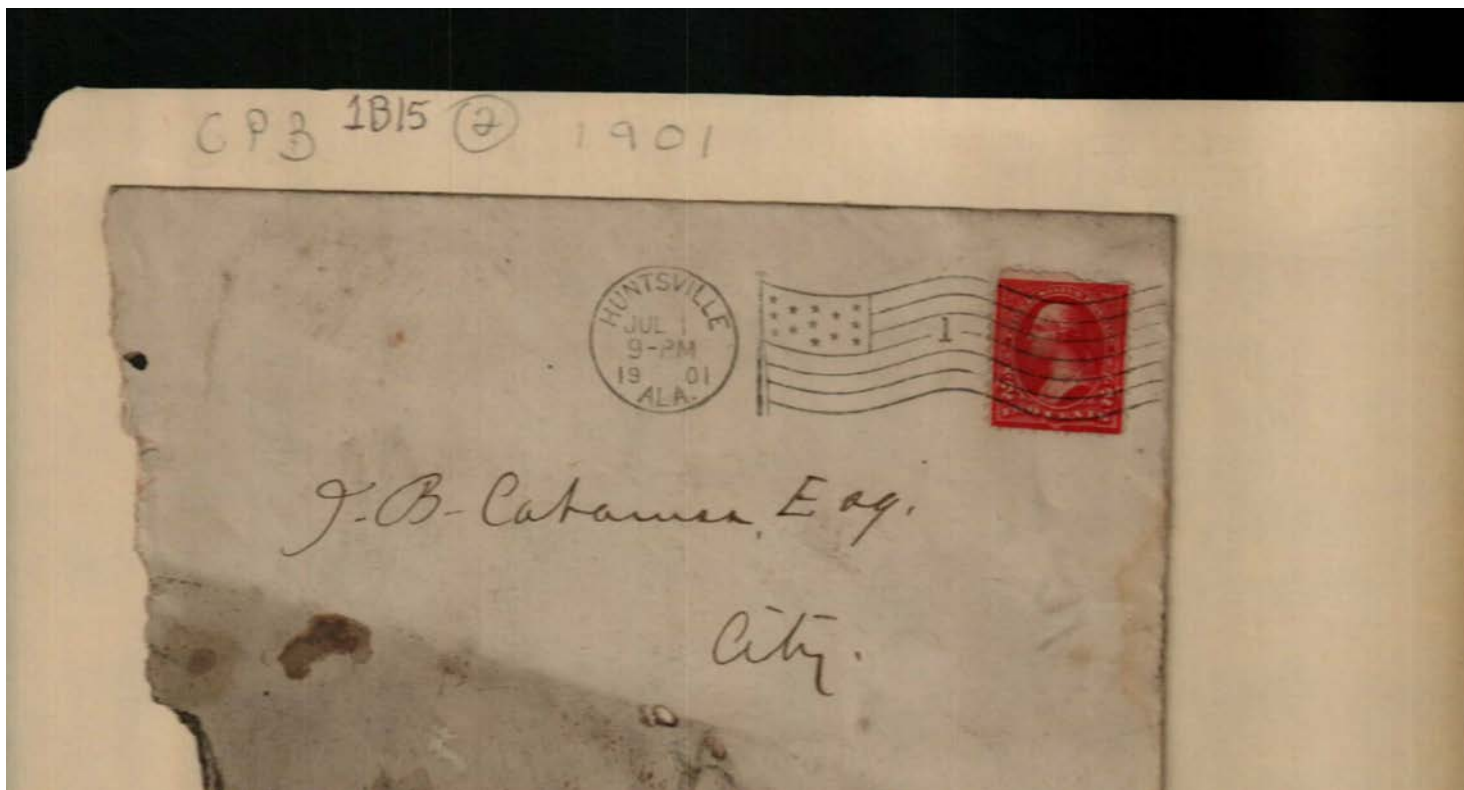

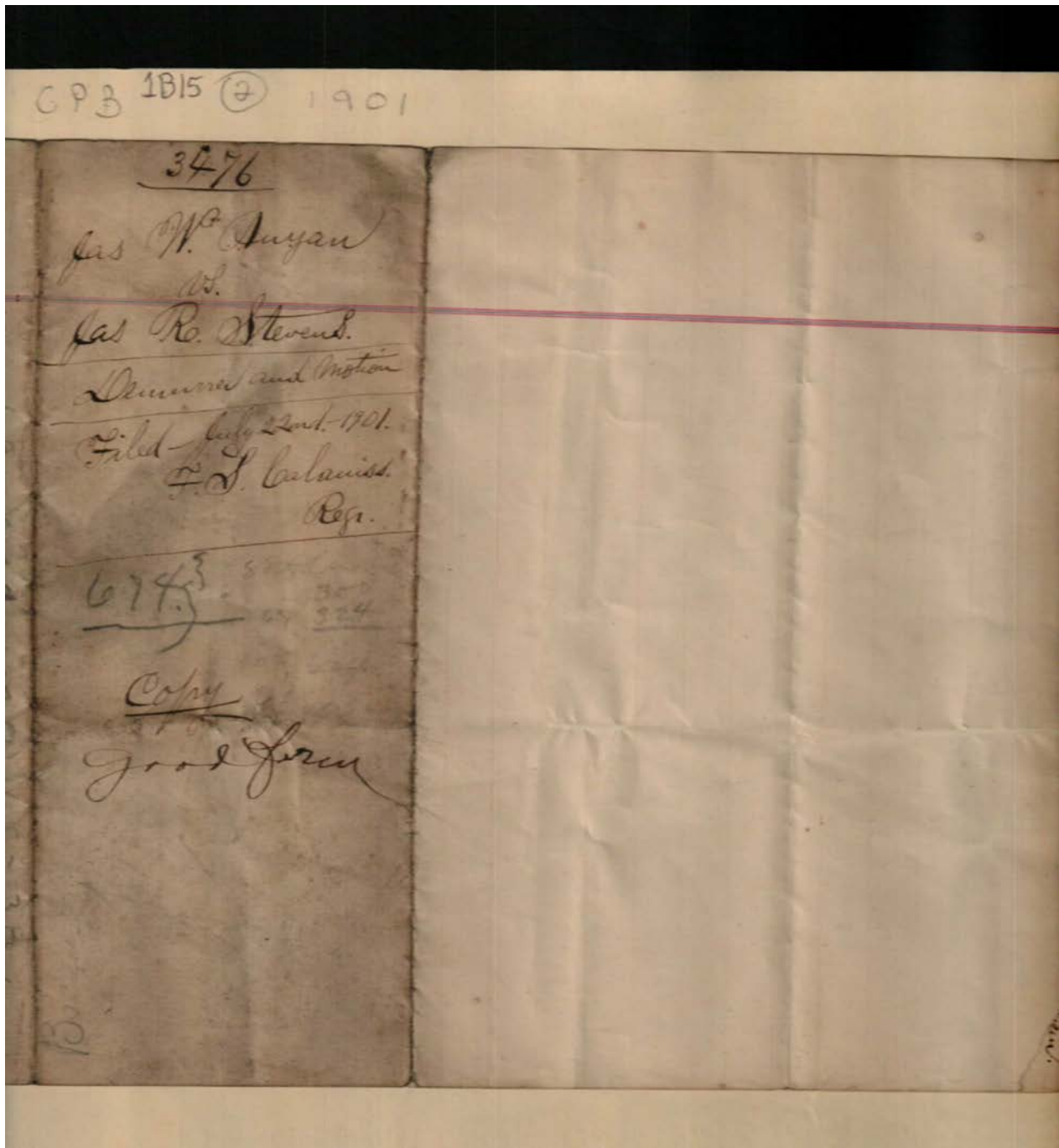

Respondent demurs to the bill and for grounds
sets:

1. The bill is multirious in that it is a bill to quiet title under Section 209 of the Code and also a bill to cancel a cloud.
2. The bill is fatally defective in this, it seeks to cancel the deed made by the Register in Chancery to Stevens, but does not allege that the parties to the suit, as a result of which the land was sold and conveyed to Stevens, had any title to the lands and without such title said deed could be no cloud.
3. It is not shown by the bill that Stevens acquired any title to the lands under the deed from the Register, whereof said deed is no cloud.
4. The tax deed from Burke Auditor to Neuman, under which Complainant claims title to the land, is void because it is not acknowledged as required by law before an officer authorized to take acknowledgments.
5. Said tax deed is void because the signature of the grantor is neither acknowledged nor attested.
6. Said tax deed is void because it purports to be executed by Burke through Owens his clerk, who is not shown to have power of Attorney or other sufficient authority to execute the same.
