MARLSON COUNTY.      This deed of Mortgage executed by the undersigned Henry Peterson, sold to M. Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons, all of the County of Madison and State of Alabama, WITNESSETH:

Whereas I, the said Henry Peterson am justly indebted to the said Luther M. Simmons and L.S. Simmons in the sum of Eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) as evidenced by four several promissory notes for two hundred dollars each of even date herewith, and payable respectively, with interest annually, from date as the 1st day of January in the years, 1897, 1898, 1899 and 1900 to said M. Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons or order, payable and negotiable at the Banking house of W.R. Rison & Co. Huntsville, Ala. given for the second, third, fourth and fifth installments of the purchase money of said real estate sold to me by said M. Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons at the price of Twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00). (the first installment of \$300.00 being paid in cash at and before the delivery hereof) and conveyed to me by deed of date ..... with the understanding that the payment of said deferred installments should be further secured by the execution of this deed of mortgage.

NOW KNOW YE in consideration of the premises I the said Henry Peterson do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons and their heirs and assigns all my right title claim and interest in and to those certain tracts or parcel of land situate in the said County of Madison and described as follows to wit: The North half of the South east Quarter and the South half of the North-east Quarter, Sec. 21, Township 1, Range 1, East, containing 160 acres more or less and formerly known as the Metalf place.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property hereby conveyed unto the said M. Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons, jointly, their heirs and assigns forever, and I hereby covenant and agree that I will warrant and defend the title to the property hereby conveyed unto them and their heirs and assigns, from and against the lawful claims of all persons claiming by force or under me, and that I will satisfy and discharge all taxes which may be assessed against said property whilst any of said four notes shall remain unpaid.

THAT THIS conveyance is made subject to the provisions, conditions and stipulations hereinafter expressed: that is to say, if I shall pay each of said notes at the maturity thereof, then this conveyance is to become null and void, and satisfaction thereof registered of record, and in case of the non payment of any one or more of said notes when due, then in such event, then the said M. Luther Simmons and L.S. Simmons or the assignee or assignees of any one or more of said notes, that may be due and unpaid shall have the power and are hereby authorized to sell the property hereby conveyed at public sale to the highest bidder for cash at the Court house door of said County, after having given thirty days notice of the time and place and terms of such sale by advertisement in some newspaper published

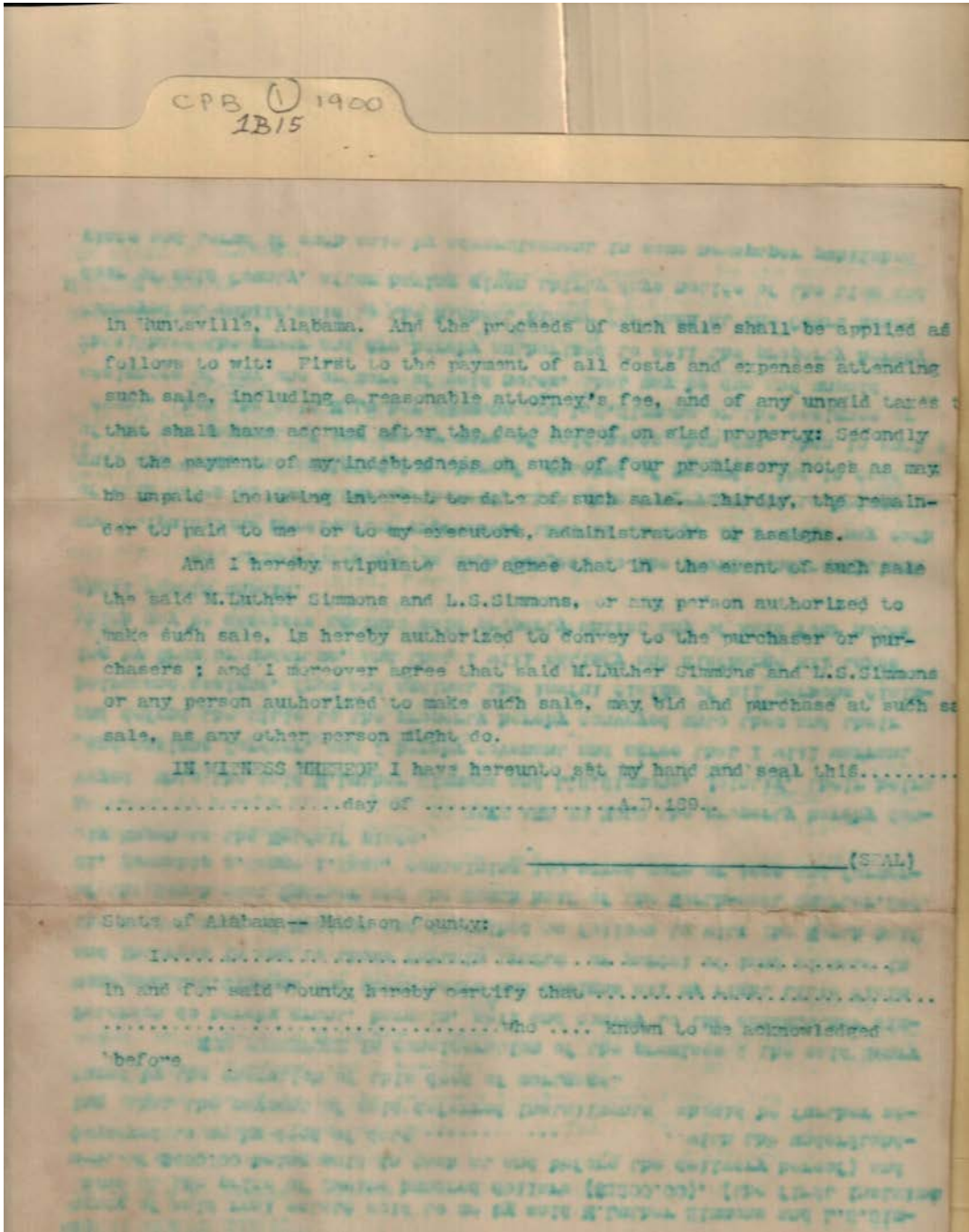
