5. 2.

1. To pay and discharge all the just and reasonable expenses, costs and charges of executing this assignment and of carrying into effect the trust hereby created, together with a lawful commission to the said party of the second part for his services in executing said trust.

2. To pay and discharge in full, if the residue of said proceeds is sufficient for that purpose, all the debts and liabilities now due or to grow due from the said party of the first part, with all interest money due or to grow due; and if the residue of said proceeds shall not be sufficient to pay said debts and liabilities and interest moneys in full, then to apply the said residue of said proceeds to the payment of said debts and liabilities ratably and in proportion.

3. And if, after the payment of all the said debts and liabilities in full, there be any remainder or residue of said property or proceeds, to repay and return the same to the said party of the first part, his executors, administrators and assigns.

In the event any creditor is accidentally omitted from said schedule, he shall share in this trust, as if specially herein mentioned; and if the amount due to any creditor is erroneously stated, said creditor shall share according to the just and correct amount due to him.

And in furtherance of the premises the said party of the first part does hereby make, constitute and appoint the said party of the second part his true and lawful attorney, irrevocable, with full power and authority to do all acts and things which may be necessary in the premises to the full execution of the trust hereby created, and to ask, demand, recover and receive of and from all and every person or persons all property, debts and demands due, owing and belonging to the said party of the first part, and to give acquittances and discharges for the same, to sue, prosecute, defend and implead for the same, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver all necessary deeds, instruments and conveyances. And he, said party of the first part does hereby authorize the said party of the second part to sign the name of the said party of the first part to any check, draft, promissory note or other instrument in writing which is payable to the order of the said party of the first part, or to sign the name of the party of the first part to any instrument in writing whenever it shall be necessary so to do to carry into effect the object, design and purpose of this trust.

I send enclosed a statement of a partial settlement of your brother's (F.P. Ward) estate, *which I will conclude upon my return from an absence* Partial instead of final because of two or three matters pending which it will require some time to hear from, but which when decided, will cut no figure in this settlement unless they add to the resources of the estate of which you are the sole legatee.

The First is a one sixth part of a fee in a case of Jno. W. Grayson against the M.A.C.R.R.Co. brought many years ago, in which in the course of time five other lawyers, three of whom are now dead, were equally interested. In this suit, Mr. Ward and the Attys associated with him, for the M.A.C.Road saved ~~four~~ ^{two} thousand dollars, by having a lease of the M.C.Road to the E.T.Va.& Ga R.R.Co. cancelled, which saved the Directors of the M.A.C. R.R. and agreed to give the other road to release them from the lease aforementioned.

I made two trips to Montgomery for the purpose of getting some of ~~our~~ ^{my} heavy-weight ~~lawyer~~ ^{to} testify as to the value of the services rendered and succeeded in getting two ~~or three~~ ^{to} testify that the services were worth \$25000. We recovered a judgment for only \$2500. Grayson, the Plaintiff in the original case having testified greatly against our interest. It now appears that both of these roads have been put in the hands of a Receiver by order of the U.S. District Court and we will have to wait some time for our money but I think it is safe.

Only, Mr. Ward and R.W. Walker of this place had a young friend here by the name of Frank Hopkins, a merchant who became involved ^{in a lawsuit}. He left for Nashville, Tenn. and by thus becoming a non-resident of the State had to give security for costs. They became his security for costs. The case went to the Supreme Court

and it was decided against Hopkins. Hopkins now lives in Birmingham, is insolvent and refuses to pay any part of it. I went to Birmingham and offered to pay it if he would pay me as Exr. back in monthly instalments out of his salary, which he refused to do.

I am now resisting it in the circuit Court and think I can avoid its payment by a technicality, and feel no scruples in doing so under the circumstances.

Thirdly. There is a liability of a very serious nature that Mr. Ward seemed to have overlooked. ^{3d} The Bill of costs in the case of F. P. Ward Admr. with the will annexed of Thos. Fearn, dec'd. vs. Reuben Chapman dec'd. at sds. This suit was commenced somewhere in the neighborhood of twenty years ago, and I believe I have written you some of its details and the amount of costs for which he made himself liable, amounting then I thought to \$1500. or more. Since then the Chancellor has decided the matter against us and Capt. Humes a son in law of Chapman, and a leading member of the bar here has dug up fees of Isiah Dill and took a great many depositions in the case amounting to \$200. which he claims does not come in the fees of the three former Registers, viz; Dill, Wilson and Newman, of which as purchased by me, I wrote you.

I will fight his claim and have no doubt but that I can win it. I also intend to take the case to the Supreme Court and if possible reverse the decision of the Chancellor. I am, the Register of the Chancery Court and will have the record made out at my own expense. The record is between 1600 or 2000 pages, which it becomes the duty of the Register to make out, the law allowing six 1/2 cents per hundred words for copying it. The only cost of the estate will be a tax of about \$20. imposed by law to defray expenses of Supreme Court. All that I can do, I will do free of charge, and will not collect any fees due me as Register.

I send you a list of notes for money loaned out. Some of them I am apprehensive I will have to sue upon to recover the amount, which if necessary shall be no expense to you ~~in~~ in the way of Atty's fees. But I will retain them so as to be

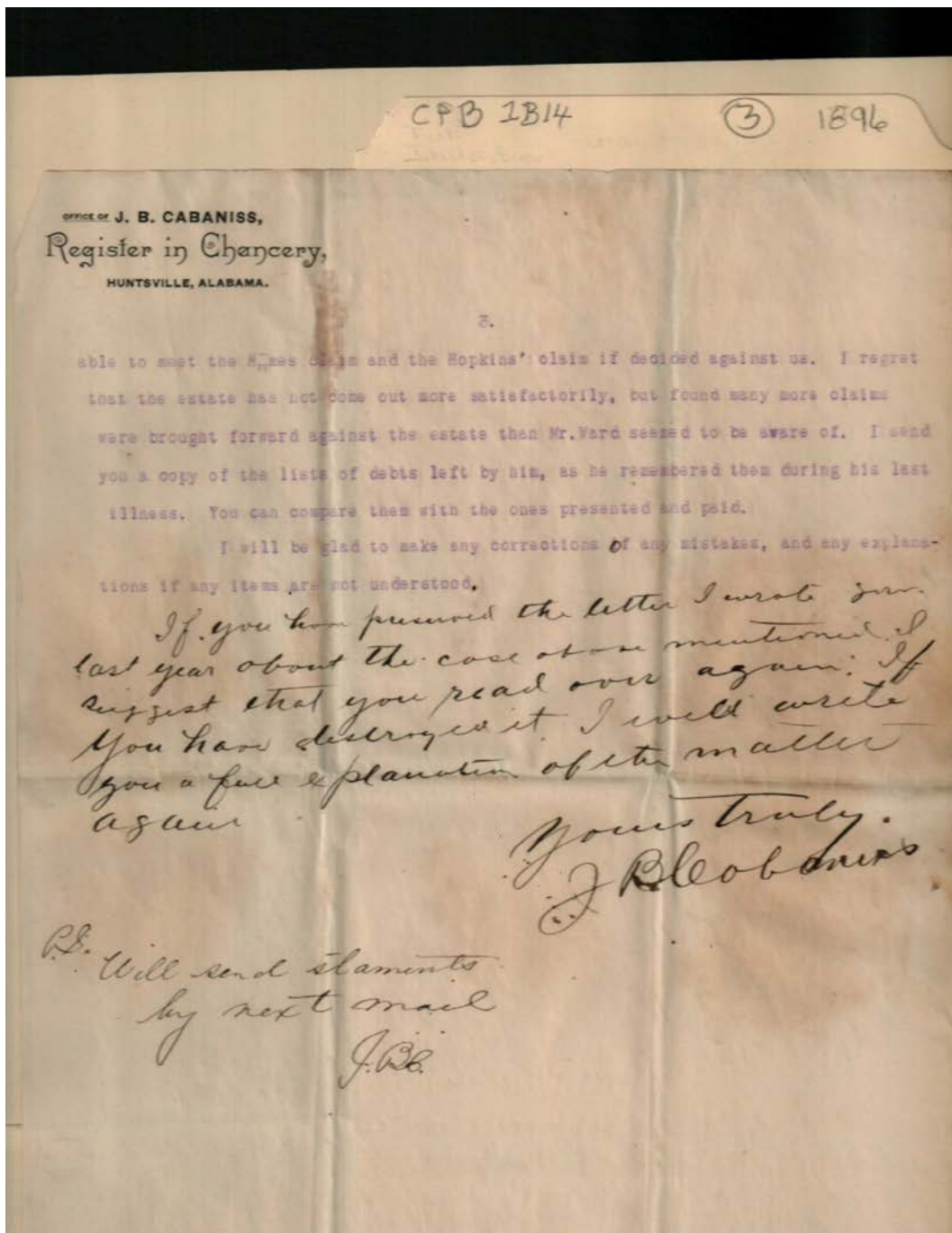

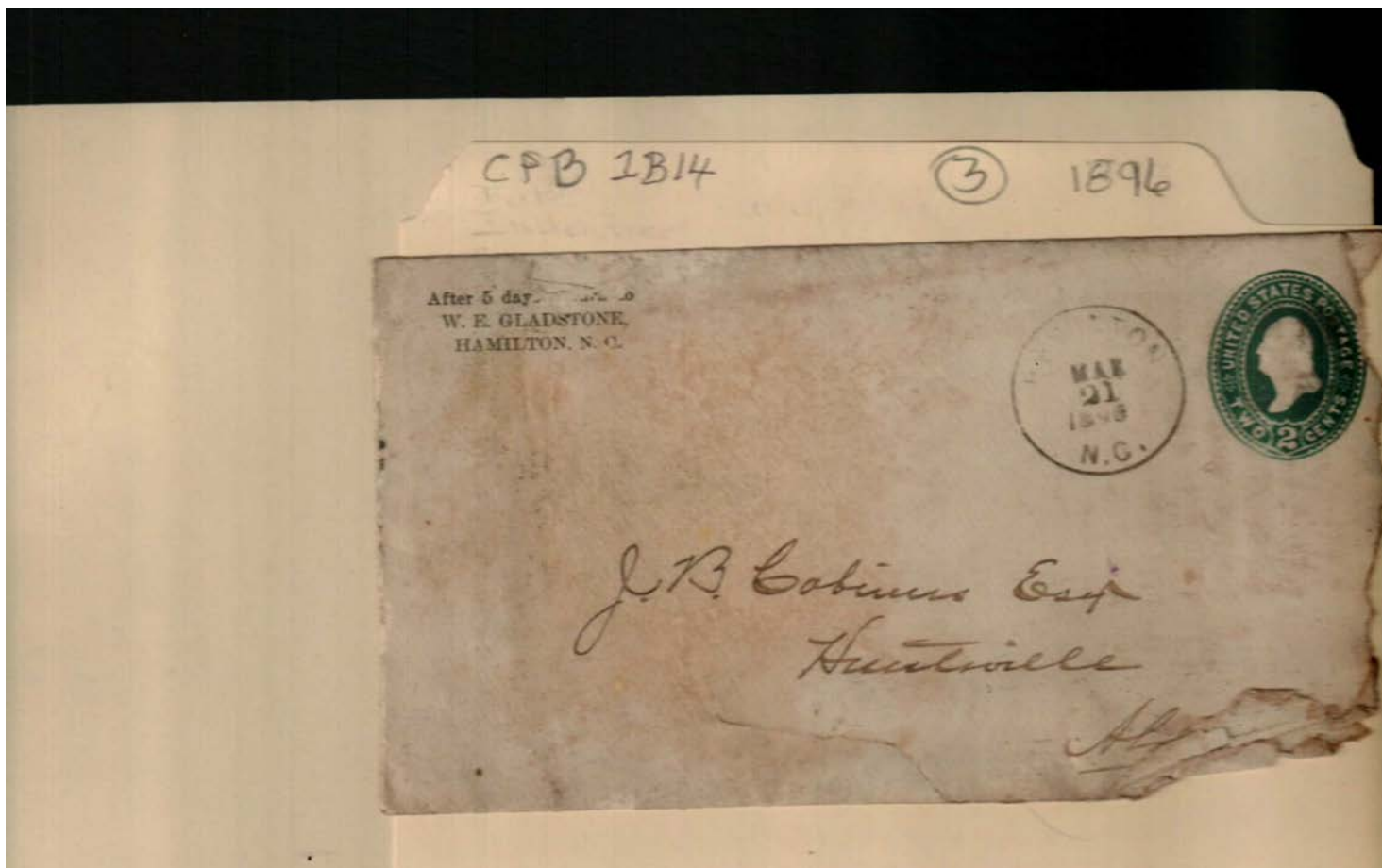

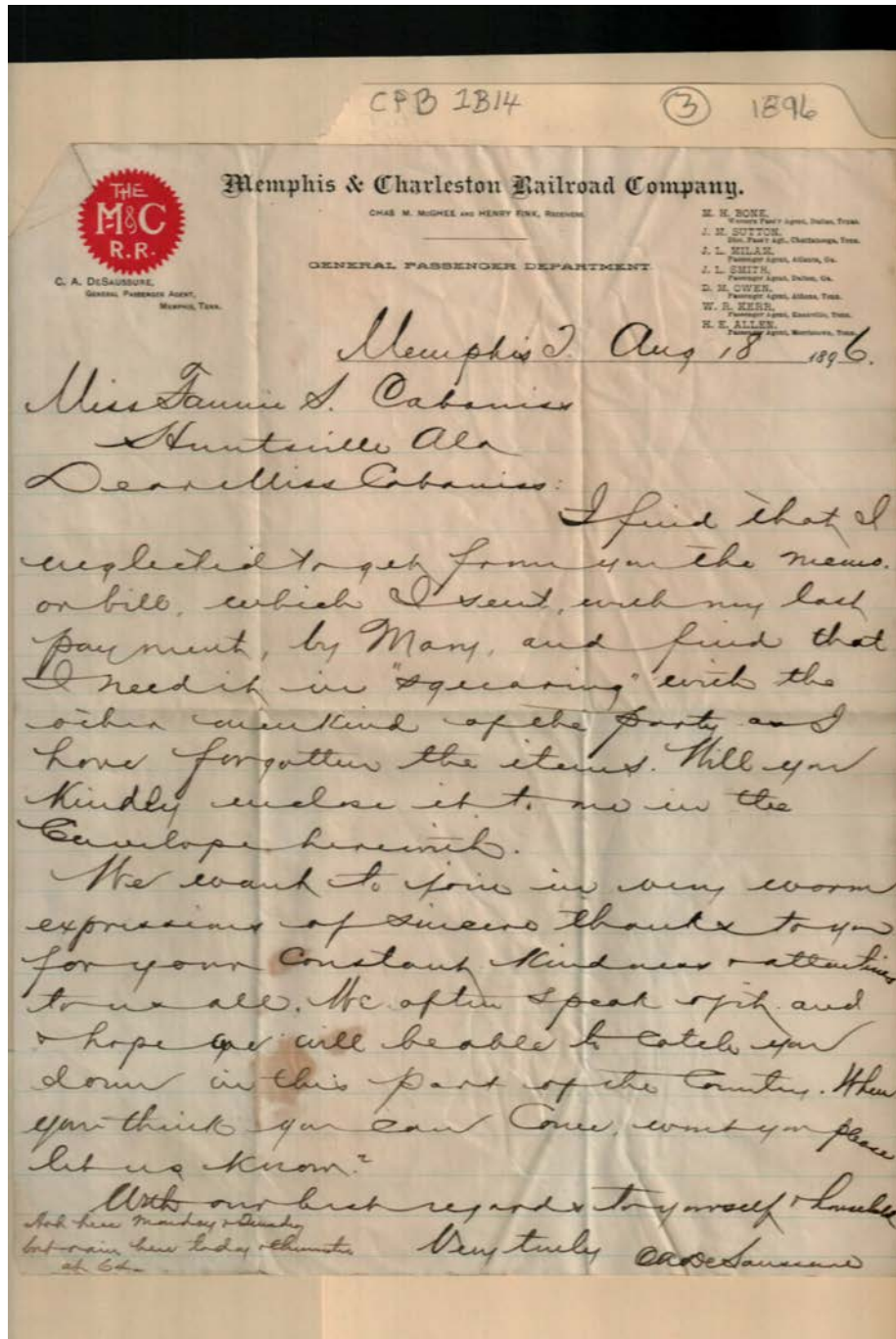
