The "VICTOR" is made entirely of Steel with the exception of the tongue, and has boxes which are so constructed that the bearings are kept free from dirt.

The main FRAME is made of square pipe while the gang frames are made of channel steel; the stands to which the boxes are connected with the frames of the gangs are of flat steel, and not cast iron. Each gang has an adjustment by which the depth of cut is regulated.

There is positively no side draft in this machine, when properly hitched, and there is no weight on the horses' necks.

The Harrow has two levers, thus enabling the user to control the angle of each gang independently.

The scrapers used are very simple in action and are easily controlled by the pressure of the foot.

We have adopted no "trappy" devices that will give unusual trouble, but on the other hand, the "VICTOR" OVERLAP DISC HARROW is well and honestly made and is perfect.

This Harrow cultivates the ridge and pulverizes the ground from outside to outside, leaving a smooth surface behind it. The importance of this

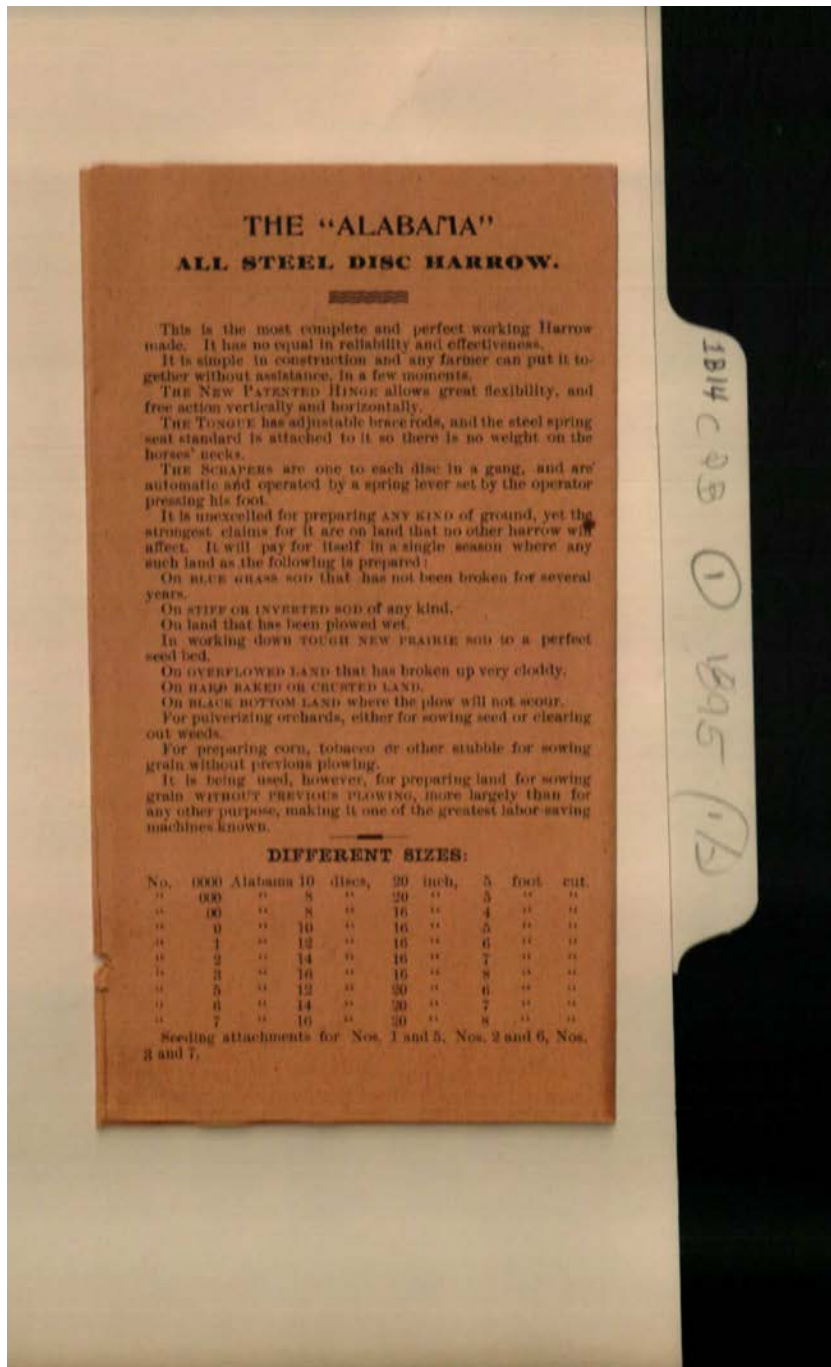
