C.P.B. 1813 1889 ② 2/5

This Agreement, made this 29th day of July, A.D. 1889, between Thomas George, of the first part and William R. Green and George W. Moore, of the second part, interpose that the said party of the first part sells, and the said parties of the second part purchases, upon the terms hereinafter set forth, all that certain parcel of land in the County of Madison and State of Alabama bounded as follows: On the north by the lands of Bell Factory, on the east by the lands of Luther W. Payne and his west line extended north, on the south and west by lands of said Bell Factory, containing about sixty-five acres, more or less, being part of the farm known as the Laughinghouse or Cannon Farm. Should the parcel of land above described not contain, upon survey, the full complement of sixty-five acres, the said parties of the second part may add to the same so much of that parcel of land as they may wish, which lies north of said Payne's land, east of the land above described, and west of the range line between ranges one and two.

The price agreed for said land is eleven dollars, and twenty-five cents per acre, be the same more or less, which is to be paid on the first day of January, A.D. 1890, with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum from the first day of January next, to be paid annually. The said parties of the second part, may at their option pay said purchase money on the first day of January of any year in said term, upon giving said party of the first part six months notice thereof, and upon such payment interest shall cease on said money.

Upon the payment of such money the said party of the first part will cause said lands to be conveyed to said parties of the second part by good and sufficient warranty deed free and clear of incumbrance.

Possession is to be given to said parties of the second part of all of said lands on the first day of January next.
