land he shall die by the hands of justice, or in, or in consequence
of a duel, or in violation of any law of these states or of
the United States, or of any other country which he may
be permitted under this Policy to visit or reside in;

In as much as my niece Miss
L. P. Snedecor and Mr Kring the guardian of her
Estate have been in correspondence with me in
regard to the interference of the Adm^r of F. P.
Snedecor's estate to prevent payment to them
as beneficiaries & payees of certain insurance
policies about which you have been consulted
I hope the following suggestion will not be
regarded as an unwarrantable intrusion on
my part -

I think it not improbable that the Adm^r
Mr Chapman, and the Atty of the N. Y. Equitable
Life Ins Co may have been misled by a citation
of Bliss in his work on Life Insurance (Edition of
1872. page 497-8.) referring to case of Greenfield
vs Mass: Mutual Life Ins Co et al as decided by
Suprem Ct of N. Y. June 1871. but not their report

You will however find the case reported, as
decided on appeal in the Court of Appeals
in 47th N. Y. Reports (2 Sicksler) page 474-43
Bliss describes the policy as being payable to
the widow & children when in fact as shown
in the report, both of the policies were paya-
ble to the assured & to his executor or assigns,
and Bliss fails to state the fact that the widow
was herself the assured who brought the suit,
and that on motion of the Insurance Co, she in
her individual capacity, and her children
were made parties defendant.

It was contended in the Court of Appeals, ~~that~~
among other grounds of defence by Bliss him-
self as appellant atty, that the appointee
named in the policy that is ^{to be} the beneficiary
was the proper person to bring the action.

And on the other hand by ~~Bliss~~ A. J. Requier
(District Atty for Ala during Confederacy) that
the policy being ~~payable~~ payable to the real
mistake was an express trust within the
meaning of the Code of N. York, the suit

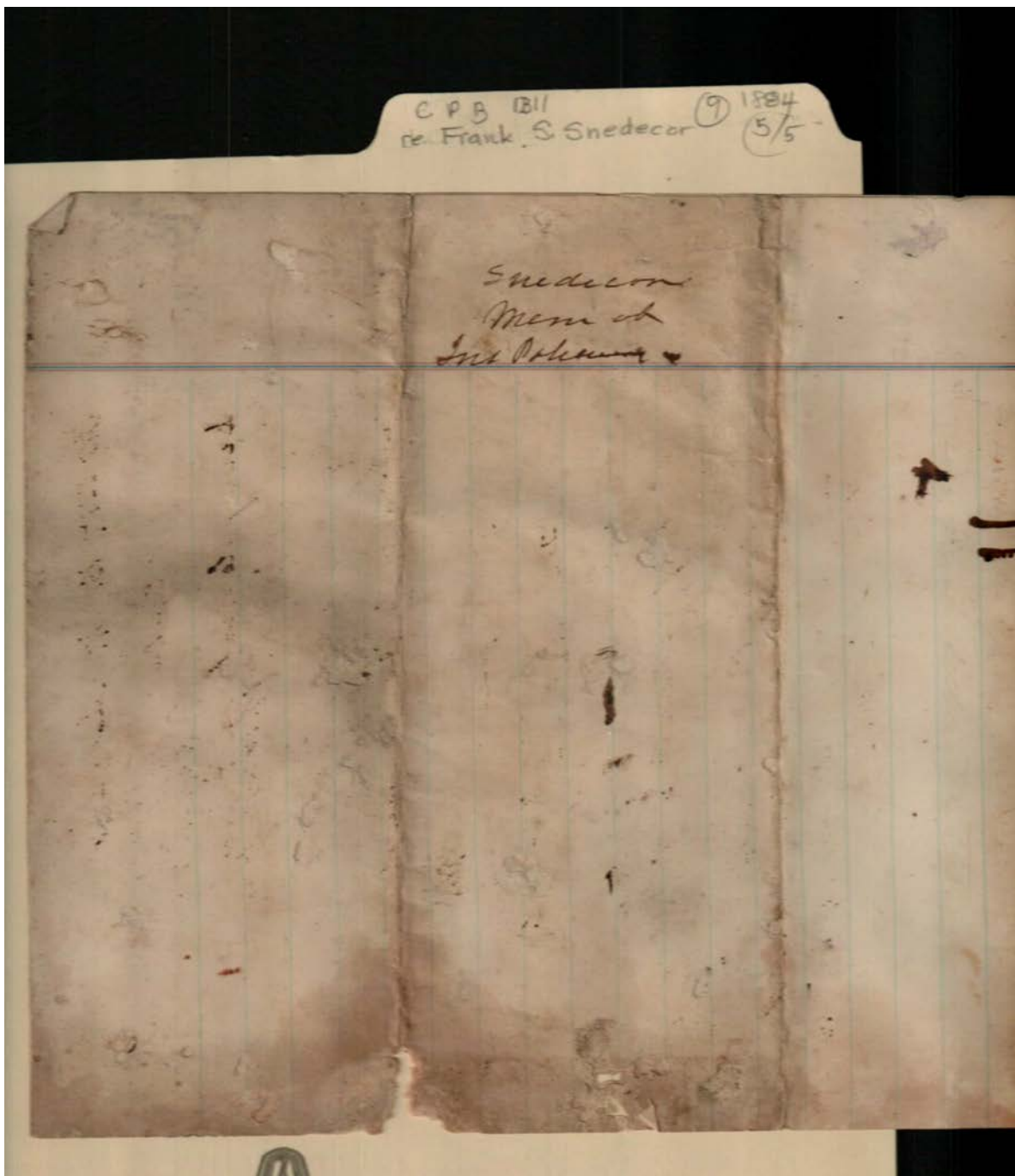
