 Opinion of the Supreme Court in *W. G. Alspaugh*
 526 & 527 & also ^{the} *Re Ralston* especially

I enclosed to you by Thursday mail
 a statement of the executing issues on the decree
 under which the land was sold, so far
 as they could be found on file. That under
