Dear Sir: I have seasoned flooring 4 in wide on end that will make beautiful floors as it is free of knots and mildew. It is 1 1/8 thick. I can load 6000 or 7000 ft on a car. I will send you a car load and let the surplus go on the new run if you bring one. If not you can pay me when you realize on the lumber. I want Mr Barclay paid out of it. I will put the lumber on the car here for \$11⁵⁰ per M face measure. I have cut but about 25 M this season and have no orders. Of course I have no money nor any prospect of getting any soon. I expect to fail if paying for the mill isn't done in.

If you would write Mr. Jones for a better rate of ft than they are in the habit of giving I think he might allow it. I believe it is 1840⁰⁰ per car load. It is 14 on the 14th and 23 on the 15th & 16th.

1875 I investigated conveyance of land by
Bolling Byrd to his wife and children, in the
interest of Mrs Margaret E Byrd who held a
debt against Byrd. I became satisfied
that the conveyance could be set aside and
the land subjected to the payment of Byrd's
debt. I so informed Judge Wemple the
Squire in Bankruptcy of Byrd, and offered
to present a bill in his name to secure
the land or in sum him a bid of over
thousand dollars for his right to the land
if he preferred to sell rather than sue.
Having no assets in hand with which to pay
expenses of suit in case of failure and no
indemnity from the creditors, he decided
to sell and authorized Governor Lewis and

At the officers sale on April 9. 1870 Iral bought the land at one thousand and thirty five dollars. (\$200 on the Byrd tract and \$135 on the Pugh tract). On the evening of the day of sale Mr Coons informed me that Mr Jordan proposed that his sister Mrs Byrd should take Iral's purchase of the Pugh tract and pay Mr Coons debt. I went immediately to Mr Baker's office and left a written proposition allowing her to do so. Receiving no notice of Mrs Byrd's acceptance of the written proposition I had left with Mr Baker. Iral on April 11. 1870 sold the Pugh tract to Mr Campbell for \$500. This would have paid off the bond's lien on it, returned Iral's purchase money and satisfied Mr Coons debt. But a petition was filed in the Bankrupt Court to set aside the sale to Iral. This petition we could not get disposed of until last spring. Mr Campbell could not wait for the action of the court and received his purchase from Iral.

On December 26. 1870 Iral agreed with Mr Byrd that if his purchase was confirmed he would convey her the Byrd tract for \$500 with interest from April 9. 1870, and that she should charge with any interest in the Pugh tract and pay him out for it in the meantime.

Last summer I made a settlement with Mr Jordan for his sister Mrs Byrd pursuant to that
