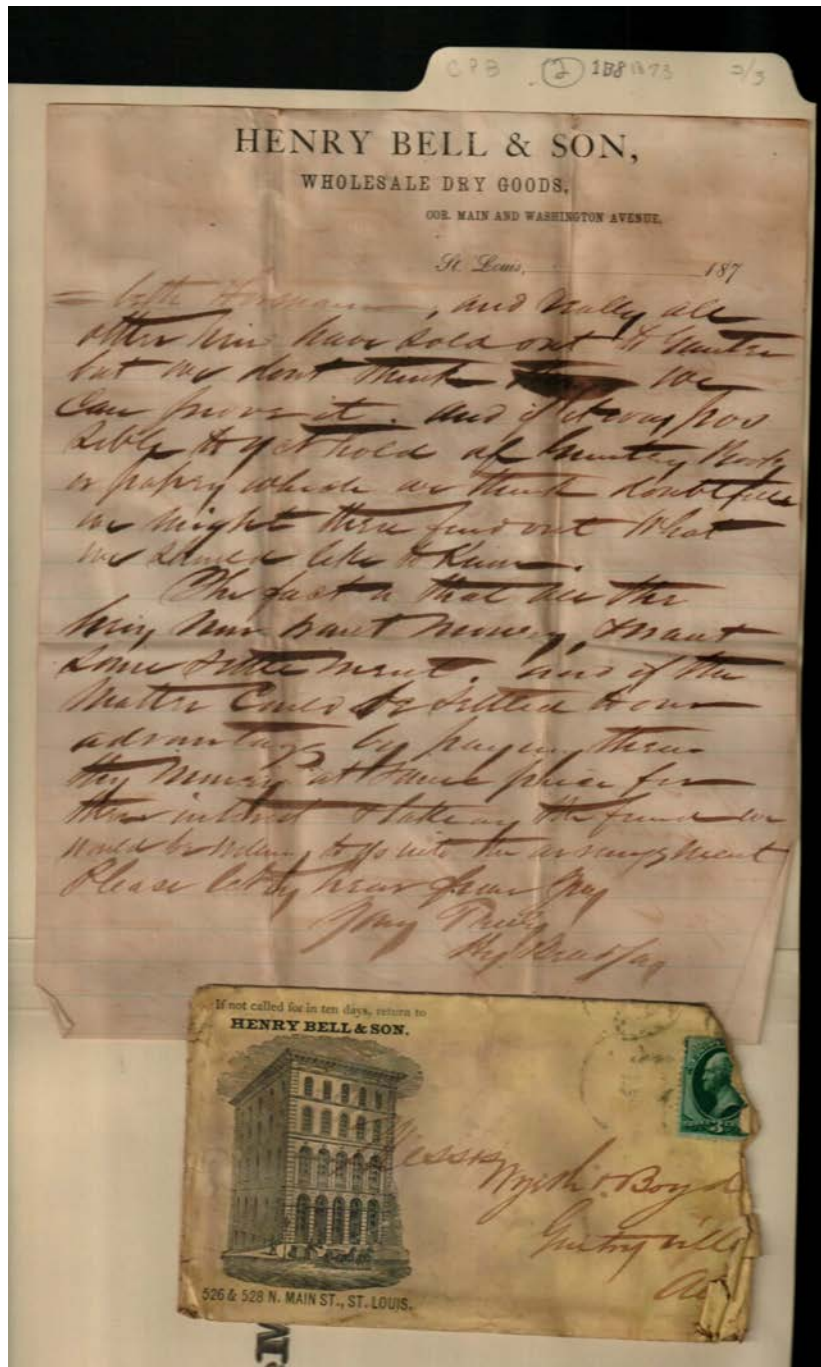

 and machinery destroyed by the same
 cause. The fencing upon the Madison
 County plantation & Ken House was in like
 manner entirely destroyed and lost to said
 estate, and that the fencing and other improve-
 ments on the plantation in Marshall County
 will also greatly impaired by the devastation

 bill more has been sold since the same was
 filed.

Proof has been taken of the value of the
 several parcels of land comprising the
 plantation in Marshall County and the
 value of each parcel has been set forth
 in Exhibit M. C. herewith filed but no
 satisfactory proof has been adduced to
 show, whether or not it can be advantage-
 ously divided and further time is
 asked for further investigation on the

The Russell Hill ^{tract} which lies near
