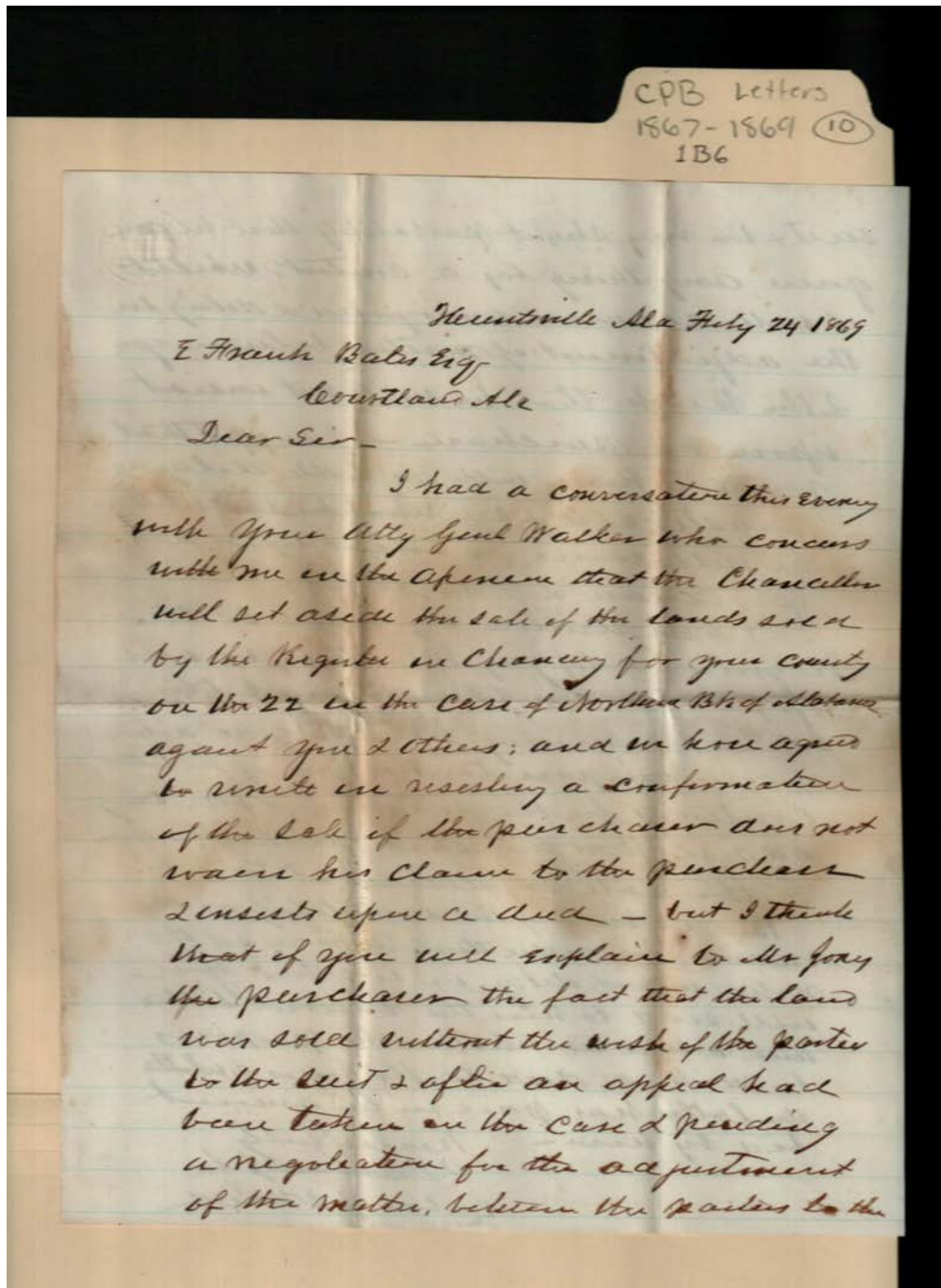

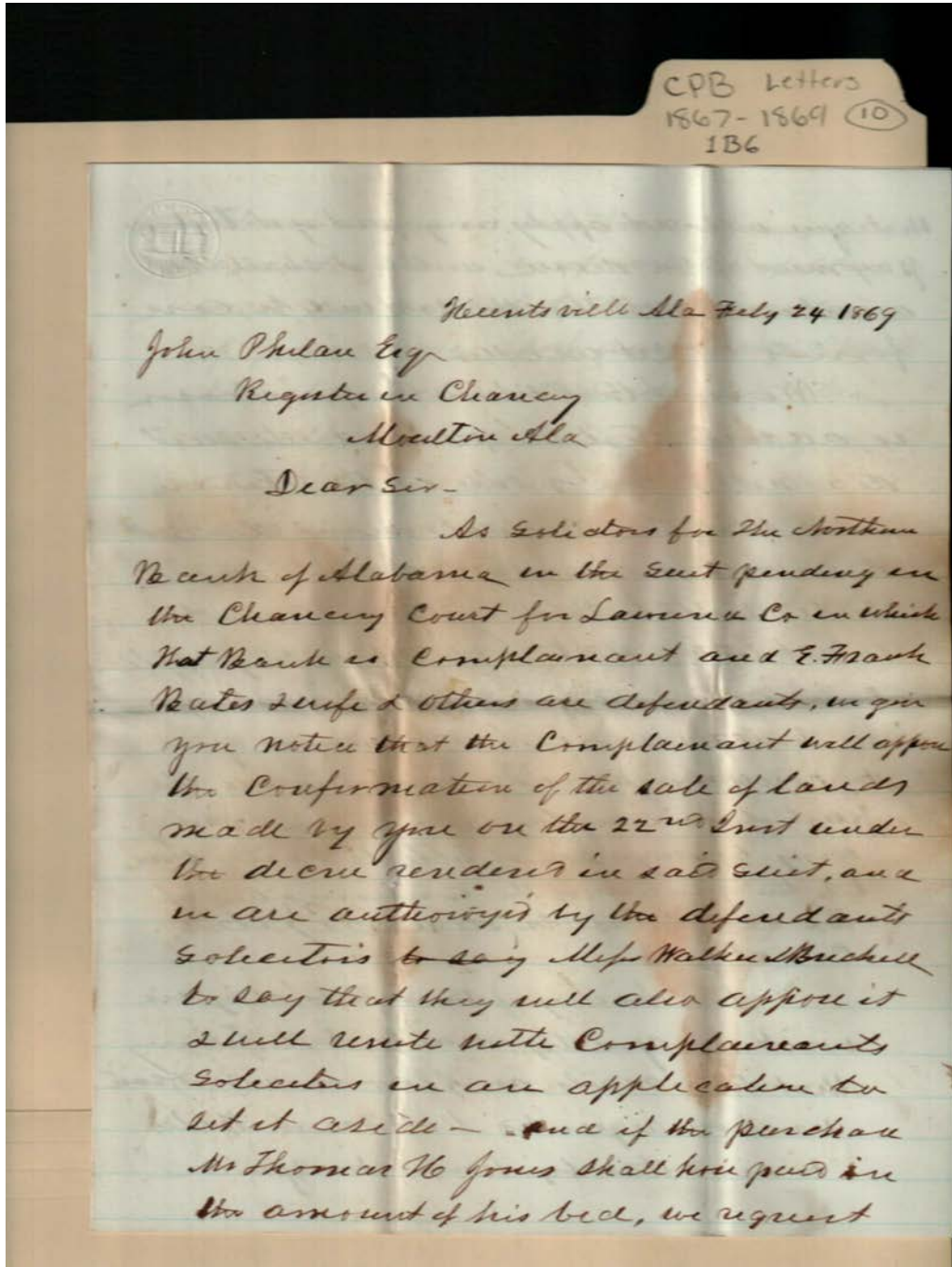

Court -

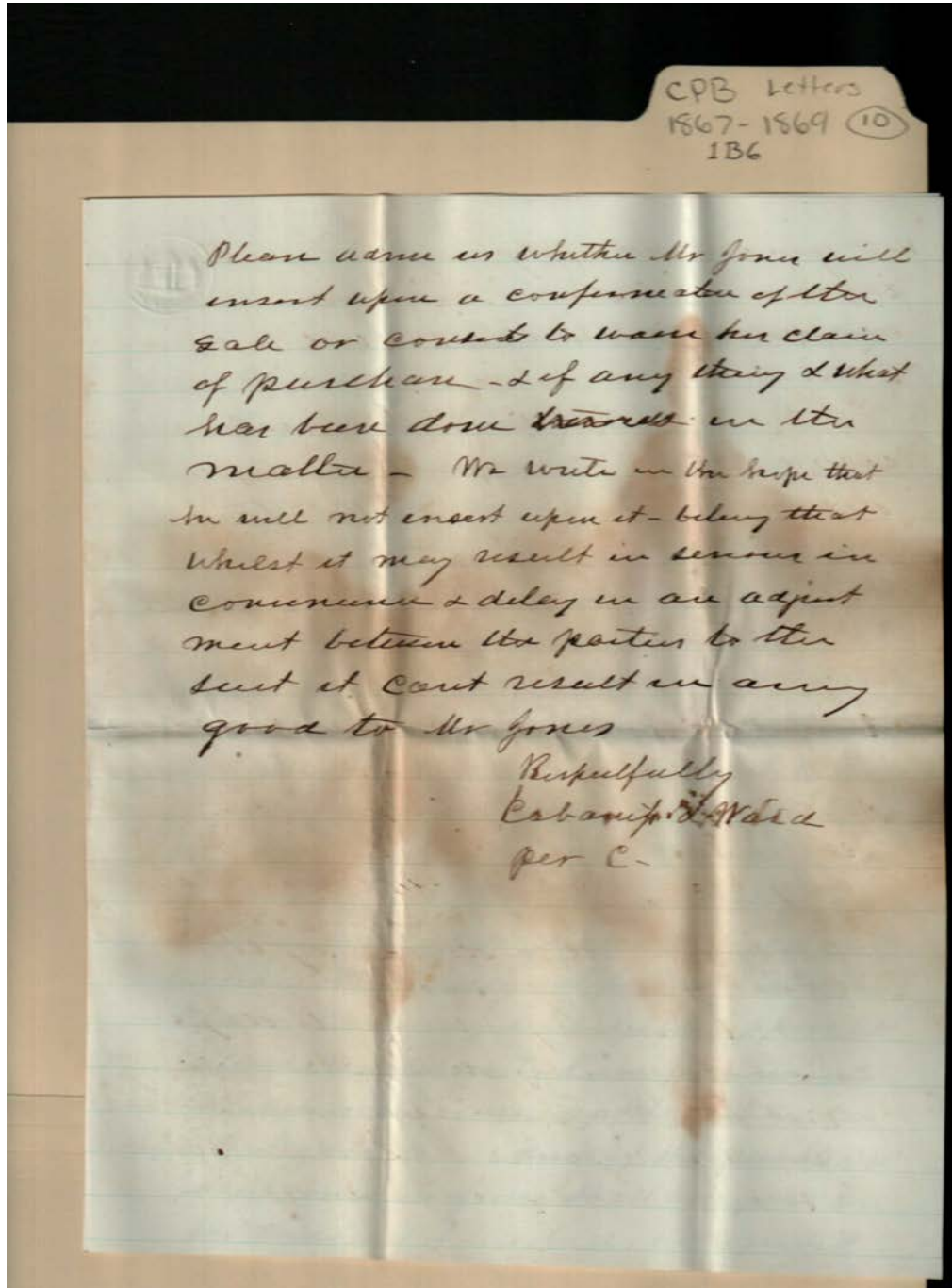

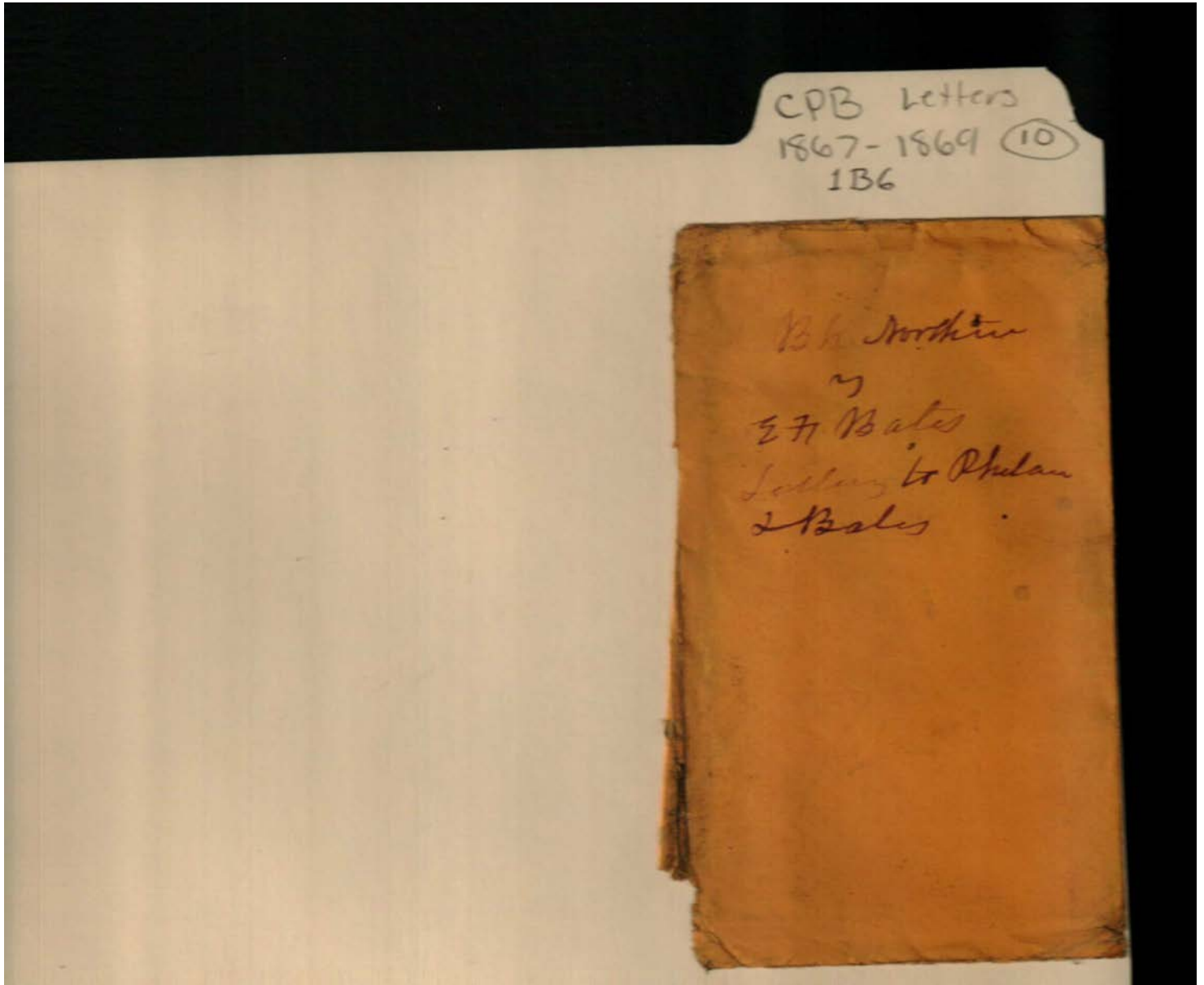

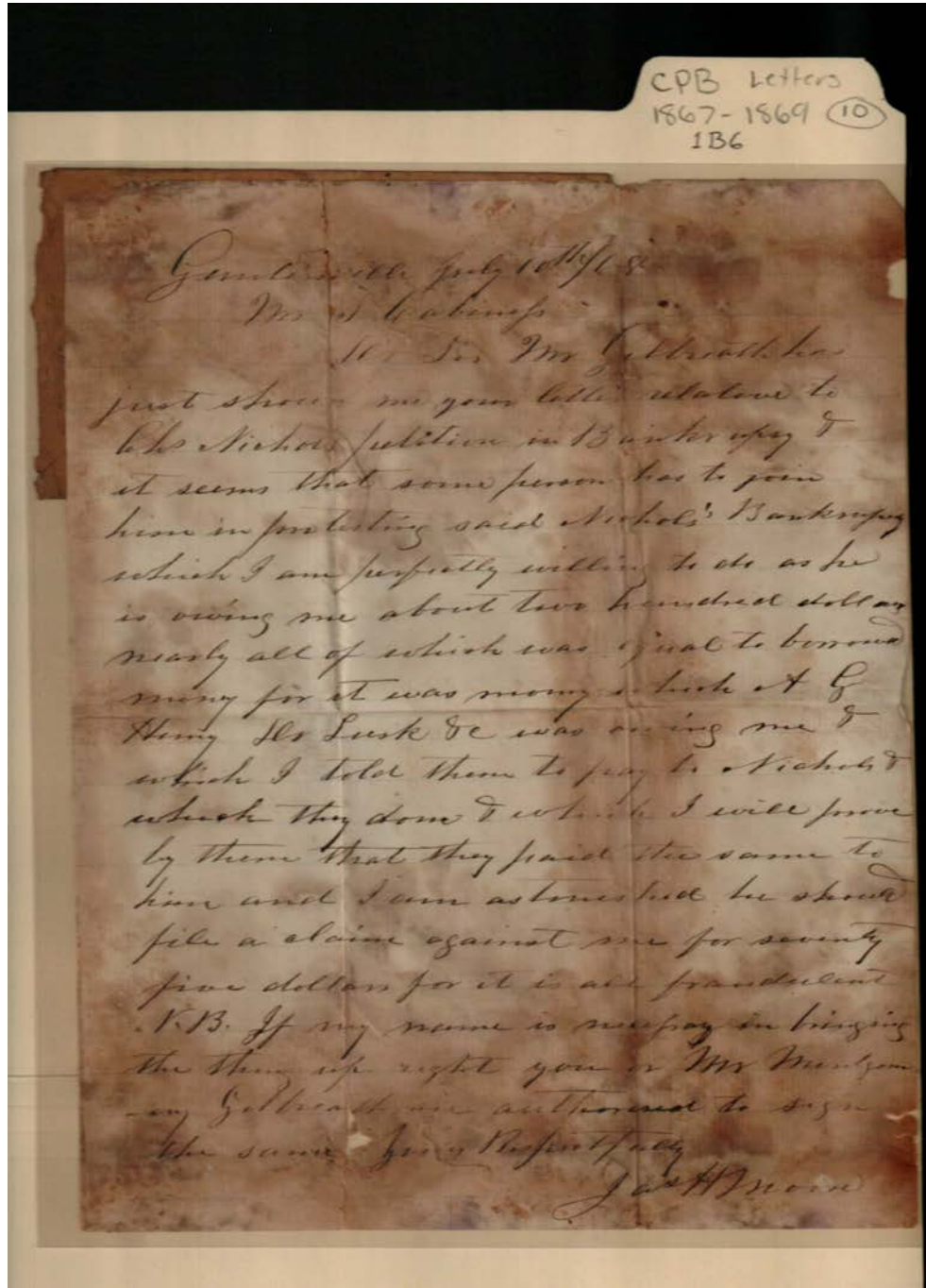
