I shall send my family to McMinnville Warren County Tennessee to spend the summer. They leave here next week. I will bring them down to see you from there as soon as I get time. My wife and both boys have been sick several weeks. I have also been sick for several days and am just getting about again.

I shall be unable to do so however until after our stockholders meeting of August 15th. I am now engaged in making out a full report of the business of the Road from its commencement, which with a full report monthly to the Governor of Tennessee of the operations of the Edgefield & Kentucky keeps me busy. Besides I am building new shops and engine houses one new bridge 500 feet long. have just finished one Depot at Hopkinsville and building two more. and operating the Road gives me consequently I have yours truly H. The Chancellor has in the decree the NW 1/4 & W 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Sec 9 and Sec 8 - Ragland trespasses at an NW 1/4 and W 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Sec 8. - So that Ragland lease out 240 acres of Sec 9, and 1400 acres of Sec 8. in trespass by the decree besides the 100 acres of Sec 6 which the Chancellor left out - This can all be corrected when the Court shall again be in session, and it does not at all affect your authority for the ^{order is} application that the decree shall take possession of the lands described in the bill of Complaint - and the order to you covers all the lands in the bill - It will be but that you shall not mention these discrepancies to any one, lest it might have an undue influence if presented to an ignorant Justice of the Peace - Unless mentioned it is not likely to be noticed by any one -
