Thought Anthony did wrong - but I did not

he no necessity for troubling you with this matter - but I thought I had best explain it to you, and if Mr Grizzard should say to you that he is dissatisfied, perhaps he would remain if he thought I liked him, or really wished it.

If Mr Calhoun will not sell me a lot, or delay answering your letter in a long time, could I not get one from Mr Scruggs?

Perhaps Judge Hale will sell his, but he may ask too much. I would like a lot in your neighborhood, but it does not matter much where I live, (the little time I hope to live in Huntville) - just so it is where I can sell it readily. Mr Ward said he would be ready in six weeks from the time I saw him - it is now nearly gone. Mr Trotman offered me a lot, one opposite Judge Hale's - I do not wish to give a high price for a lot - either of those is near water. I would have to dig a well I suppose if I get a lot from Mr Scruggs - but he would be cheaper, I have no doubt.

As there says would you let Charley come over and stay just one week.

the negroes share 1/4. the cotton crop is very promising indeed. three fourths of mine is now waist high and if the worms do not trouble me I will make eighty bales and probably more. my neighbors think that I will make a hundred. I consider this doing well with but seventeen hands. we have had no "freeman" business to demoralize the negroes and I hope may never have the pleasure that I have heard of is at Columbus. I pay the negroes 1/4 of the corn and cotton for their services for the year and feed them that works they pay all other expenses. I think that I can cultivate one third more land in this way than by paying them money. mine are all satisfied and wish to remain another year. I look for Wm and Linn soon. they will spend the summer with me. Arthur has been boarding in Pickensville and going to school. he is very steady now and one of the most promising boys that I ever saw. Frank stays in Jackson the most of the time. Jim has been here since February doing nothing of course. I have told him several times that he must go to

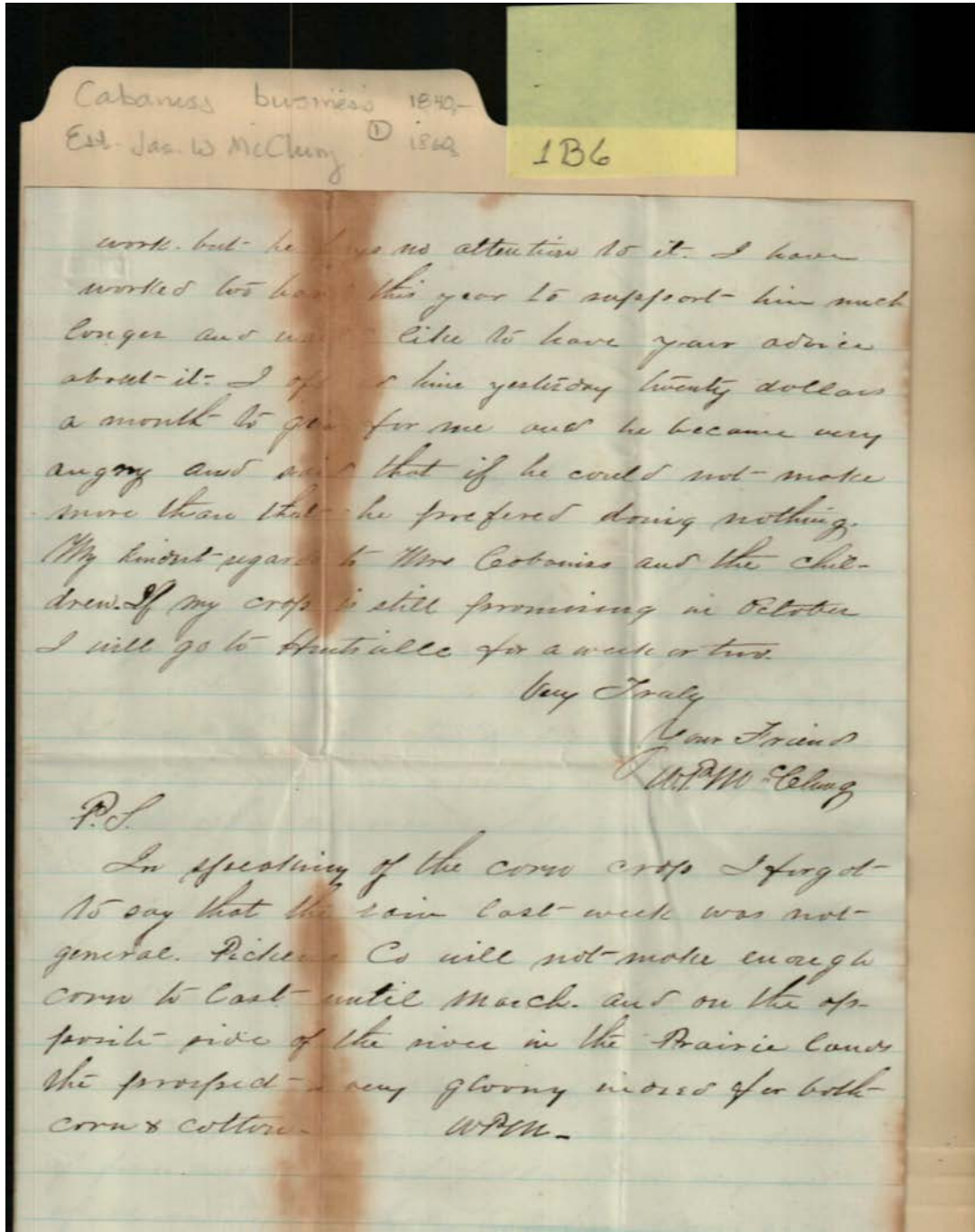
