Woodson has said the time that he is in the mud as to money.

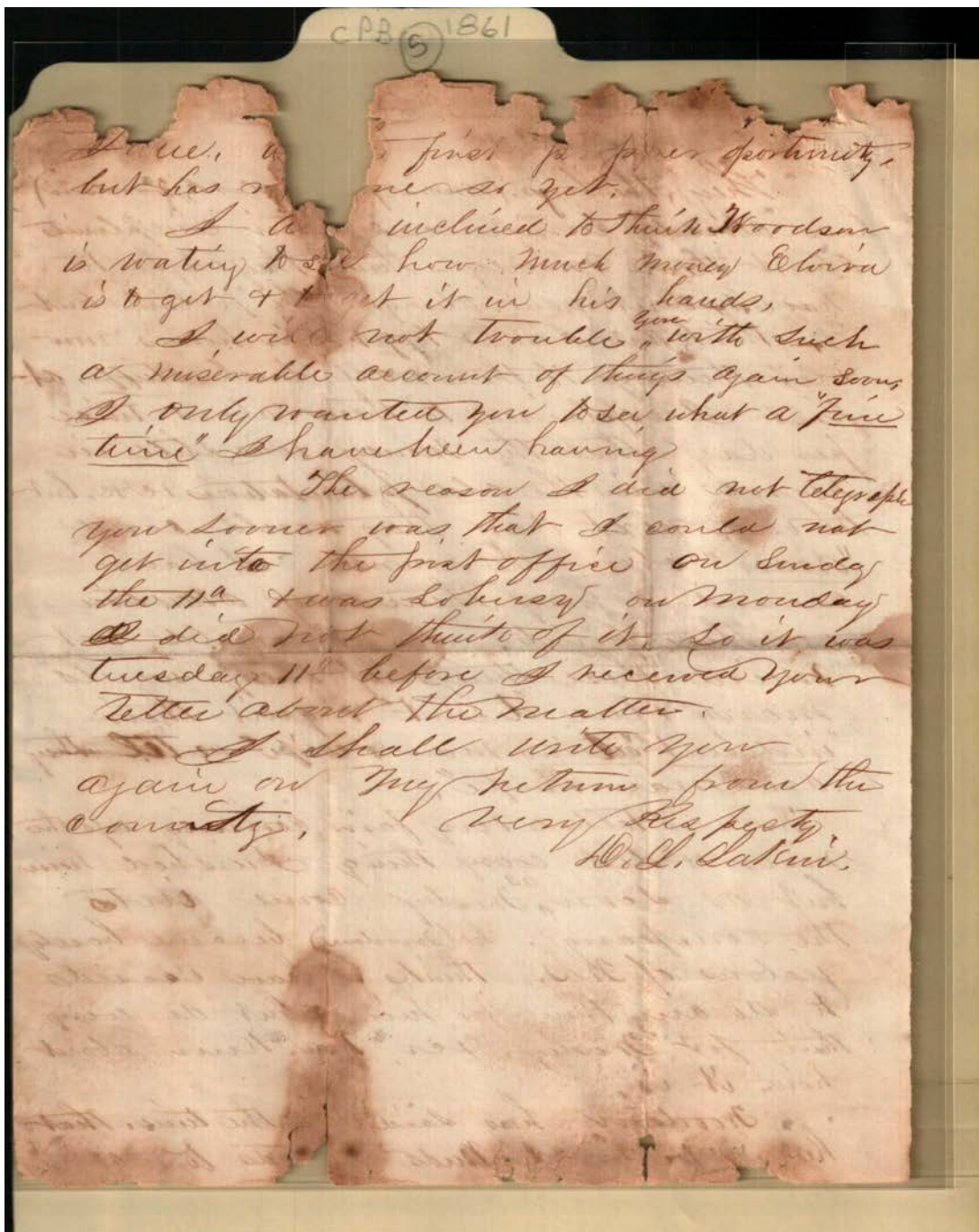
