In October or Nov 1860 - W. F. Kercheval as Atty for Colcock McCalley & Malloy obtained a judgment in Circuit Court of Sevier Co a judgment against Champion E. Smith (as principal debtor & drawer of Bill of Exchange) and three or four other defendants who were Endorsers of the bill - One judgment being obtained against all under Tennessee Statute - Shortly before or after rendition of the judgment Moses Cruse & another of Smiths Endorsers filed a bill in Chancery alleging a fraudulent conveyance by Smith of his property & praying to have it subjected to payment of debt of Colcock McCalley & Malloy for which they were bound - The Defendants to the bill denied the fraud & alleged that they had rescinded the contract - Charged to be fraudulent - I believe no execution was issued on the judgment at law before or during the war, but if issued was returned unsatisfied - In the early part of last year 1867. found that Smith was

was in undisputed possession of a large body of valuable land near Fayetteville, without consulting with Kercheval who was absent, I caused a execution to be issued which was levied upon a tract of 198 acres worth before the war, 30 or 40 ff per acre. Two other execution creditors knowing of this had their executions issued & levied prior to the sale which occurred 1st Monday in May 1867 - At the sale the land was struck off to Colcock & Malloy at \$200 - I did not bid more because I was advised that the other execution creditors would be entitled to share in the proceeds of the sale and my clients Colcock & Malloy did not have the money to pay. The first bid was made under the impression that the others were not entitled to any part of the proceeds of sale - Kercheval advanced the \$200 - and after the sale & within 20 days to guard against redemption by paying per cent money 2 1/2 per cent on it - Kercheval at my suggestion bid either \$1300 or \$1500 more on the judgment which I suppose was credited -

Your favor of yesterday is received. The case in which the bill was received for by Mr. Moore, is *Thompson v. W. Cooper & Ed. King, Esq. Bean et al.* It is a case of law & equity. —

The costs were directed to be paid from the proceeds of sale; and the Commissioner (making report, leaving the amount of costs blank as it was not known. The report was sent to you, and I think Mr. Moore received for his bill of costs, and admitted the amount in the report. What the amount was I do not now recollect, but believe it was over \$200; which we thought very exorbitant. I remember Mr. Beckett was perfectly satisfied with it. —

The representations of C. T. Barton, and others parties were made known to the bill and also Ed. King, after the suit was commenced.
