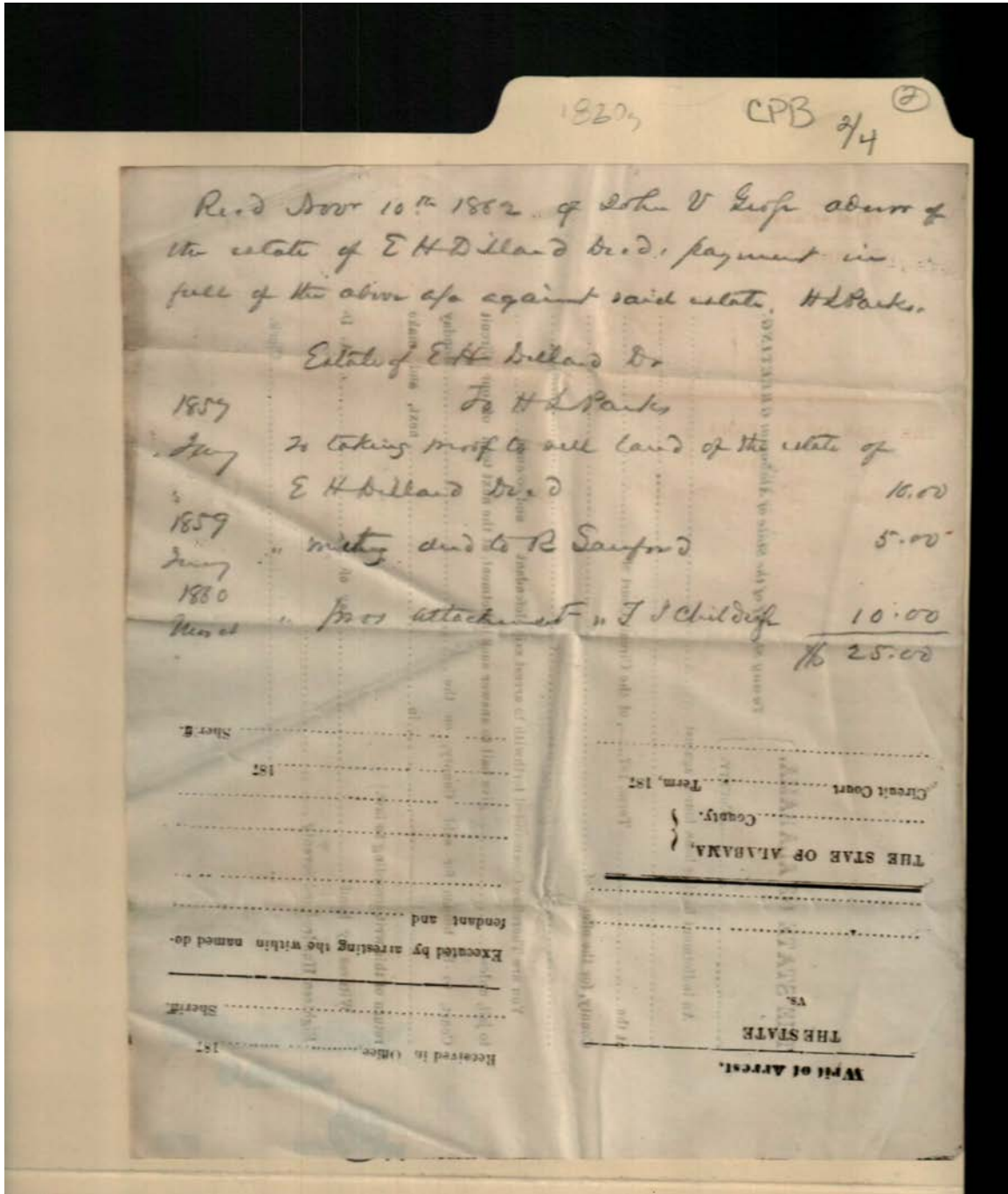

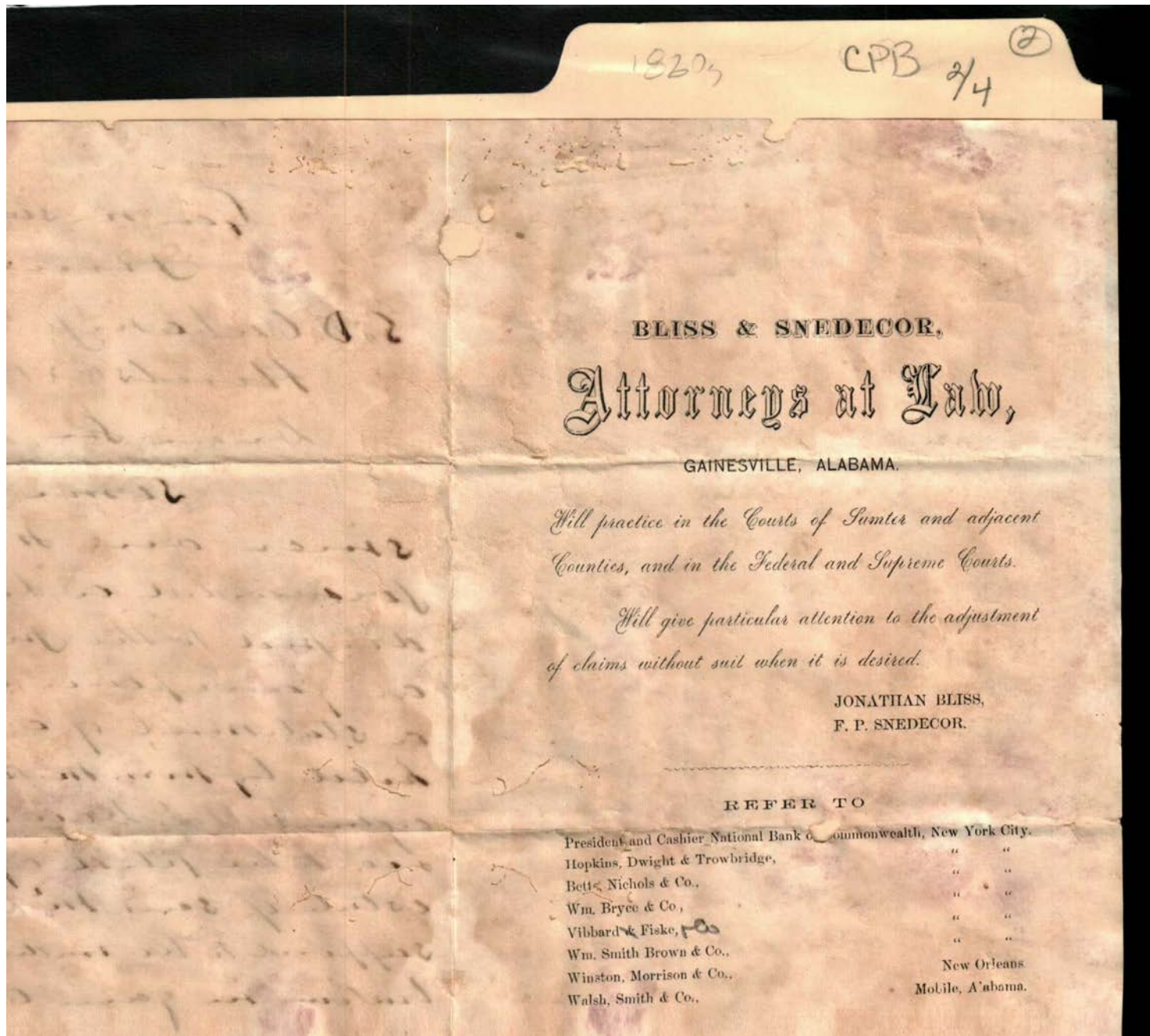

\$250 We James J. Blackmon es
 principal and Martha J. Blackmon
 and William H. Blackmon as his heirs
 jointly & severally promise to pay Septi-
 mus Cabaniss Executor of the estate
 of Saml. Townsend decd two hundred
 and fifty dollars for the rent for
 the year 1869, of the plantation on
 which we now live, one hundred
 dollars of which may be paid in perma-
 nent improvements on buildings on
~~the~~ said lands within the next four
 months, fifty dollars in repairs to
 the fencing outside fence on said
 plantation to be done within the next
 six months, and the balance of one
 hundred dollars to be paid in money
 by the 25th day of December 1869 and
 if there be any deficit in payment in
 repairs or improvements such deficit
 is to be paid in money by the 25th
 December next (1869) - it is hereby
 agreed that said Executor shall have
 a lien on all the crops grown on
 said plantation for the payment
 of the whole rent, and said parties
 the liabilities of the parties herein is
 not to be discharged or diminished
 if said lien shall not be enforced

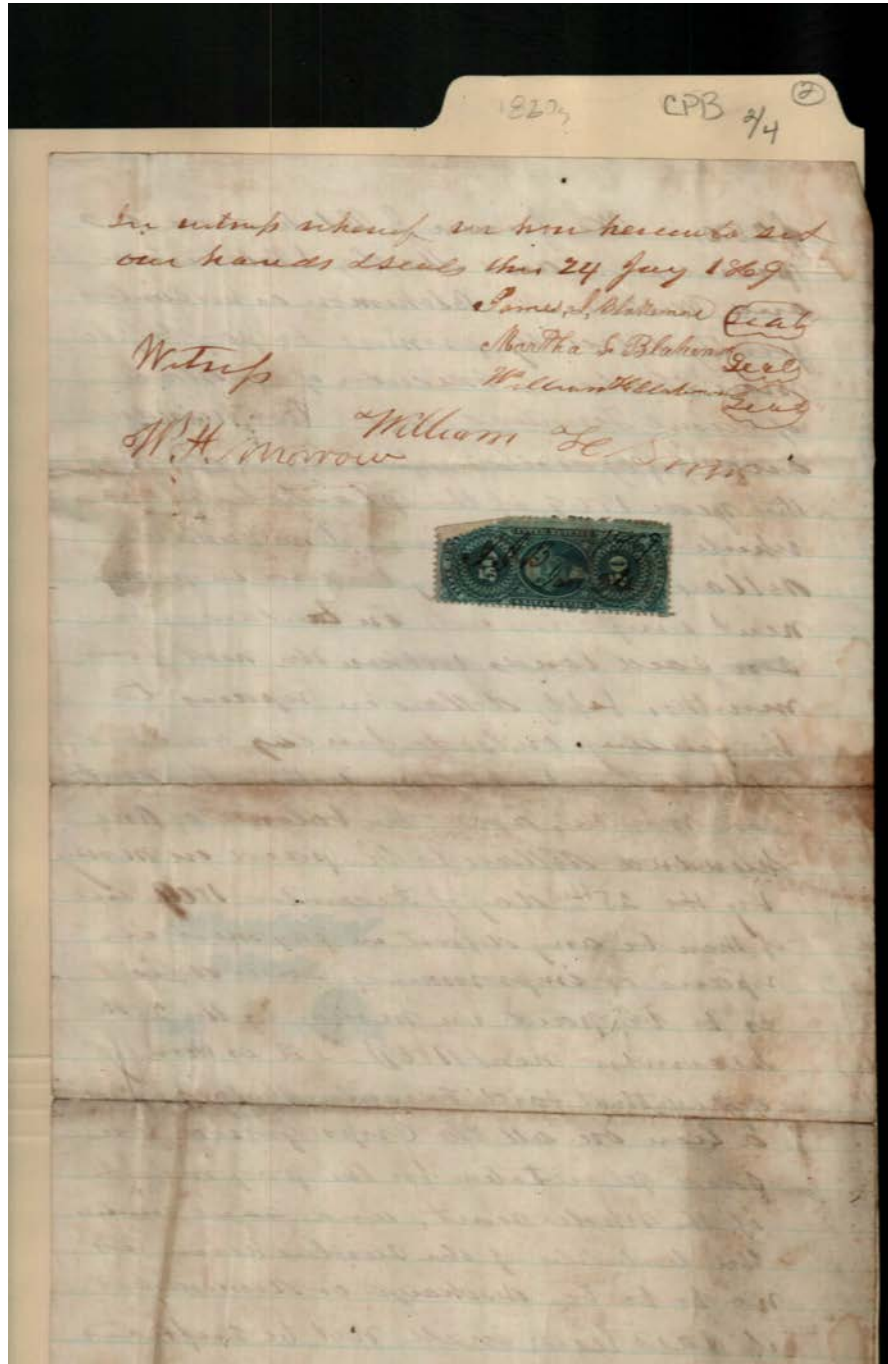
