Statement of William Sanders  
- Tate  
Dear Sir  
In December last I received  
a letter from you and did not return until after your trial  
I learned that Mrs Barbara Hazle was  
a witness against you & that you  
in a matter that she knew me but  
I was one in Mississippi and  
I told me that a certain gentleman had  
been with her - In the month of October  
I went from Madison Ala. to Marshall county  
at Jacobs Eshamungo county & ones with  
you and went in company with him to the  
place where the witness is the daughter of  
her name Mrs Barbara Hazle who had  
childhood and spent the night  
I suppose Mrs Hazle in conversation  
told that in June 1848 you robbed  
a man who lived in East Tennessee &  
I suppose Sawyer during the  
winter or spring had gone South with a  
lot of horses and on his way sold you a horse for  
\$200 & I believe he paid on his return home  
I suppose he called at your house and was  
told that you got from him a gelding  
which was called Charley - The details  
of the particulars of the murder  
I suppose she was sleeping up stairs and that latter  
part she was awaked by a noise & on going  
down stairs found that it was at the office that  
you had shot out of the window at the west end of the  
office - Tate walk out of the office &
