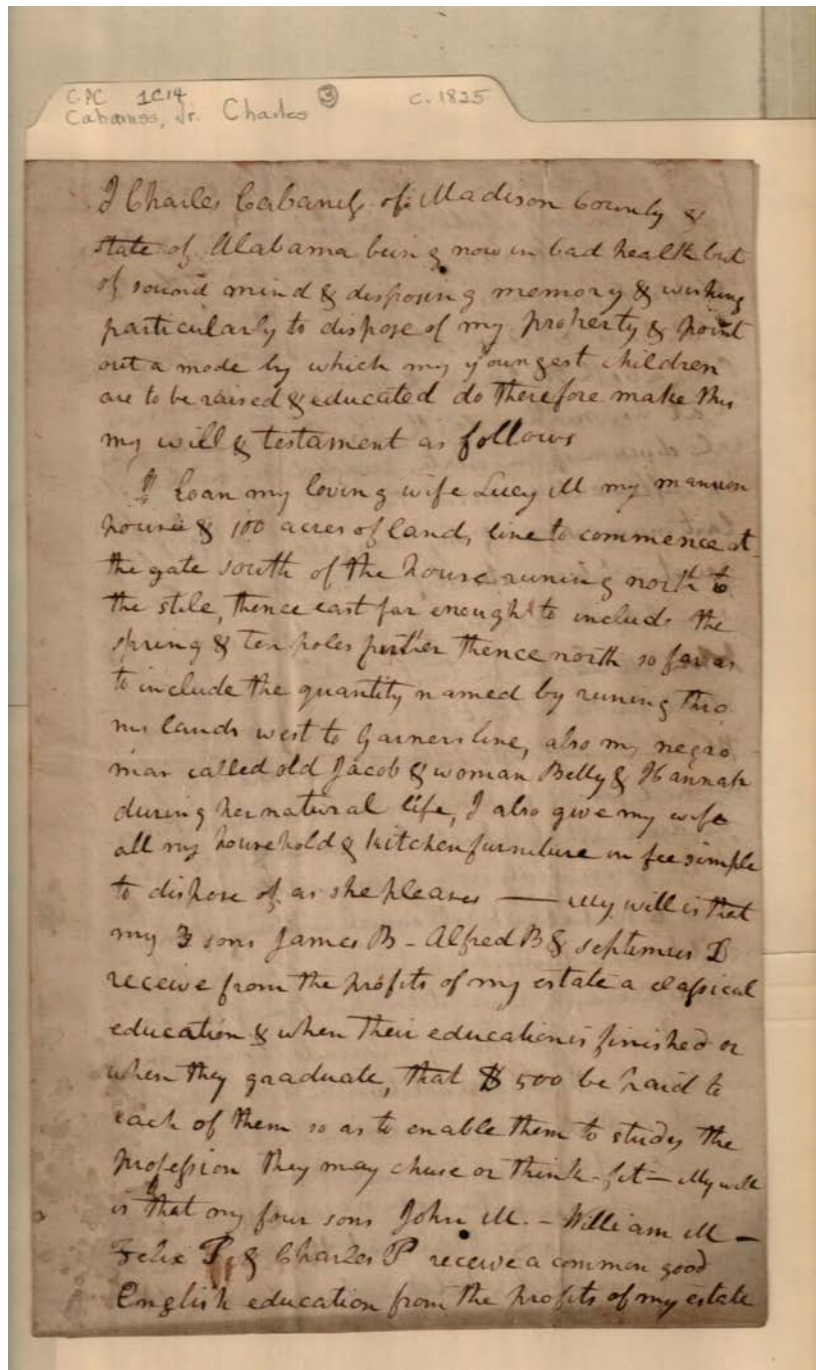

I as each of them becomes of lawful age shall receive from my estate in properly a money \$2500 if the estate will admit of it, to my son Felix I give \$1000 more than to the others to be received when he is 21 years of age — To my daughter Elizabeth I give \$1500 when she marries or at her mother's death, also \$1000 at the general division of my estate, provided my estate will be sufficient to divide the like sum to my four last named sons & my daughters, the last bequest is to bear interest from my death — To my son James B. & my friends John H. Allen & John M. Leake in trust for the use & to be applied for the support of my daughter Martha Allen, a negro girl named Jane a boy named John & a woman named Mary with her children all of which I value at \$1700. also at the general division of my estate enough more to make her part equal with any of my children under the same trust & at her death to be divided equally amongst her children if she has any if not to be equally distributed between my children or their representatives — To my daughter Sarah H. White a negro girl named Elvira, also two notes of \$700 also the rent of my plantation near Huntsville for the year 1824 at \$500 which notes, rents negro &c. I value at \$1700 including some household & kitchen furniture & at the

general division of my estate enough more to make her part equal with any of my children - My will is that when my youngest living son arrives to the age of 21 years that a general division of my estate take place & all or any money left after the bequest heretofore made be equally divided between all my living children or their heirs, I would be further understood that I value a classical education at \$2000 which I have in my last bequest directed to be given 3 sons, it being my intention to make all my children equal except Felix & to whom I have given \$1000 more, I therefore direct my executors that if in their opinion that my estate will not hold out to meet the bequests, that they give ^{such} portions only to my children as may be justified by my property, so as at the general division of my estate all my children shall share alike according to the foregoing calculations, my further will is that at the death of my wife Lucy & the land & negroes I loan her be disposed of as the balance of my estate herein directed - I herein direct that my son James B. & my friends John A. Allen & John M. Leake be executors to this my will & also guardians to my infant children - This will is written second & witnessed the 8th day of March 1825 after one with very little alteration which was made in 1824 when I was in perfect health
