has wrought among the students; I can scarcely recognize the men who have been boarding with me since the beginning of the session. And, to believe them, not one has looked into a book since the 20th of March. We had about 30 students in the Med - class which formerly numbered about 100. I expect that a good many of them will reach here to-morrow & on Monday, but a number of them have gone to Philadelphia in order to begin a summer course of Lectures. I have not yet learned how the other classes stand in point of numbers, but I believe the highest estimate is, that there will be 400 students who will finish at the session. The Catalogue has been delayed for 2 months in consequence of the suspension, but will be out in a few weeks now, when I will send you one. I was surprised a good deal on reading Dr. Maupin's Circular, the other day, to see that he states only 15 deaths in all among the students. Of course I was not personally acquainted with all who died since October - but I have heard the students name & count 19 deaths before the suspension, & two died on the Sabbath before I started to N. C.

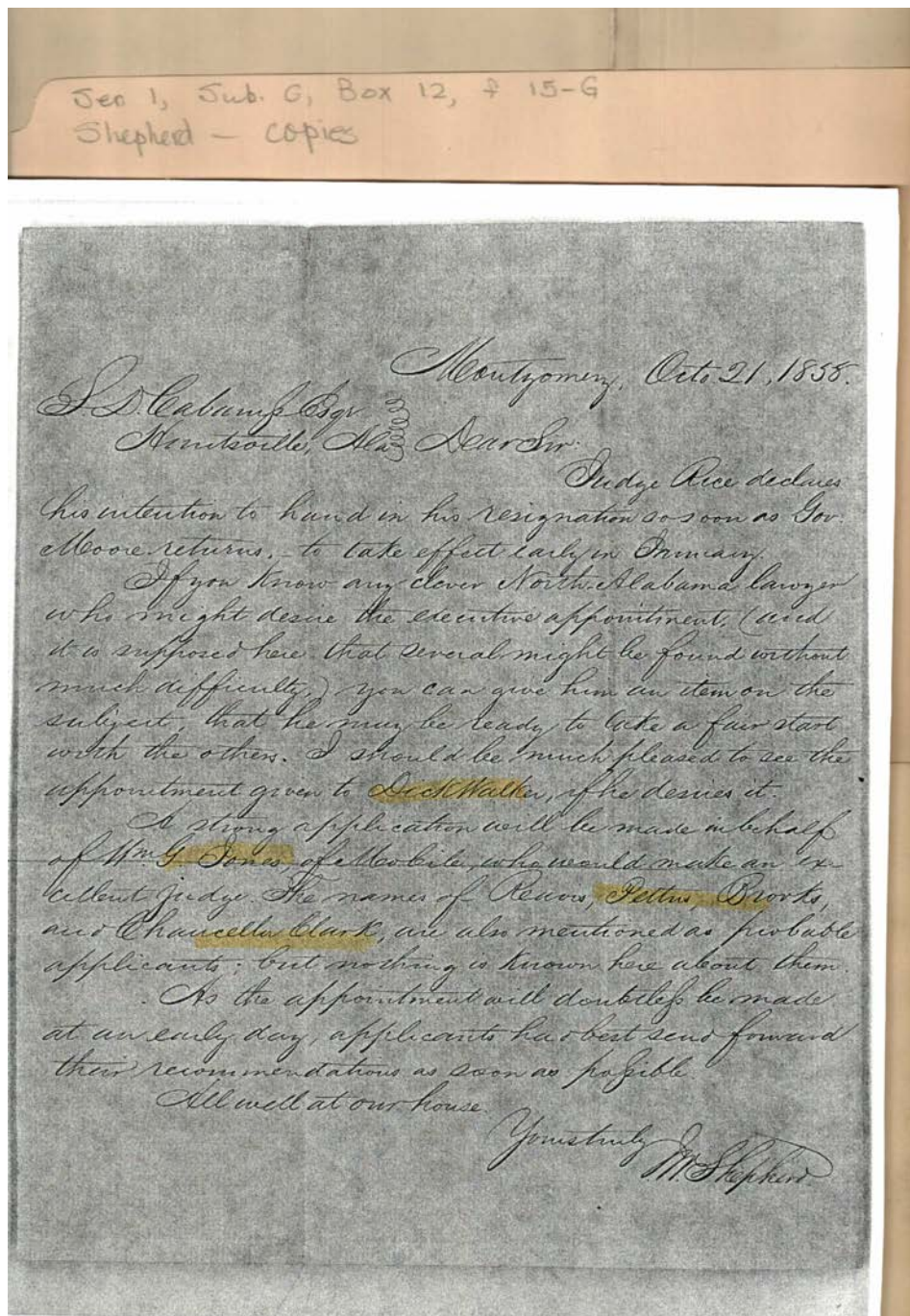

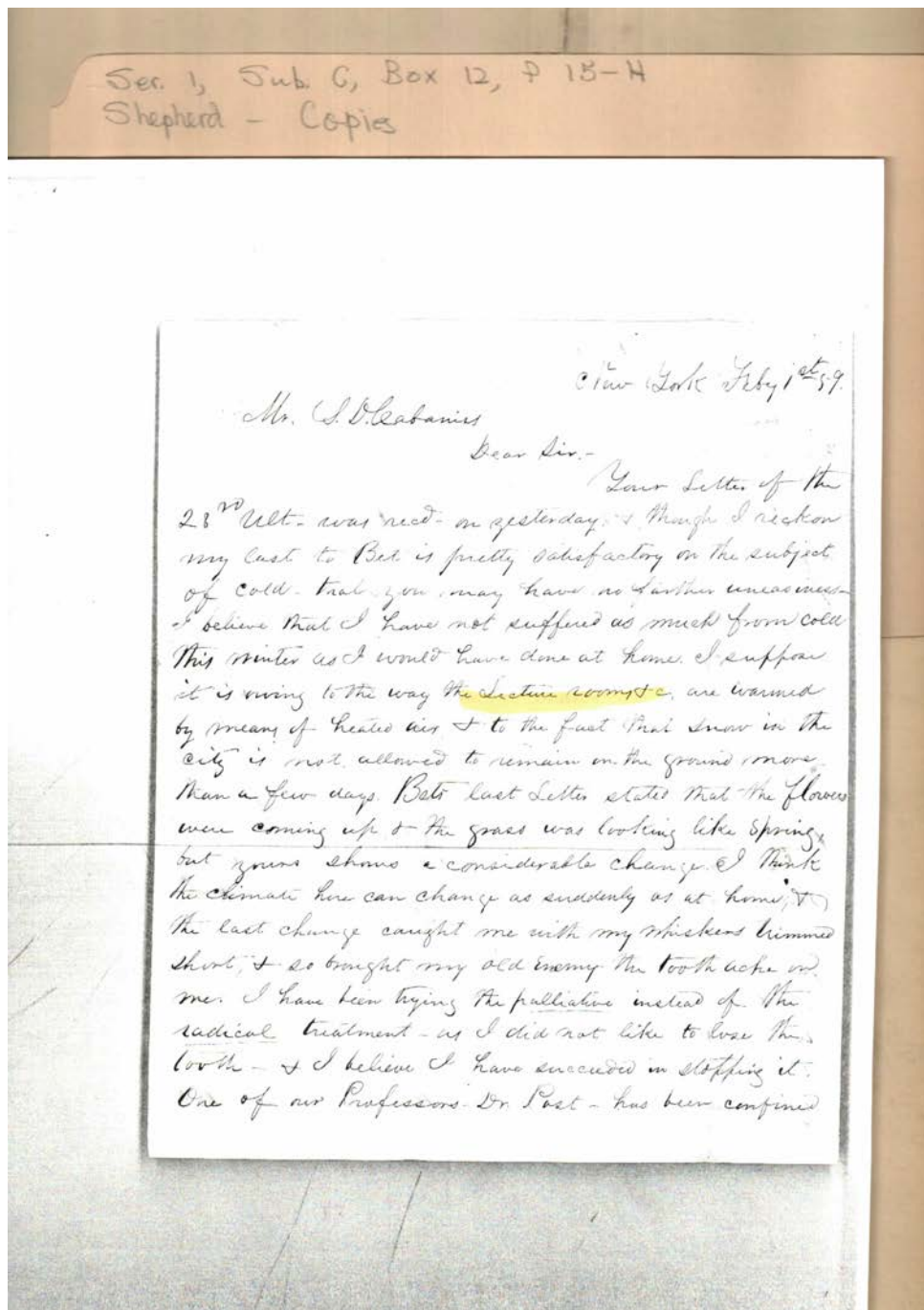
