I noticed a few mistakes in your letter which I will try to correct before I present any farther, so far that I should forget it.
You use the word diff instead of diff. You say "having eat" instead of "having eaten"; and I corrected this same mistake once before. In another place you say, "If diffier had not wrote. I should have wrote." Now you know well enough that this is wrong, and also, what is right, and therefore I shall not take the trouble of telling you. I only noticed one mistake in your spelling, though that is one for many. You spell the word "feeling" "feelin". There were all the mistakes that I noticed in your letter, and though they are not so numerous as those in your previous letters, yet nearly all of them would never have occurred, if you had taken any pains.
You said that you wanted me to send you a few ideas, with which you might commence a letter to Constantin Harrison. If you do not wish to acknowledge any such relationship with him, I have never written to him myself, and am therefore in all probability, as bad off for ideas as you are. I hope you will write to him nevertheless.
How much for your letter and its contents, and now I am sending it a long, what I shall fill the rest of my letter with. Local is an exceedingly rare commodity in New Haven and has been for some time. I suppose you have been all expectation for the last few weeks, waiting for my previous account of Fasset's trial. I attended the Court House from the commencement until the close of the session, so that I was able to hear the whole of it, and had the satisfaction of being of hearing, he would get up and state that Fasset was very sick at home (Philadelphia) and that many of the witnesses for the defense could not attend the trial, &c. &c. in consideration of all which circumstances his trial was postponed until the next session of the Superior Court, which takes place on August, at which time I hope to be at Springfield, and attend

every evening (night) for the last two or three weeks. Now as they
were both very anxious to carry this election, because (with the
exception of Maryland) it was the first that was to be held since
this year, and was, as it were, the opening of the campaign of 1844,
and they flattered themselves, that the result of the Connecticut
election, will have quite an important bearing, in determining
the votes of the other States. Both parties, on the 1st of April, had
decided, by a caucus of giving the victory to the day was Election
day, and the return from the whole State, then, was received, (the
result was as follows.

Baldwin (the Whig Candidate) got 27,000 votes, while
Cleveland (the Democratic Candidate) got 26,000 votes, leaving Baldwin
a majority over Cleveland, of about 1,000. Besides this, there were
about 40,000 votes polled for the Abolitionists, and they were therefore
not elected for Governor, by the people, on account of the Abolition
votes, and this has been the case for the last thirty years.

The Governor will now be chosen by the Legislature, which
is composed of the House of Representatives, and of the
Senate, of 35 members, and 12 Senators. There are 35 towns
which have made an election, for the Senate, 10 out of 35 are
Whigs. Last year the Whigs had 10 out of 35, and the Democrats
had 25. In the Senate the two parties are now divided, and
which they now are, the Democrats have 10 out of 35, and the
Whigs have 25. The Whig Candidate, will this year be chosen of course,
and a Committee will go for Clay, and the Democrats will go for
Abolition, as the Whigs say, and the Democrats are of course for
Clay, and the Whigs are of course for Abolition. The party has
much to boast of, for it was a very closely contested election,
though the Whigs, have to be sure gained a good many votes.
