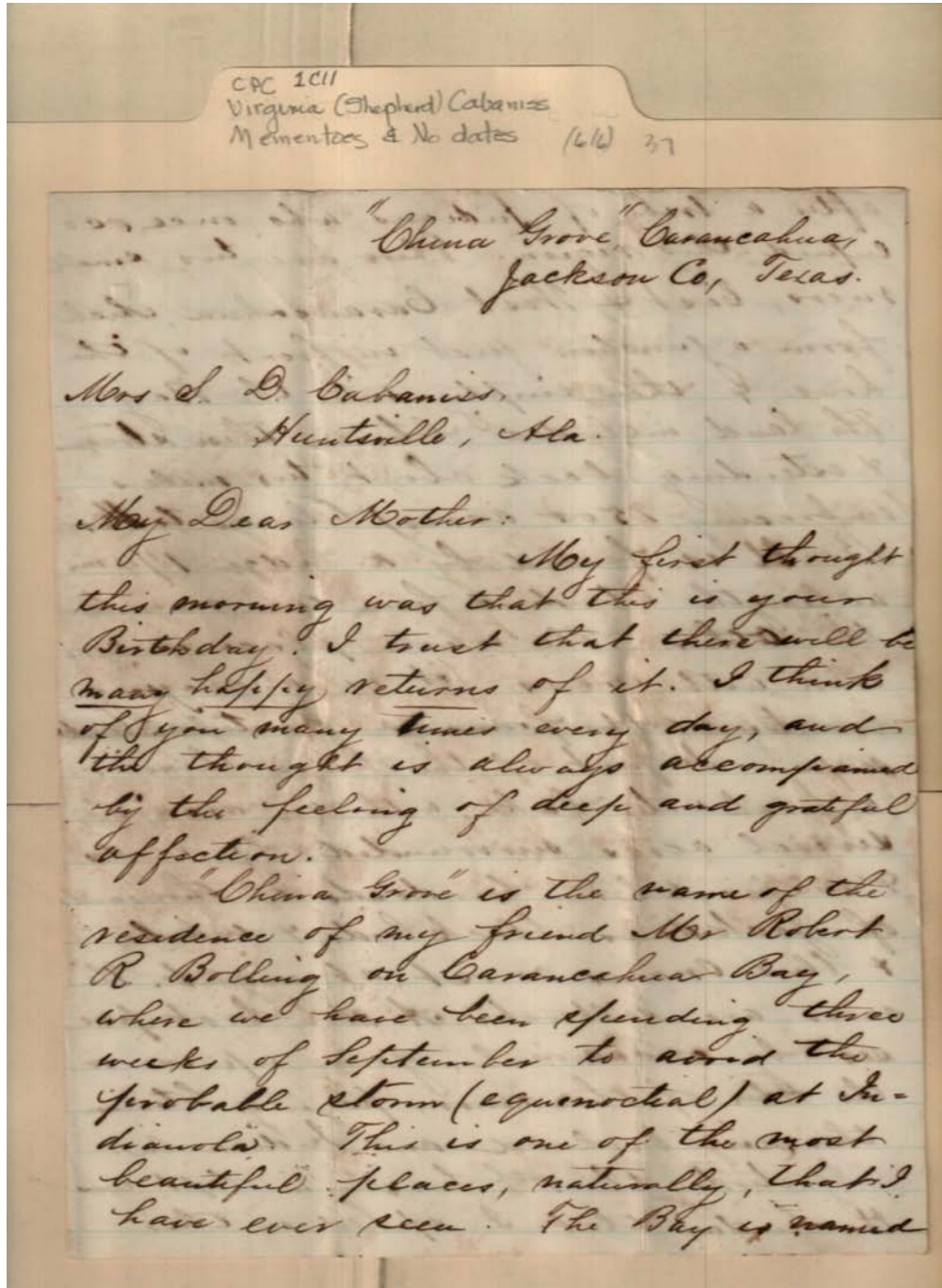

after a tribe of Indians, who once occupied this region. There are two small rivers, East & West Caranacahua, which form a junction just in front of the house, & then empty into the Bay. The land included between these streams & extending back about two miles (embracing 2500 acres) belongs to Mr. B. It is fenced by a hedge $1\frac{1}{4}$ mi in length extending from one river to the other. The whole place is covered with grass (it is a grazing country) and forms a beautiful landscape. In front of the house there is a fresh water lake, with an area of several acres, surrounded by reeds & rushes, where hundreds of thousands of Jackdaws, black birds & white & blue cranes roost at night. The rivers are saltwater. A sail boat passes by occasionally, going up one or the other of the rivers, plying between this neighborhood and Indianola. Yesterday, the 5th Sunday in Sept. was the Sunday that I spend in this

neighborhood, officiating at a church,
4 miles distant. I have service here
only when a fifth Sunday occurs.
Mr. Bolling pays me \$25. for
a Sunday's services, making \$100. in
the course of the year. He presented
me yesterday with a pony, a first
rate one, indeed, the most valuable
one that he had. He is 14 hands
high (Texas horses are nearly all small)
iron-grey, black mane & tail well
broken & gentle, named Gray Eagle,
5 years old. He is a good saddle
horse & is learning to work in Lan-
cass. He will be of great service to
me. We will return in the course
of a week to Indianola and will
spend a month there & then will
probably settle at Victoria for the
winter. I would prefer Hildred as a
place of residence if it had a
Rail Road. I hope that one will
be built soon.
