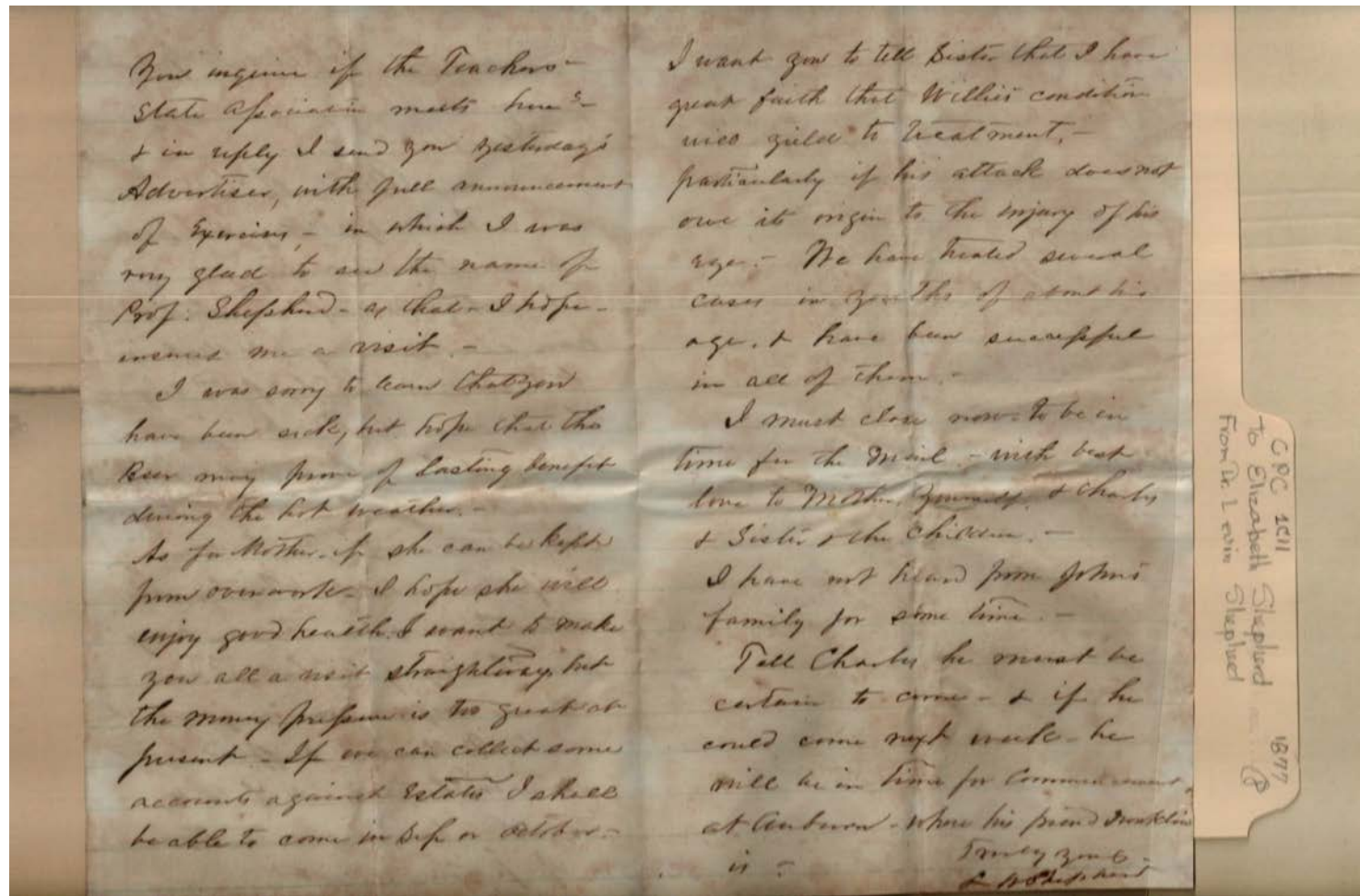

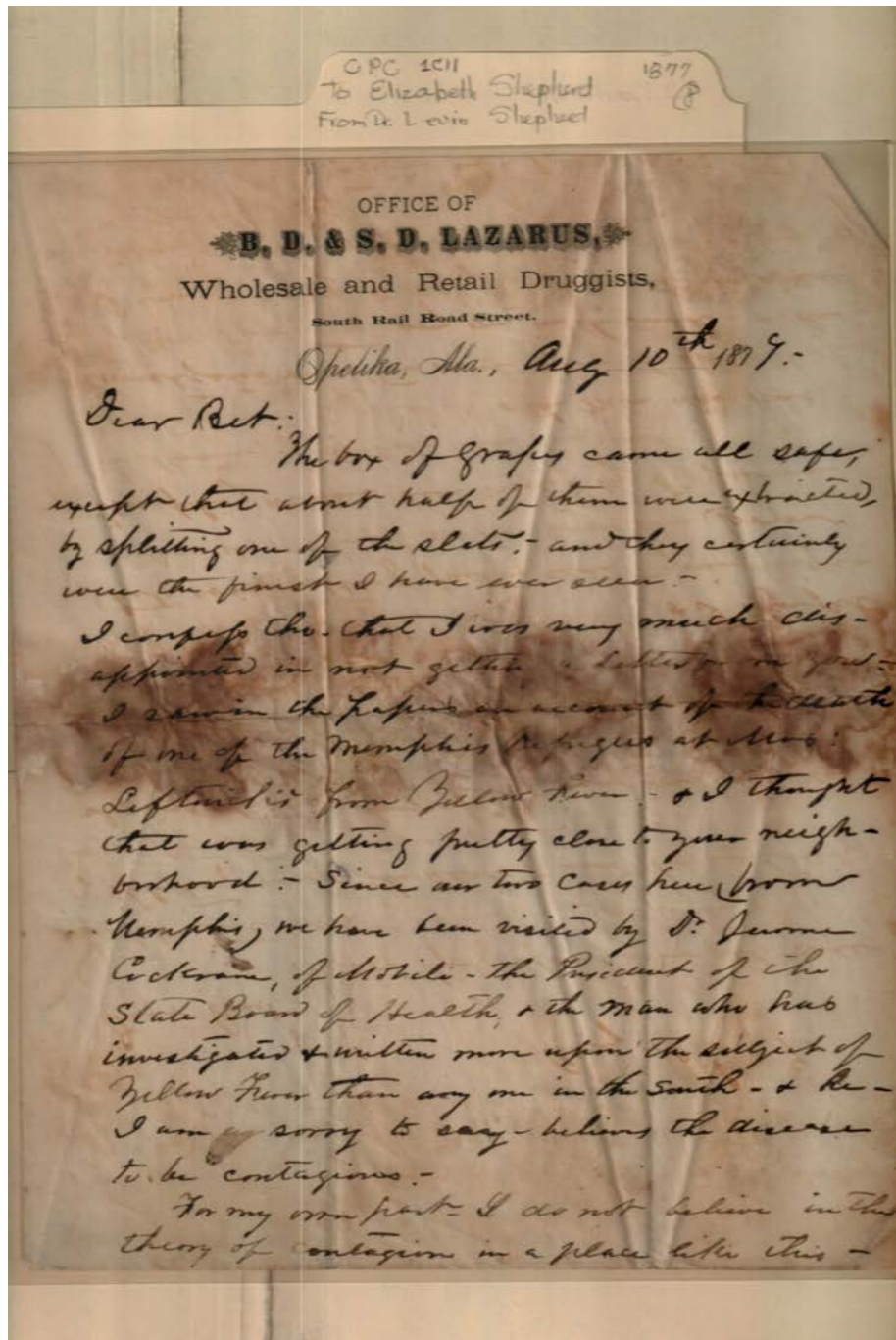

I am kept quite busy in the practice -

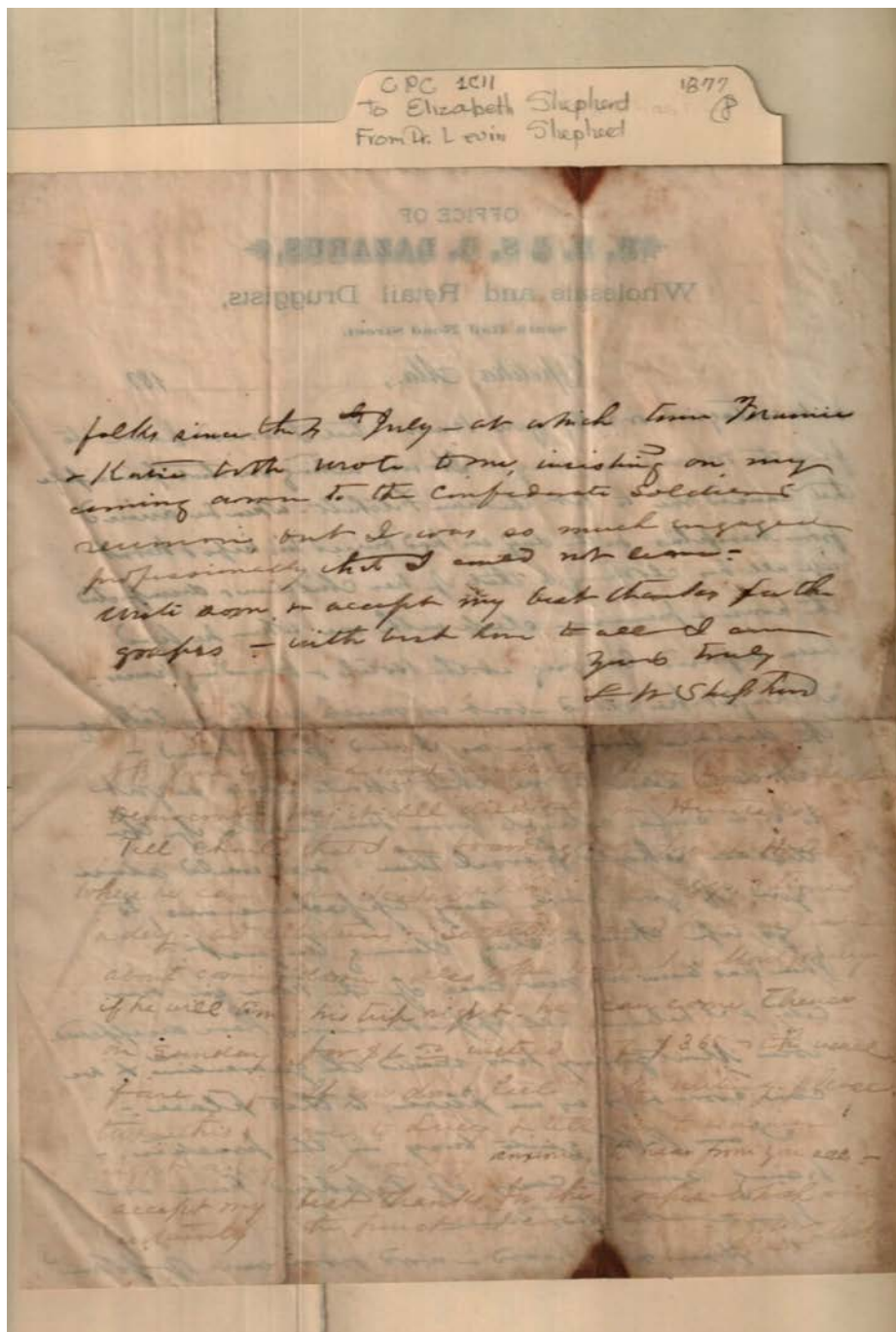
