A FUNERAL DISCOURSE.

Psalm 37th, verse 37. Mark the perfect man and behold the upright: for the end of that man is peace.

The duty devolving upon me this day, is one of peculiar delicacy. I am called, in the providence of God, as a minister of the sanctuary, identified, also, with this community in all its interests and its trials, to attempt the task of leading your minds in such a train of reflection as may stimulate you to the exertion necessary to secure enduring benefit from the unexpected event which has almost overwhelmed a bereaved family, and has sent a thrill of painful emotion through this whole community.

In the noon-tide of his days, in the pride of his strength, in the zenith of his usefulness, has fallen one, known to you all, esteemed and respected of all,—and by all who truly knew him, personally loved:—for, the lamented Judge Hitchcock was too active, too influential, too benevolent, to be unknown to almost any one in the city of his residence. Of all that I may utter, you are, therefore, all competent to judge: and from some of the most intelligent among you, have already issued public testimonials to his worth, which might well lead me to pause at the very threshold of my undertaking, as one needless and hazardous; did I not recollect, that there are in his character points of peculiar importance, which ought to be distinctly presented, and which can, in this way alone, be set forth with the prominence they merit:—and did I not recollect also, that if they who hear me may be regarded as accurate judges of the picture now to be drawn, they themselves sympathize too deeply in the spirit of the mournful occasion, to leave room for fear that they will prove rigid critics on its defects. Believe me, while I do not disclaim the partiality towards the deceased, which a warm, an admiring, a grateful friendship may be supposed to inspire, I shall aim, at least, to be strictly just. I shall hazard no assertion, which I do not believe to be true to the letter.

You who have waited on my ministry for years, know that it is not my custom to indulge in eulogy on the dead. But on this occasion, if I speak at all of the deceased, it must be in terms of eulogy. His virtues were many, and they stood out in bold relief; vices he had none: and though, unquestionably, as a man, a more man, imperfections he must have had; yet, in all candour, I declare, they have totally escaped my notice. I know not of one fault with which I can charge his memory; unless a too great modesty be that fault.

The propriety of delivering funeral discourses has been questioned by some. Generally speaking, I think the practice injudicious. But, when one distinguished for his station, his influence and his usefulness is called away, the case is peculiar. Such a man is public property: his reputation is a legacy to the community; and there is a propriety in giving a more public and impressive notoriety to the event of his removal. Nature itself teaches mankind that the memory of the distinguished is to be cherished, and their virtues are to be pointed out to the notice of survivors that they may be aroused to emulate their virtues and copy their example. The rude savage finds no means so effectual to excite the ardour and fire the
