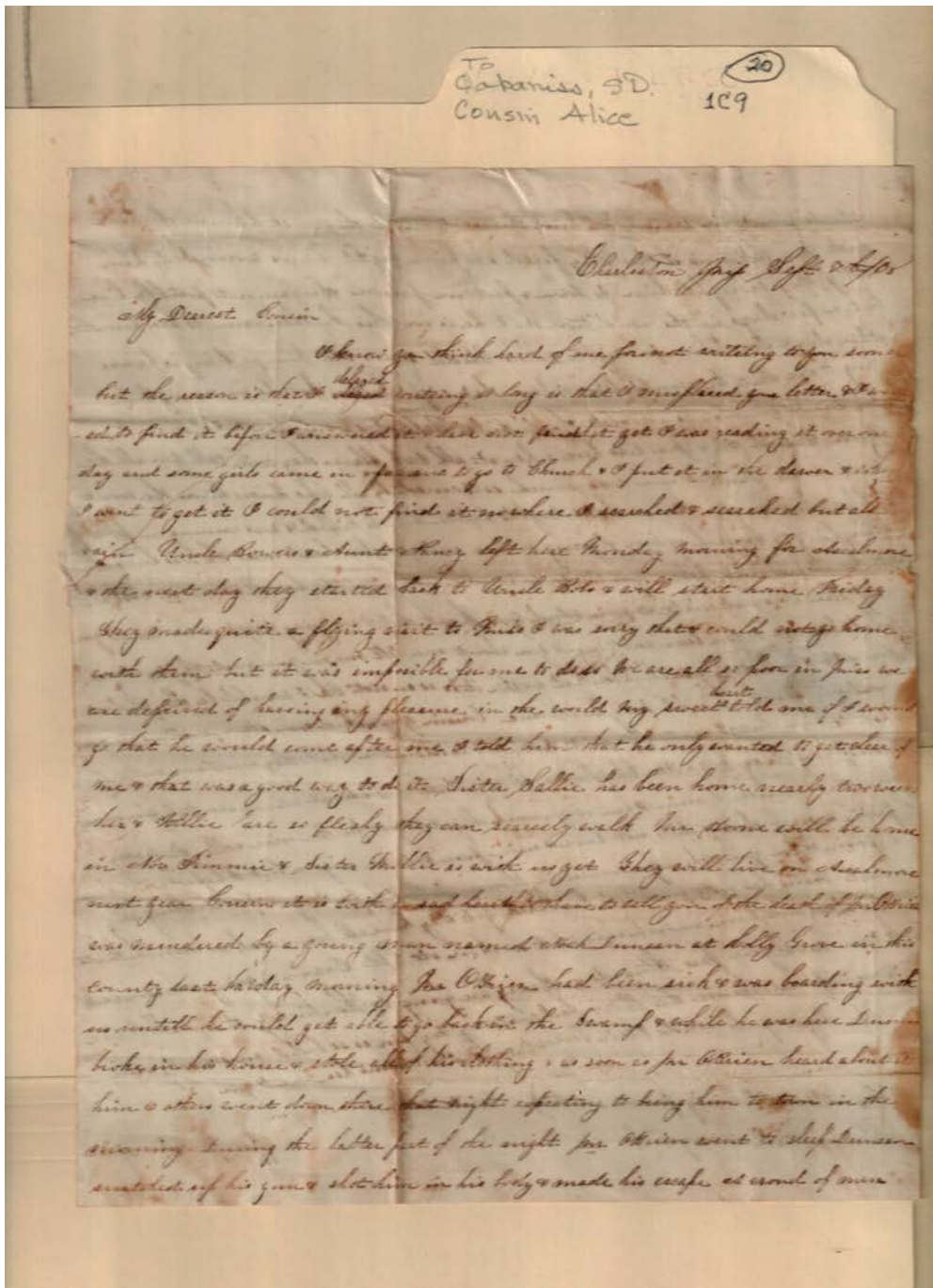

a present for you when you come a thousand thanks for to you for working my
last time has not finished her tent yet they have all been sick so much that
she does not have much chance to work on it. Let Cousin signing to move back
to town next year Mrs Stewart & Perry are going to Kentucky this fall to live
Cousin please excuse this letter I had to stop my pen as so but I can scarcely write
The boys & girls send their love they both return her love to you
I hope do not let any person see this Write very soon to you
