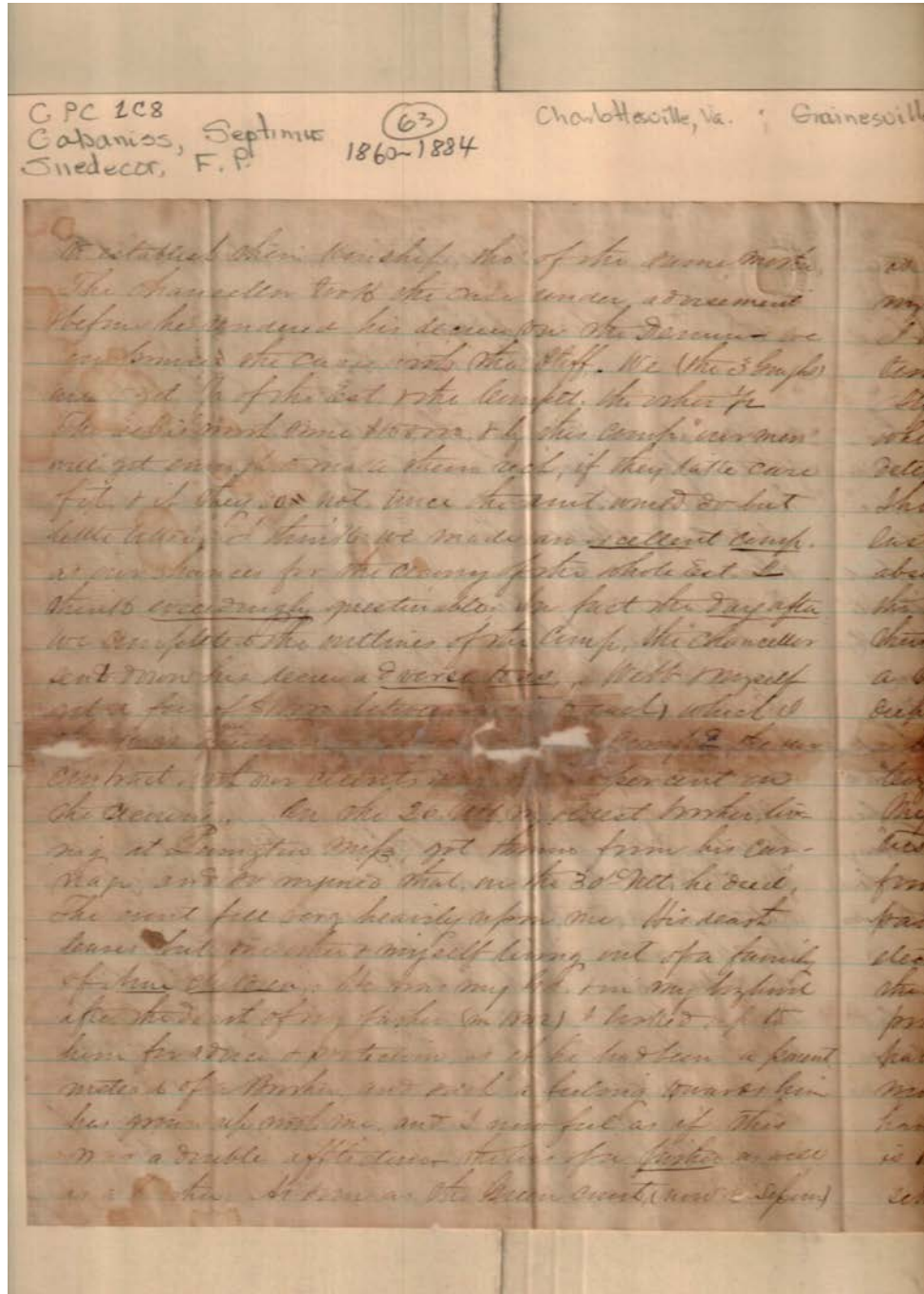

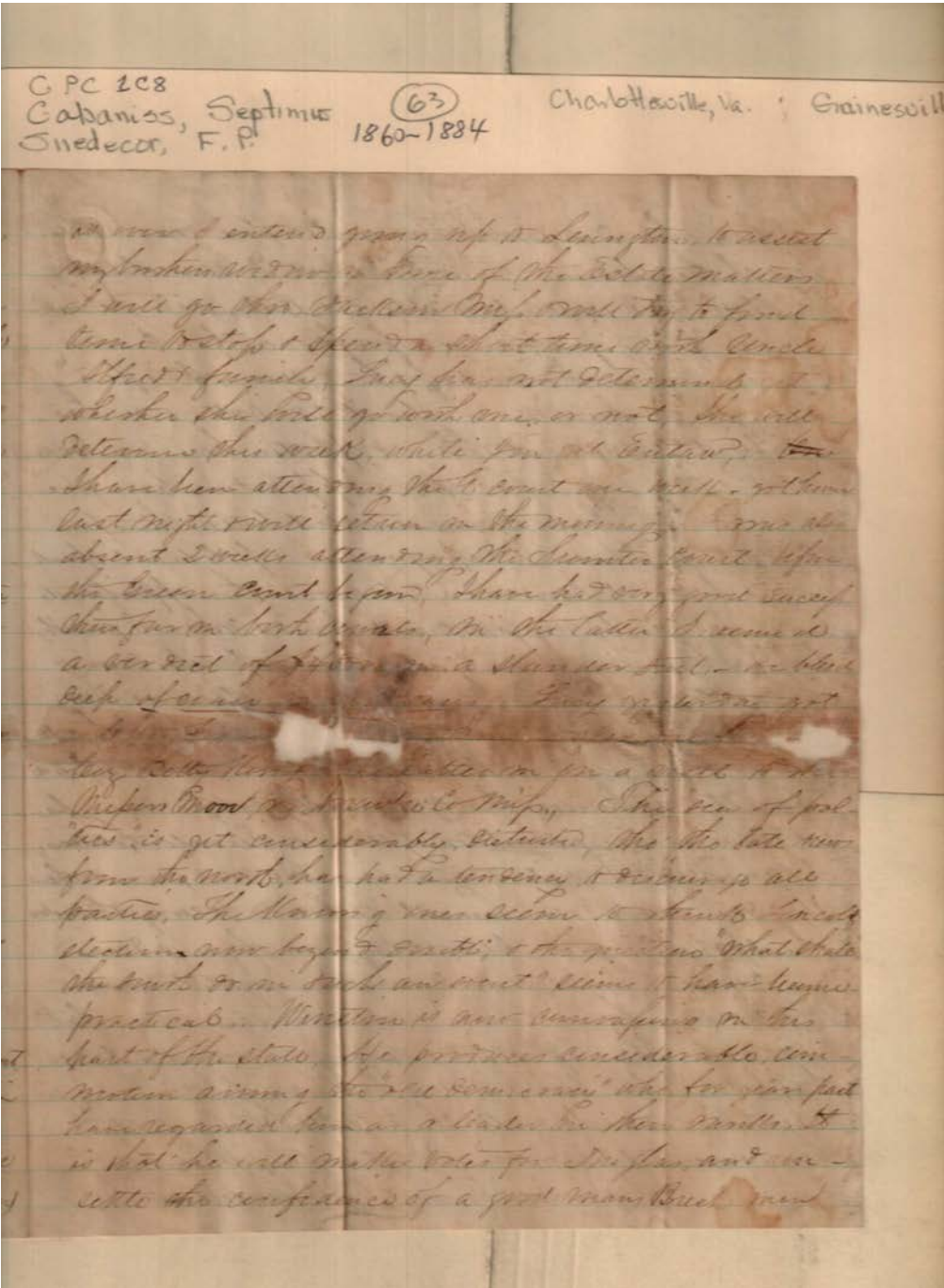

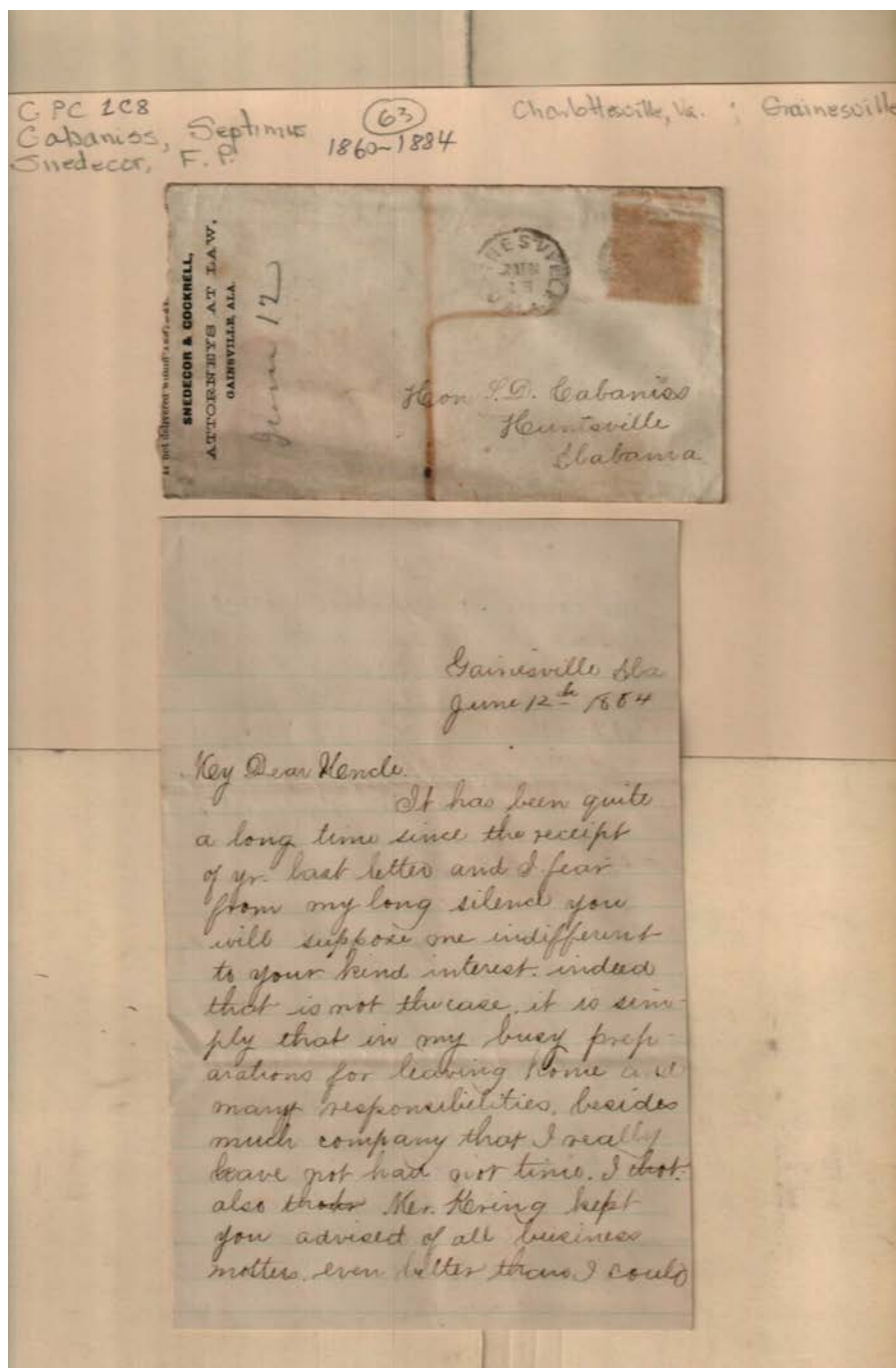
I have heard a great many Whigs men say

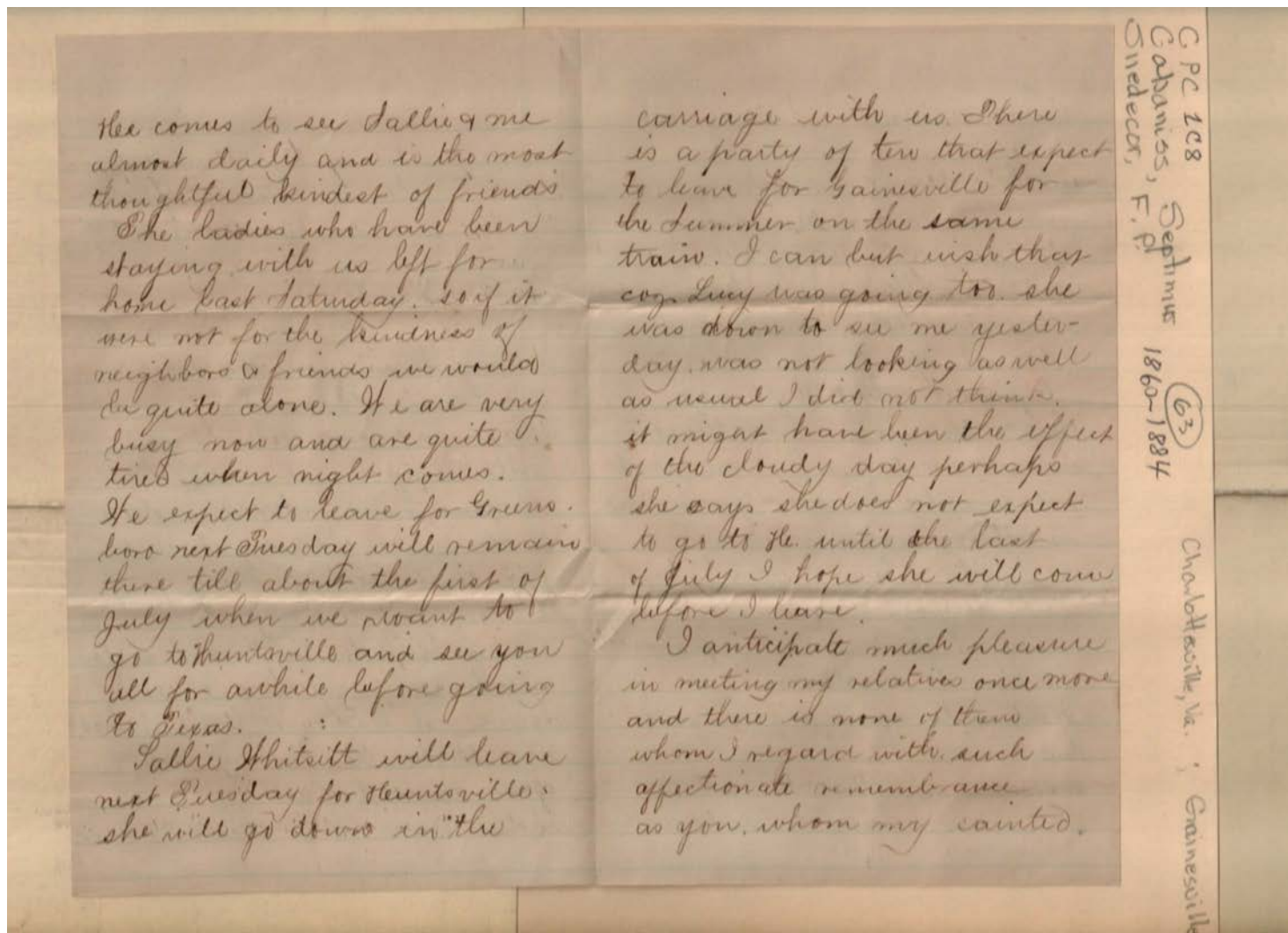

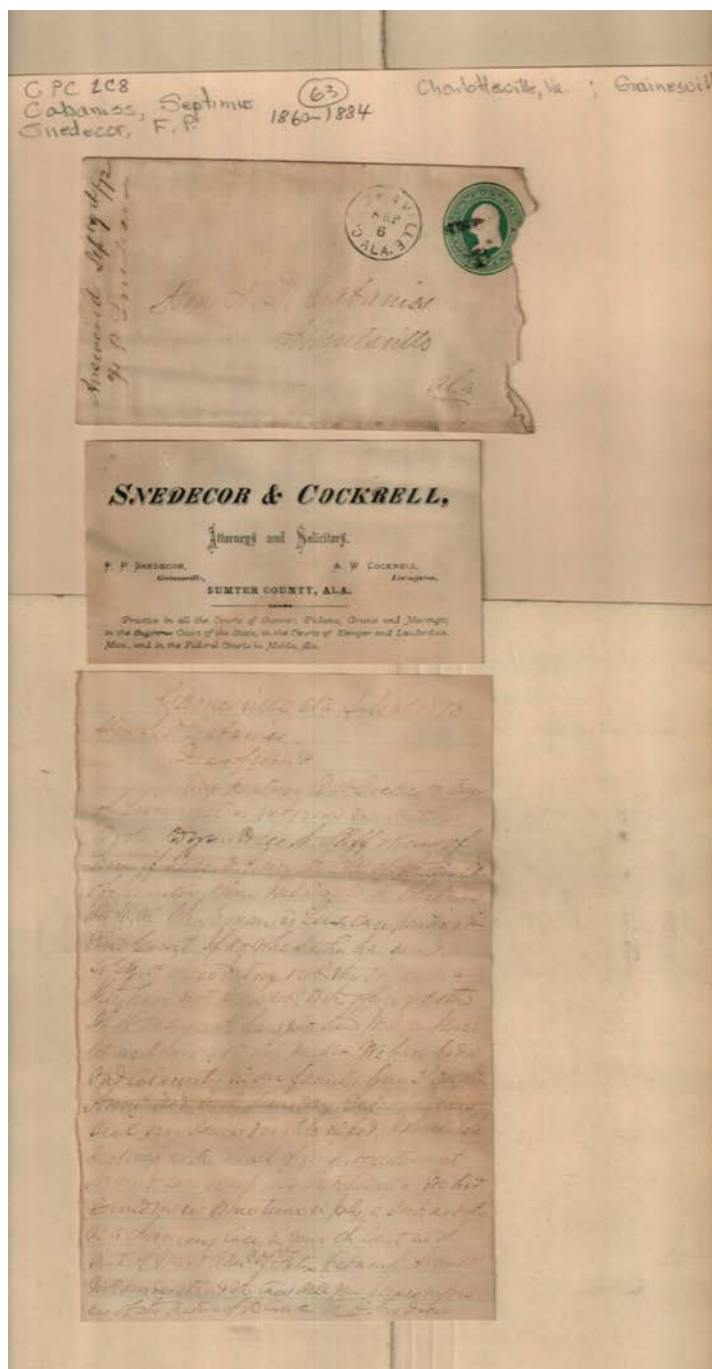

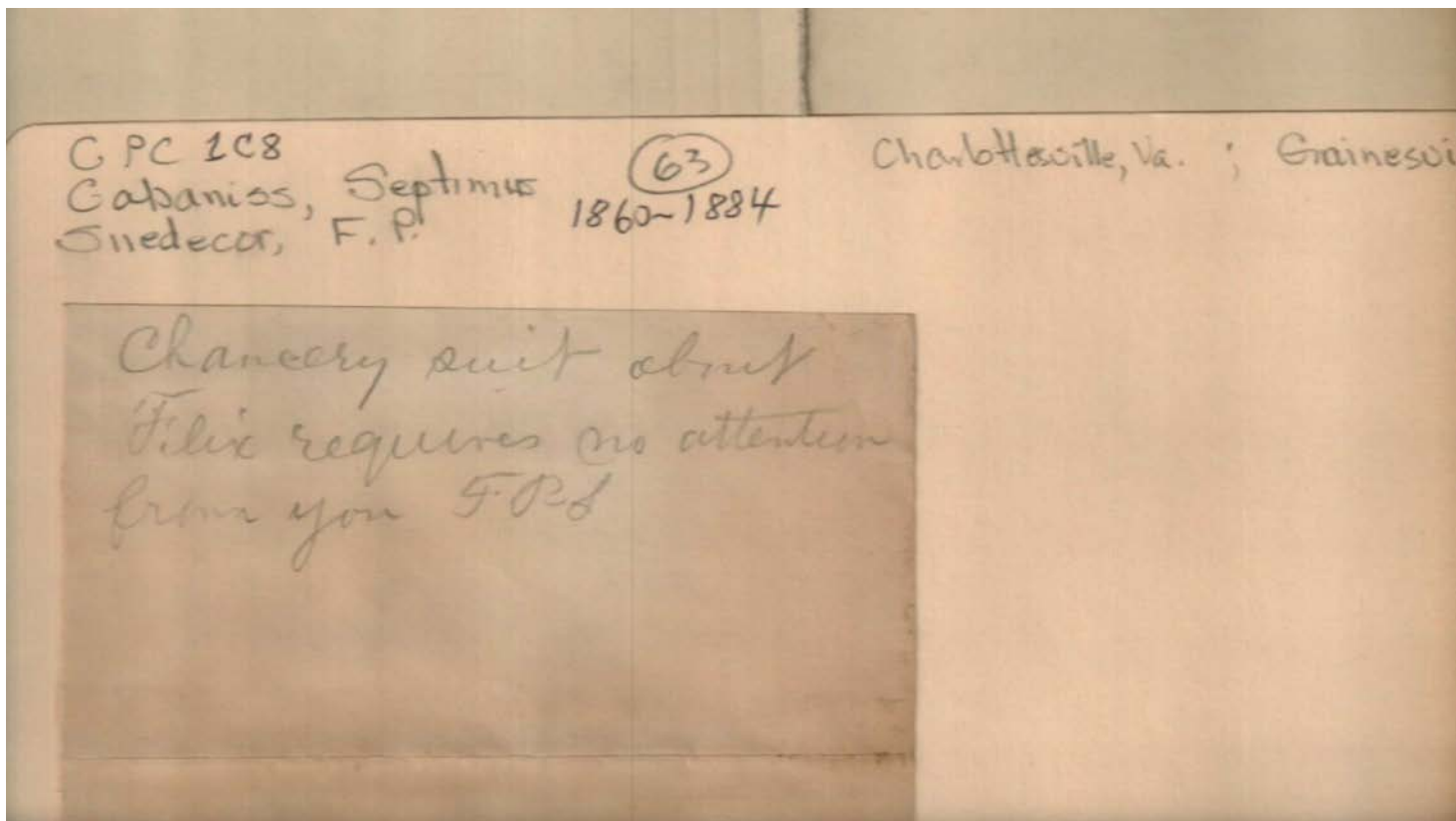
