Dear Father,

Your letter of Sept 21st was received several weeks ago, and was very interesting. It is beyond the province of thought to convey to you, the pleasure, and comfort, that I derive from reading your letters, I often think, what an inexpressible blessing it is, to have a Father who feels so deep an interest and love, for his sons. This is the sixth week of our School. So far we have had a pleasant session. We have sixty pupils enrolled. In your letter you mentioned that it was within the range of possibility, that you might visit Kansas in Nov, if you do, I hope that you will pay me a visit. It would afford me great pleasure, to see you! The difference in the cost via Billings to Topeka, from St Louis, would be only \$2.00. I will send you an old letter with a map of the St Louis and San F. R.R.

him out, the Northern Democracy, will
probably hold a few indignation meetings
as they did in '76. If I should need the Talma
that you mentioned, I will send for it.
but don't want you to go to the expense of hav-
ing it cleaned. At present I am well Love
to all, Please remember me to Mr. Hunt.

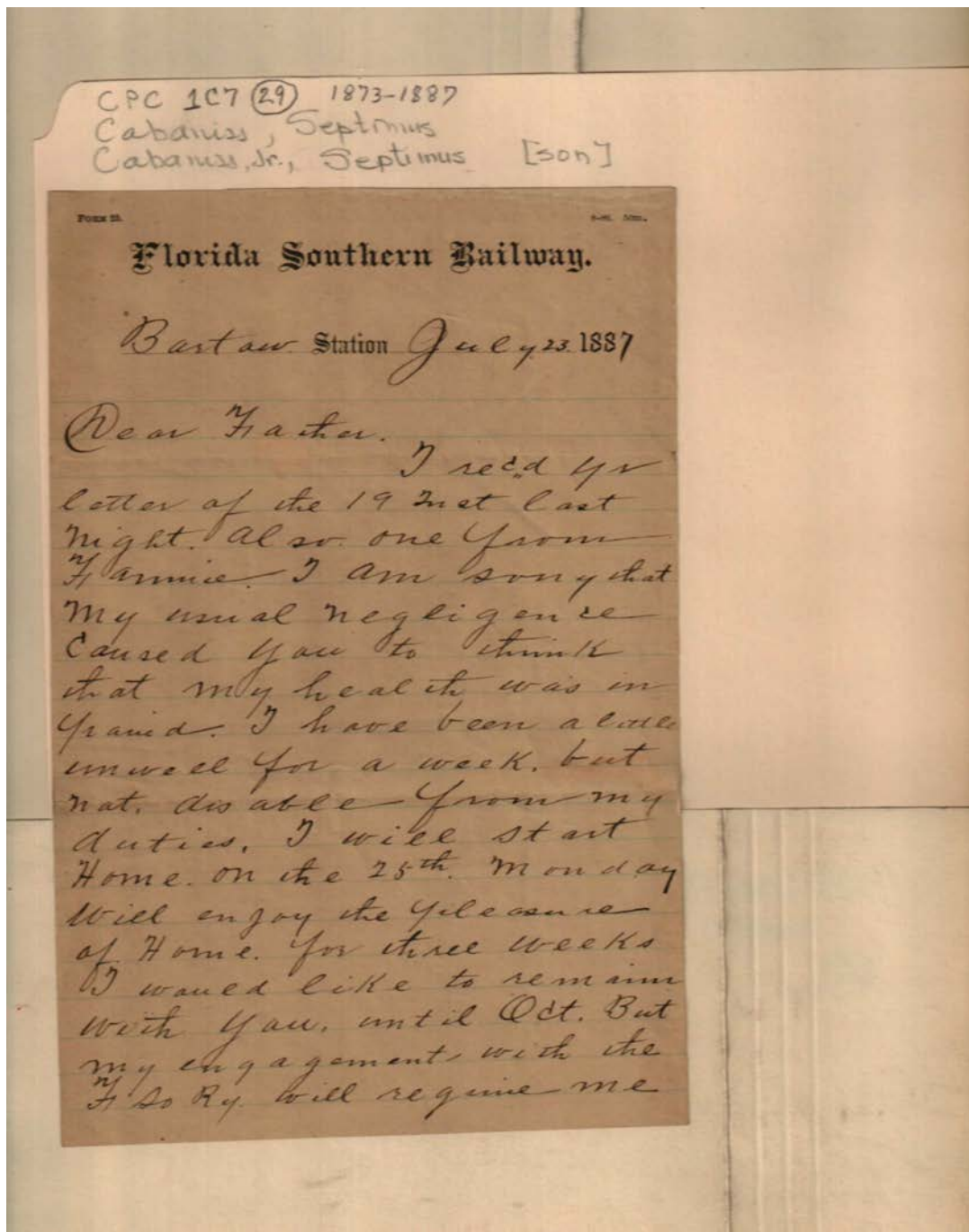

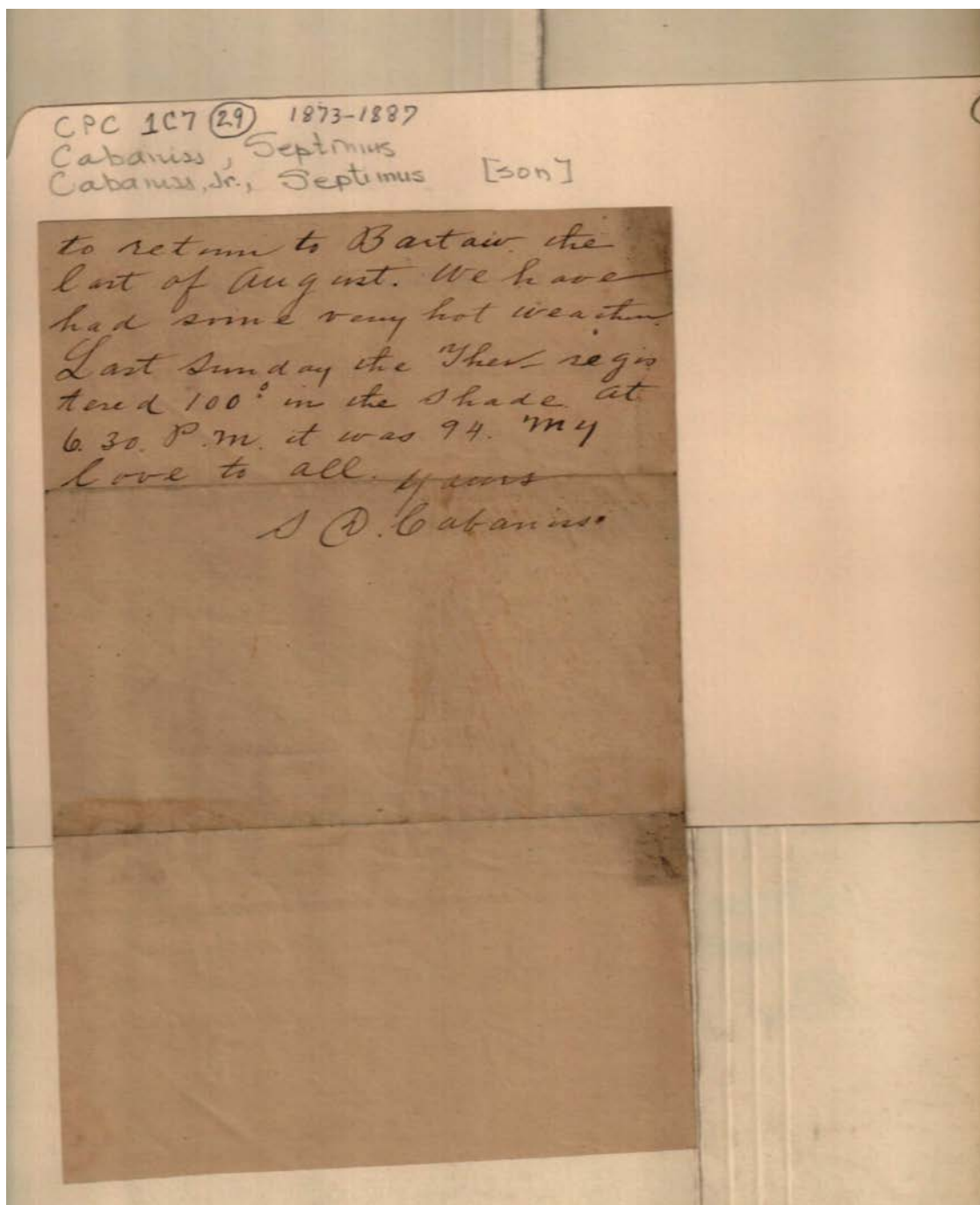
