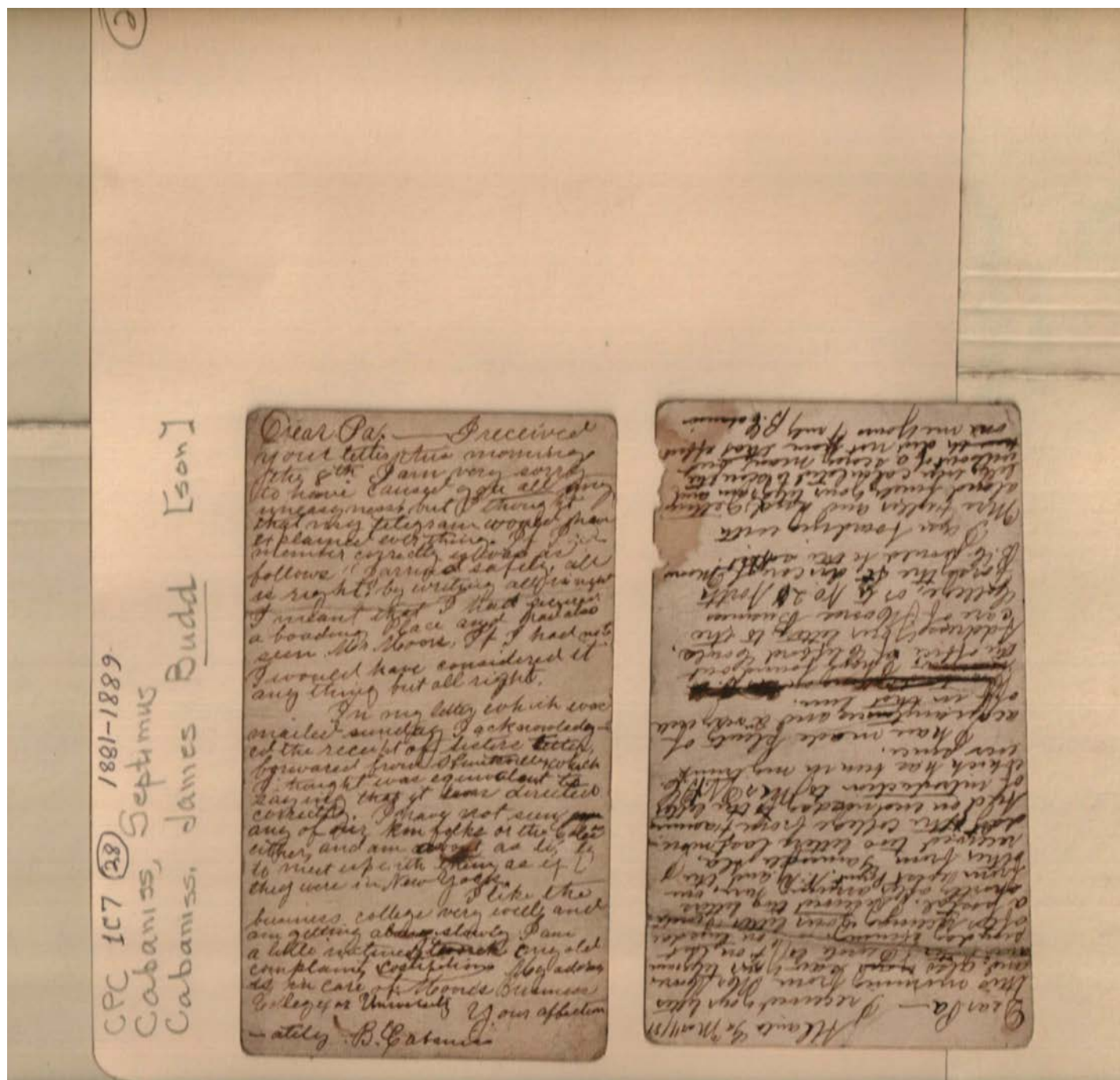

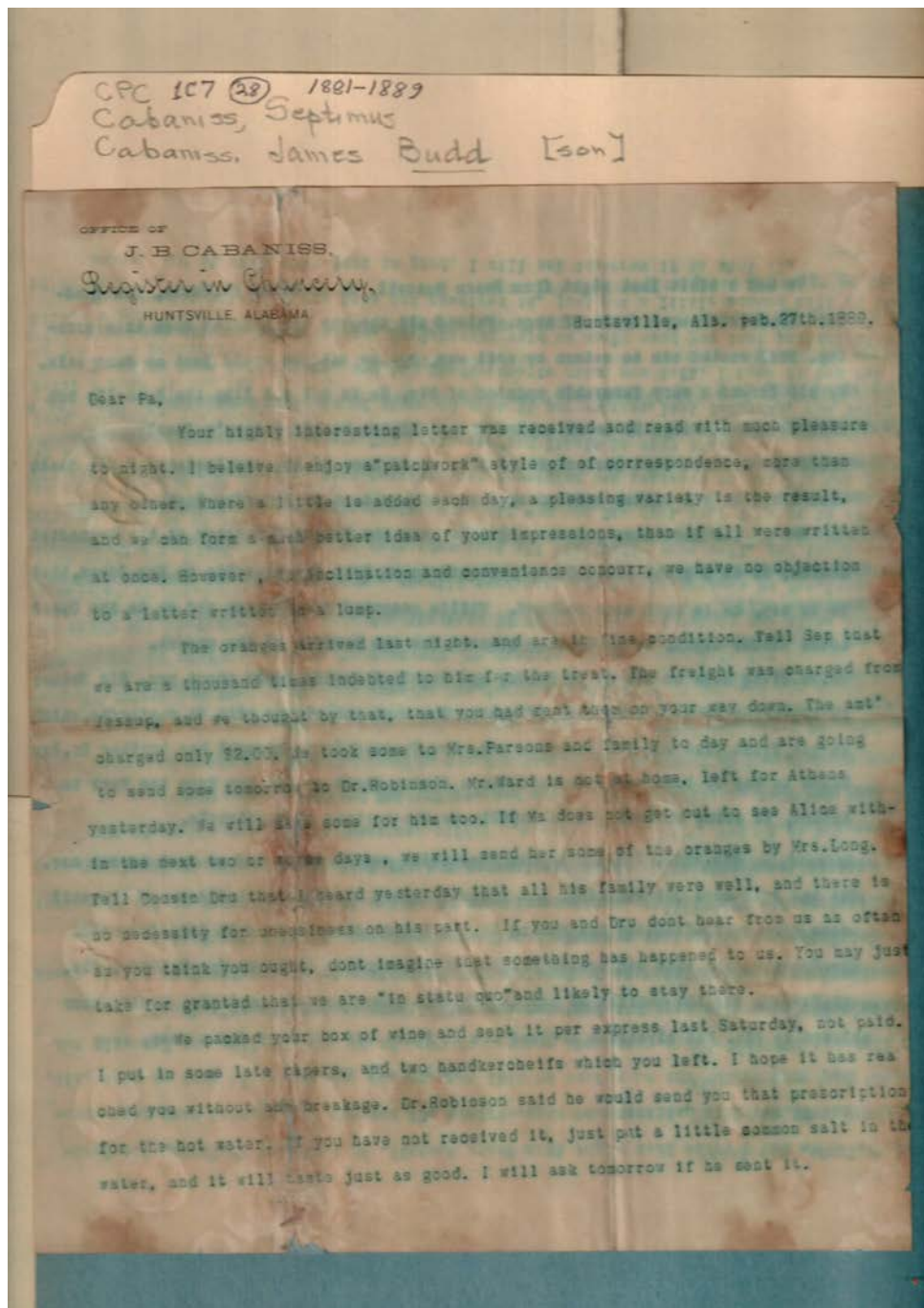

We had a visit last night from Fearn Russell. He assisted Mr. Davis, his land-
lord to drive down a drove of hogs. Walked all the way and started back this morn-
ing. Budd wanted him to return by rail way, but he said he would just as soon walk.
We all formed a very favorable opinion of him. He is not all like the Russells but
much better looking. He bears a strong resemblance to his Mother's family.
Mr. Jimmie Erskine died last night. I have heard none of the particulars of his death
but think it was rather sudden, as I saw him up town on Saturday last.

The boys have gone to night to hear the Rev. W. Culpepper at the Methodist
church. He is a great revivalist, and said to be just the opposite to Sam Jones, that
is to say, he is much more refined. Willie escorted Mrs. Clemens and me to the Opera
house Monday night, to an amateur concert for the benefit of the church.
Mr. W. C. Long came to see us on Sunday and inquired particularly about you. His Mother
is beginning to take ill again. She went out riding with us yesterday, which
is the first time she has ventured out. Mrs. Tancred's sister brought her brother Dr. Roy
Brown to see us last week. He paid her a flying visit on his way from New York to
Auburn, is going to settle in Nashville as the partner of Dr. Nichols.

Feb. 28th. I heard to day that Alice was in town and so went to see her.
She had just gone out shopping, but I saw Mrs. Long who said that Alice and the chil-
dren were well. Visitors are coming in, so I must close with much love from all.
Mrs. Parsons says that her cousin Mr. Sam Perkins expects to leave for Orlando, Fla.
on Monday, for the benefit of his health. She hopes you may meet him, during your
sojourn in Fla. His physician advised him to leave off business for a year.

We are all well. Love from all.
