We have stopped here to pass the night. Our party consists of Mr Robinson of Detroit, Col. Steele of Emporia, Willie Pierce, Robert Johnson, the teamster and myself.

Robert & the teamster will sleep in the wagon; the rest of us are at the Hotel. We expect to leave early tomorrow and hope to reach Camp Sunday or Monday next.

Mr Robinson is a cultured gentleman, going out to look at the country and to have a week's sport.

Mr Spears son (about 19 years of age) will return from Newton to Topeka & go with Col Johnson by way of the R.P.R.R. Col Johnson will probably arrive at camp about the same time we reach it.

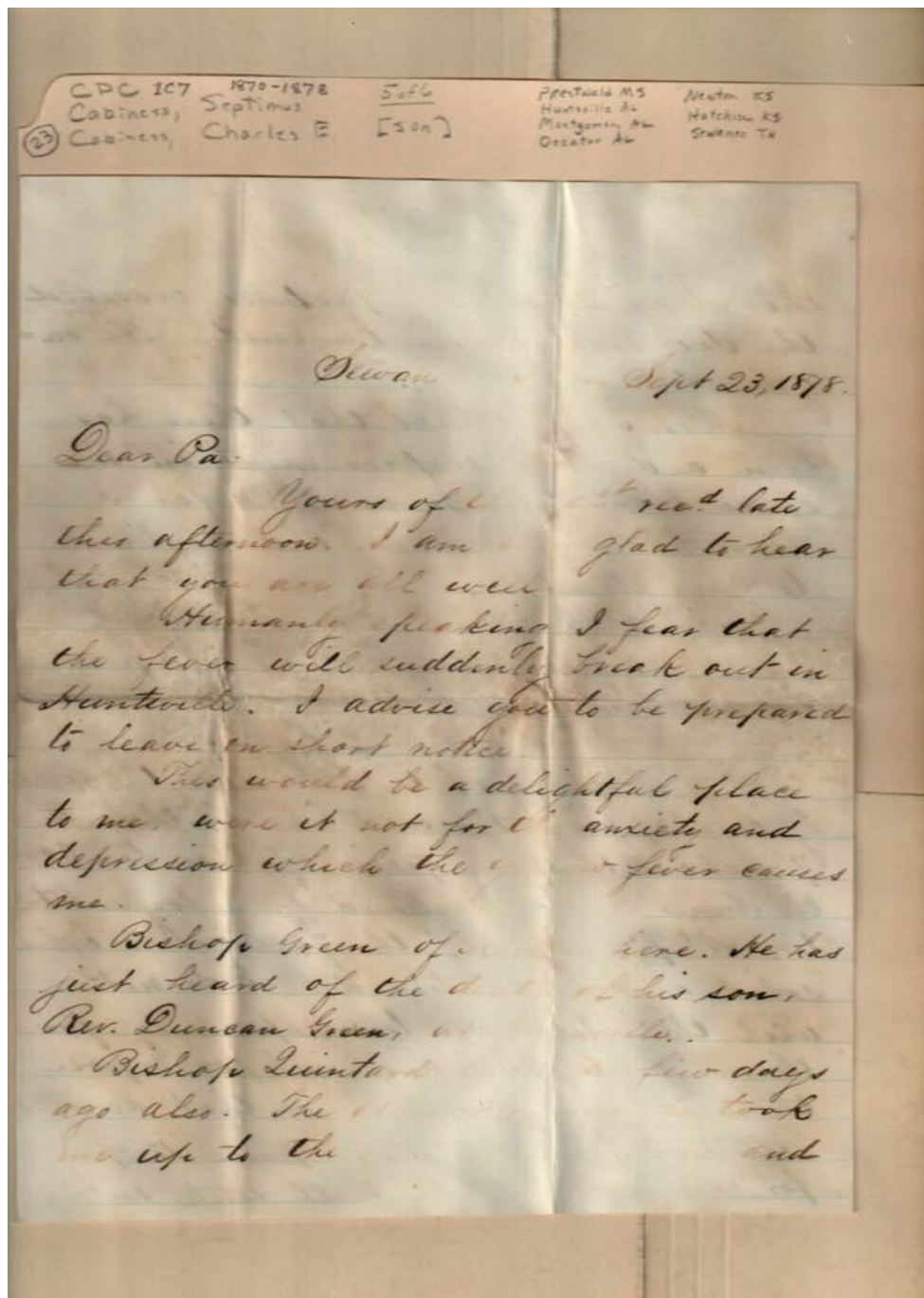

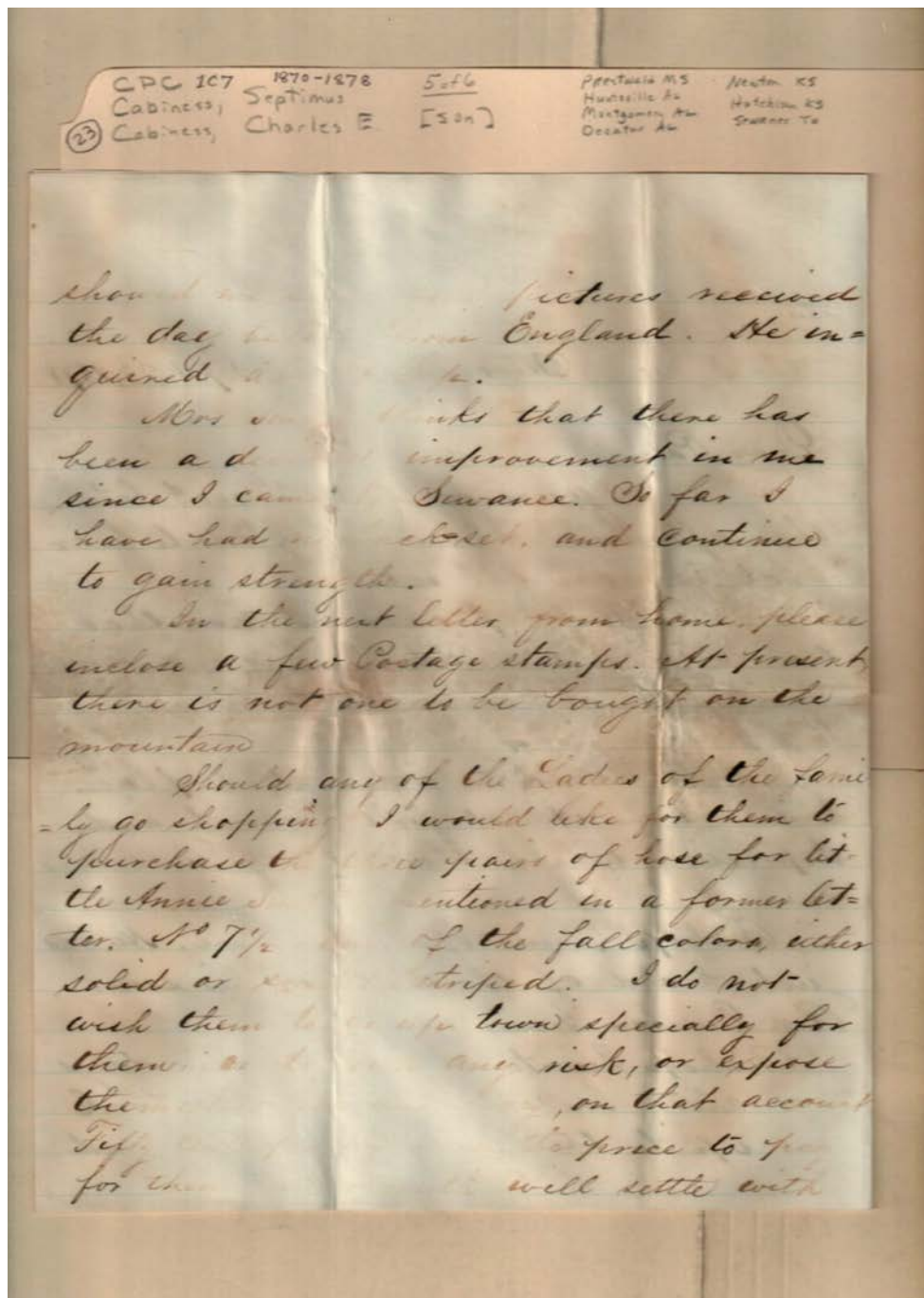

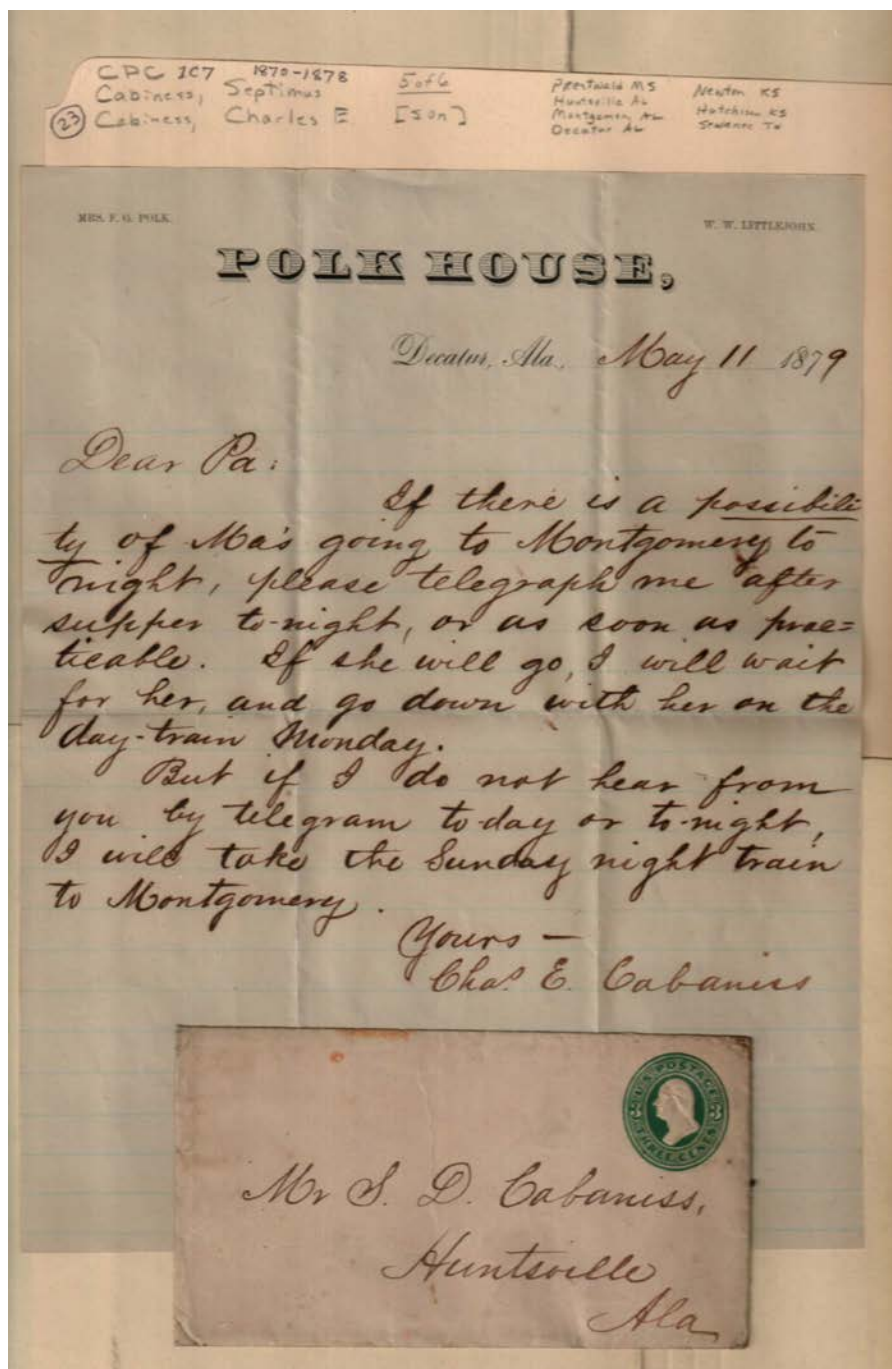
