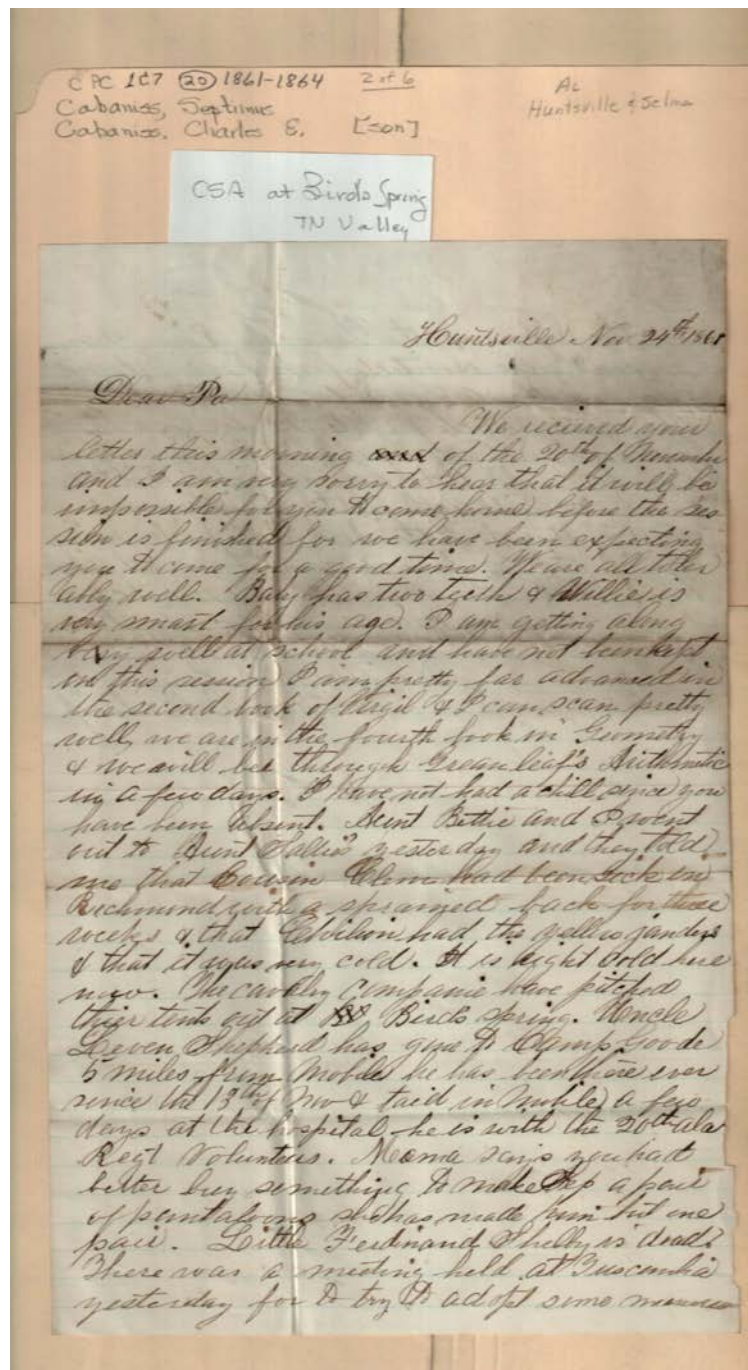

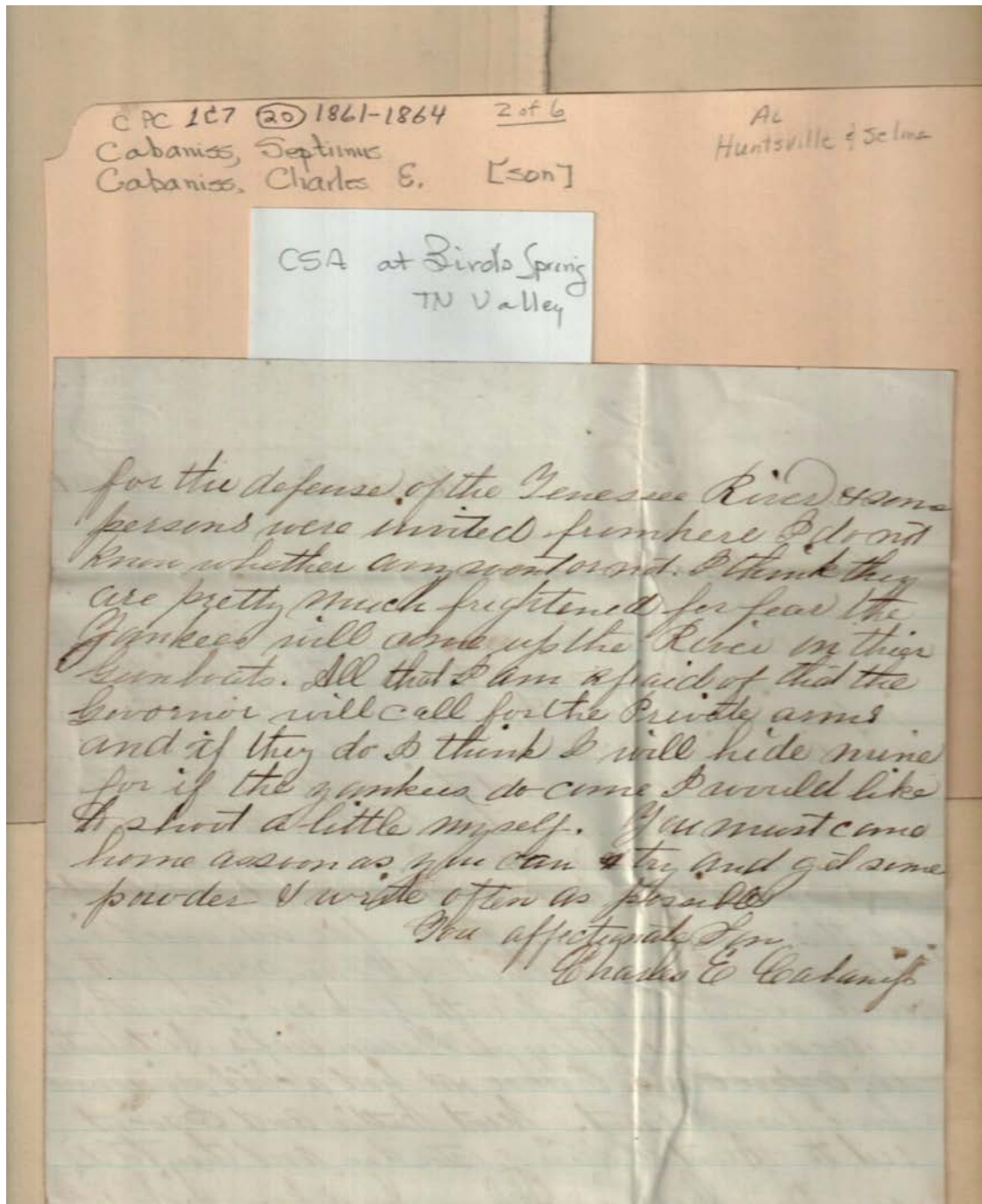

 I received your letter of the 23^d inst. yesterday & yours also of the 19th to day. I have written three letters to you but I have not received them yet. I am very well & hope you are recovered of your illness. Mr. Coltart told me that the bag of summer clothes was left at Phillips' Mills, the place where Mr. Scott is staying 15 miles the other side of Marion. I have not heard of the shoes you got Tom to make for me since you left. Uncle Abner has had the Gray mare put to Dr. Blevins's Stallion, the pony we had taken to is the Commissary & Porter Mason's Department who inspected about twice a month. The Inspector ^{detached man} ~~has~~ ^{has} ~~been~~ ^{has} our Commissary to be examined today, & both of them were ordered back to their commands, he said that my papers were good, I would willingly exchange my papers with them for their ability to serve in the field. Erskine Blevins has got back from Augusta and I hope to see him soon.

was in town I have been very uneasy
about you, afraid that you were sick
& that the Yankees would catch you

Selma Oct 12th 1864

Dear Pa

I received your letter this morning by Capt. Sommerville, & I am very sorry to hear that you had a chill. I expected as much when you left Mrs. Blevins to walk in town in the Sun. & I am very glad that was no more. I am glad to hear of Mrs. Noble's death. You must stay in Montgomery until you are perfectly well. Capt. Sommerville says you must stay by a guard. There is an order from the Major General which says that all Detailed men must go to the Camp of Instruction to be examined by a select Board of Examiners to be sent out again, so perhaps you may see me in Montgomery soon. I have just heard any talk at the left side of your letter, the order is in the hands of the 7th inst. I don't think there will be any difficulty for me to get Detailed. Capt. S. said that they would not. I came was having a chill this morning. but I'm sure it is all over now. I am glad you think that I will have no more. I will have lots plenty of time in my chill days. I be certain to stay until you are well.
