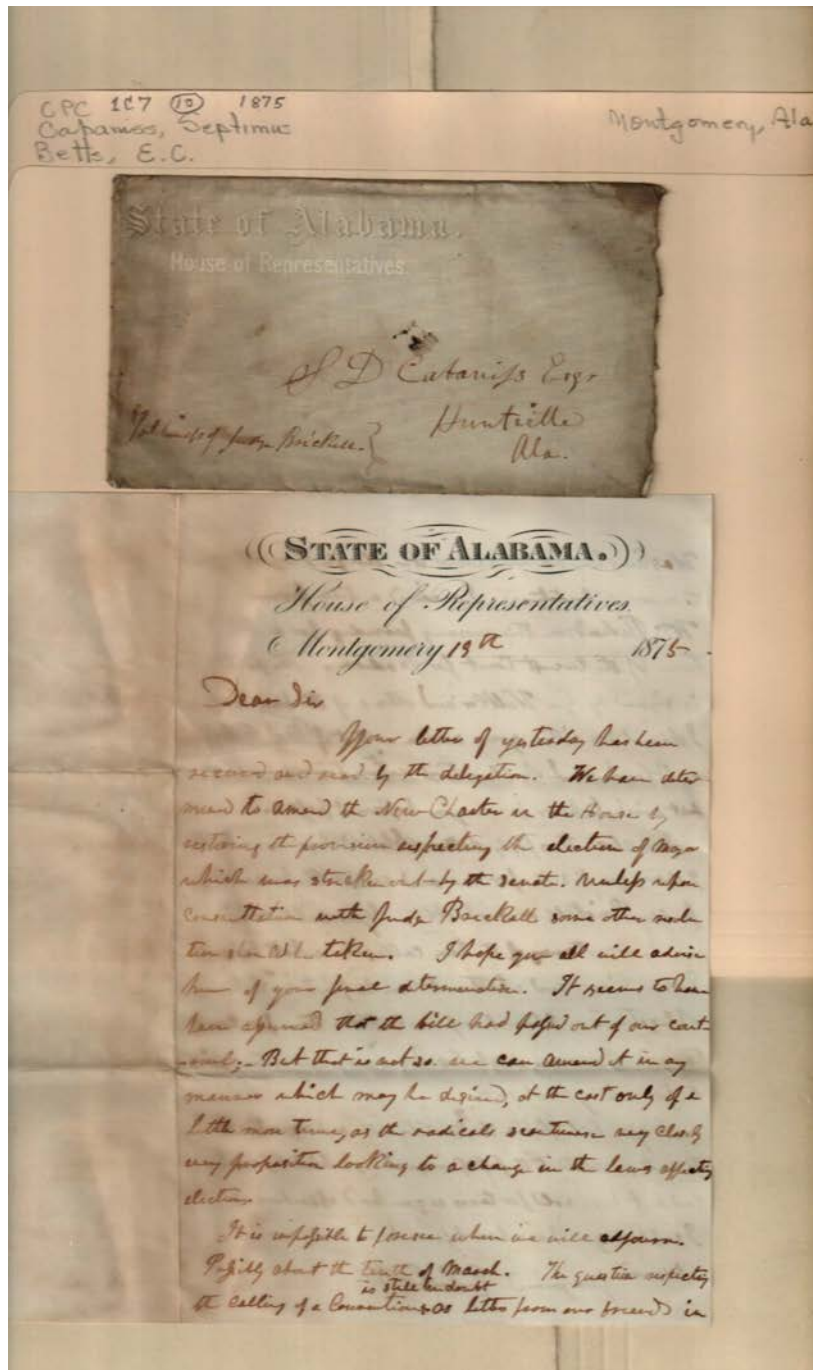

Washington advise against it though I myself see
to reason to hesitate. I received a bill from
Wm Richardson this morning forwarding for a third
time of the Circuit Court for Madison. The petition
is signed by Gen Walker and others of the bar, but
I do not see either your name or that of Prof Robinson
or Ward. I shall introduce it tomorrow but
do wish to hear from you before it passes.

I enclose two fifty dollar State Obligations, which
I desire you to sell for me and remit the proceeds by
bank check or a check. You will oblige
me by ascertaining of the tax collector what balance
I owe him and whether it can be paid in "State
Obligations" as I hear he refuses to take them for county
taxes. I was one of only two Democrats who voted against
the bill requiring him to do so.

I gave Col. Clopton the 20th obligation and requested him
to write you relative to the property in question, which I found
had not been sold for taxes as you had apprehended.
I suppose you have heard from him on the subject.
I remain your friend E.C. Betts.
