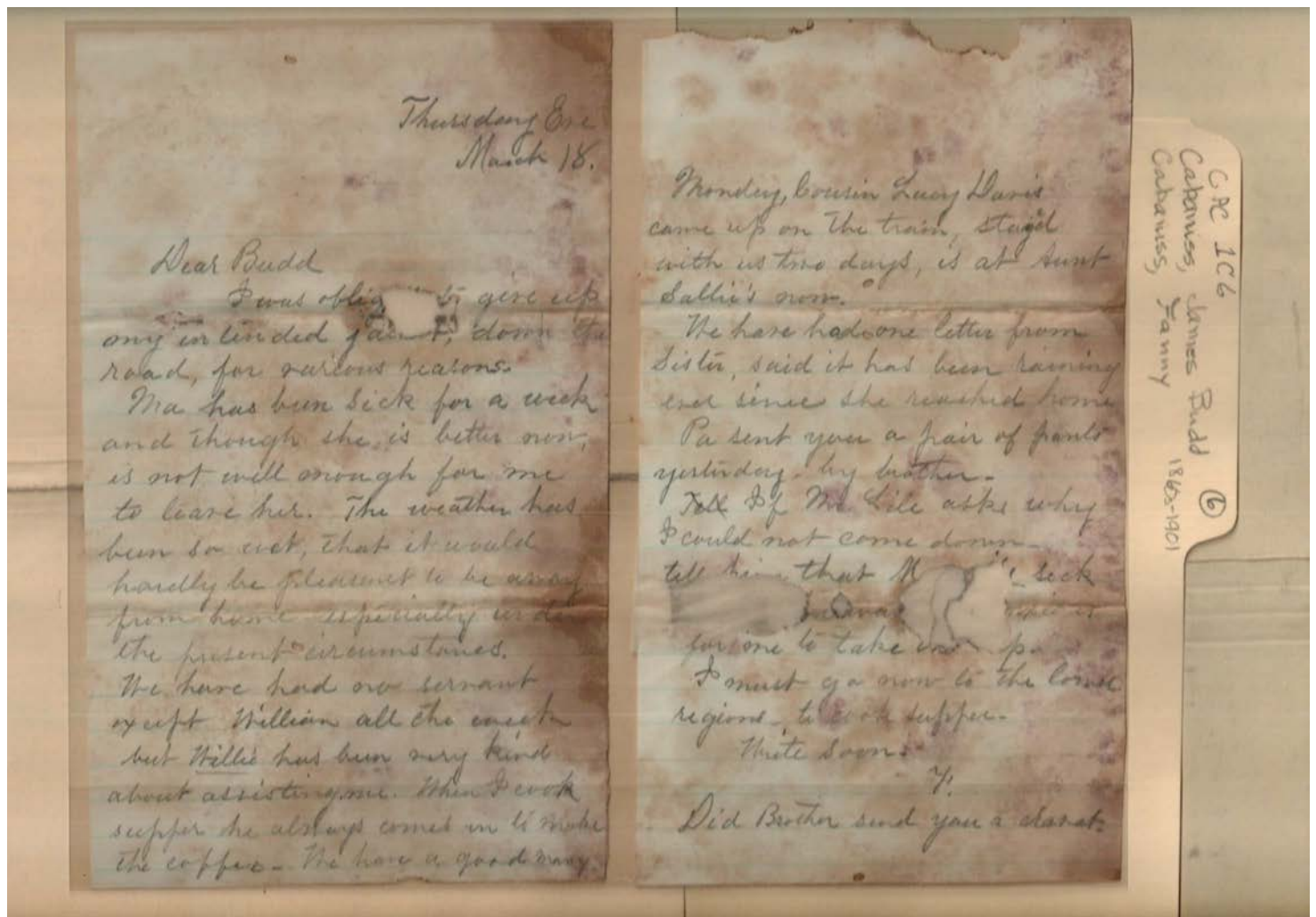

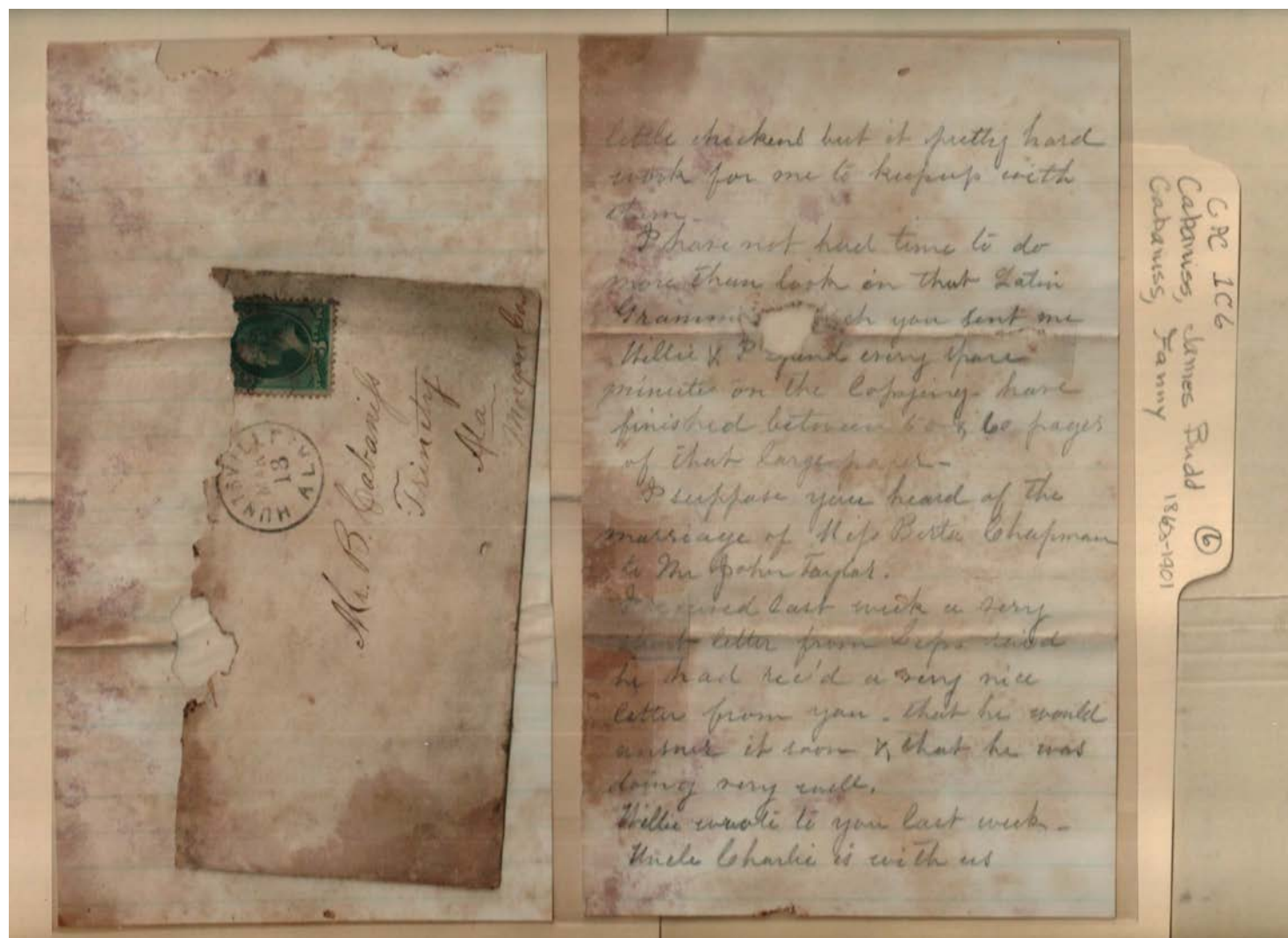

My Dear Budd,
