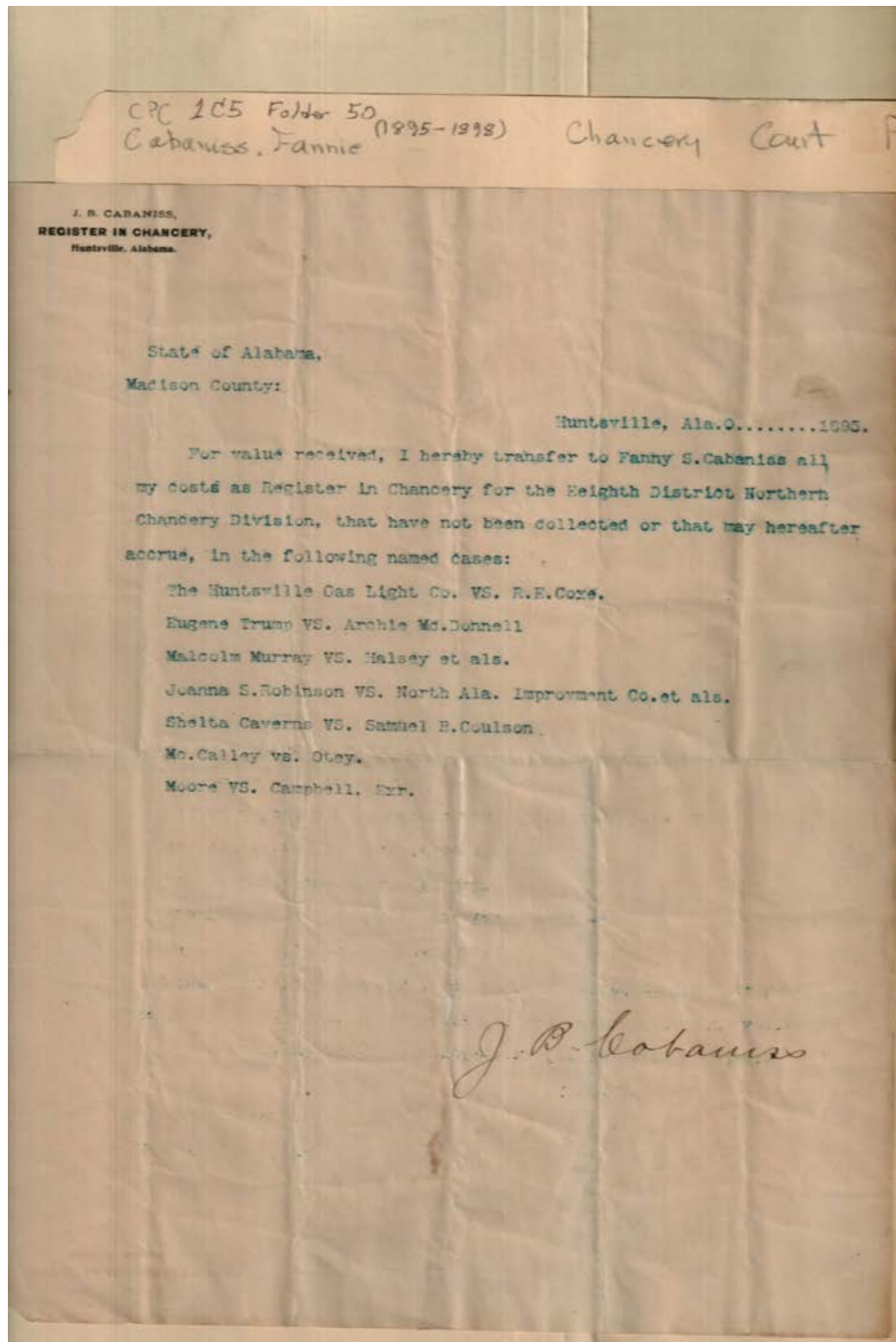

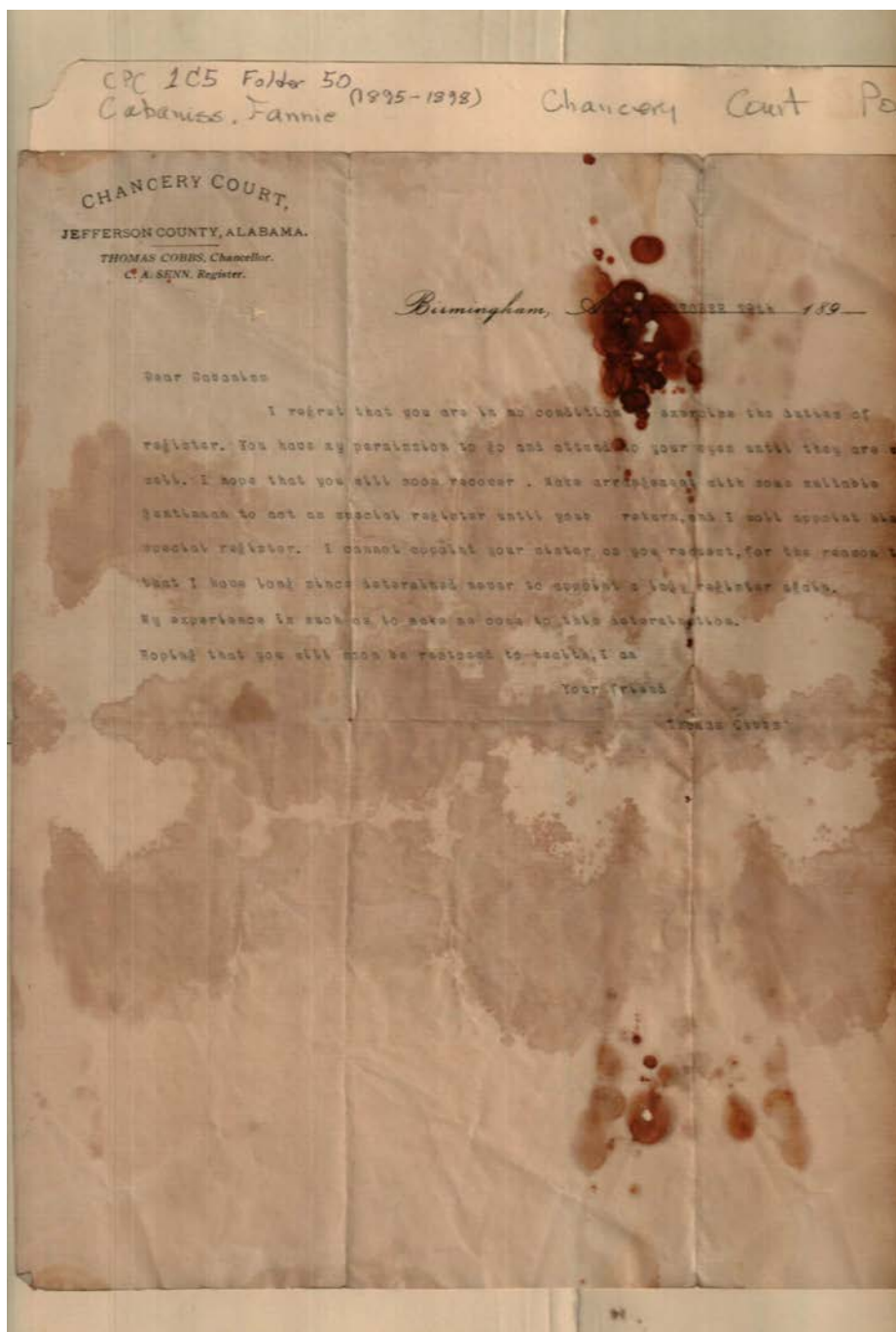

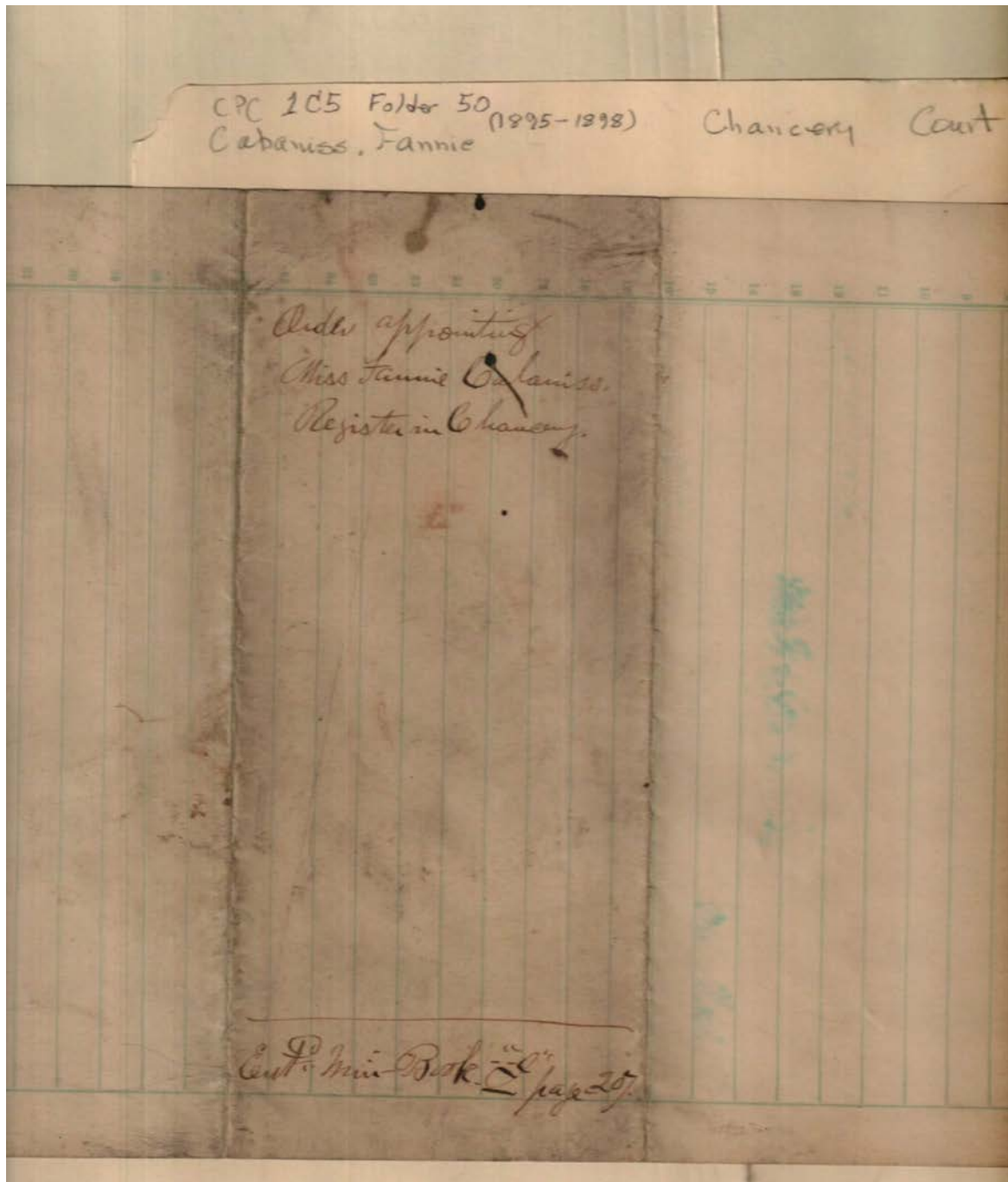

fore ordered, adjudged and
decree that Miss Fannie Cab-
aniss be, and she is hereby
appointed Register in Chan-
cery for the said County of Mad-
ison, Alabama, for the unex-
pired term of said Jas. B.
Cabaniss, upon taking the
oath of office required by
law and executing a bond
in the sum of Seven Thousand
and Five Hundred Dollars,
payable and conditioned

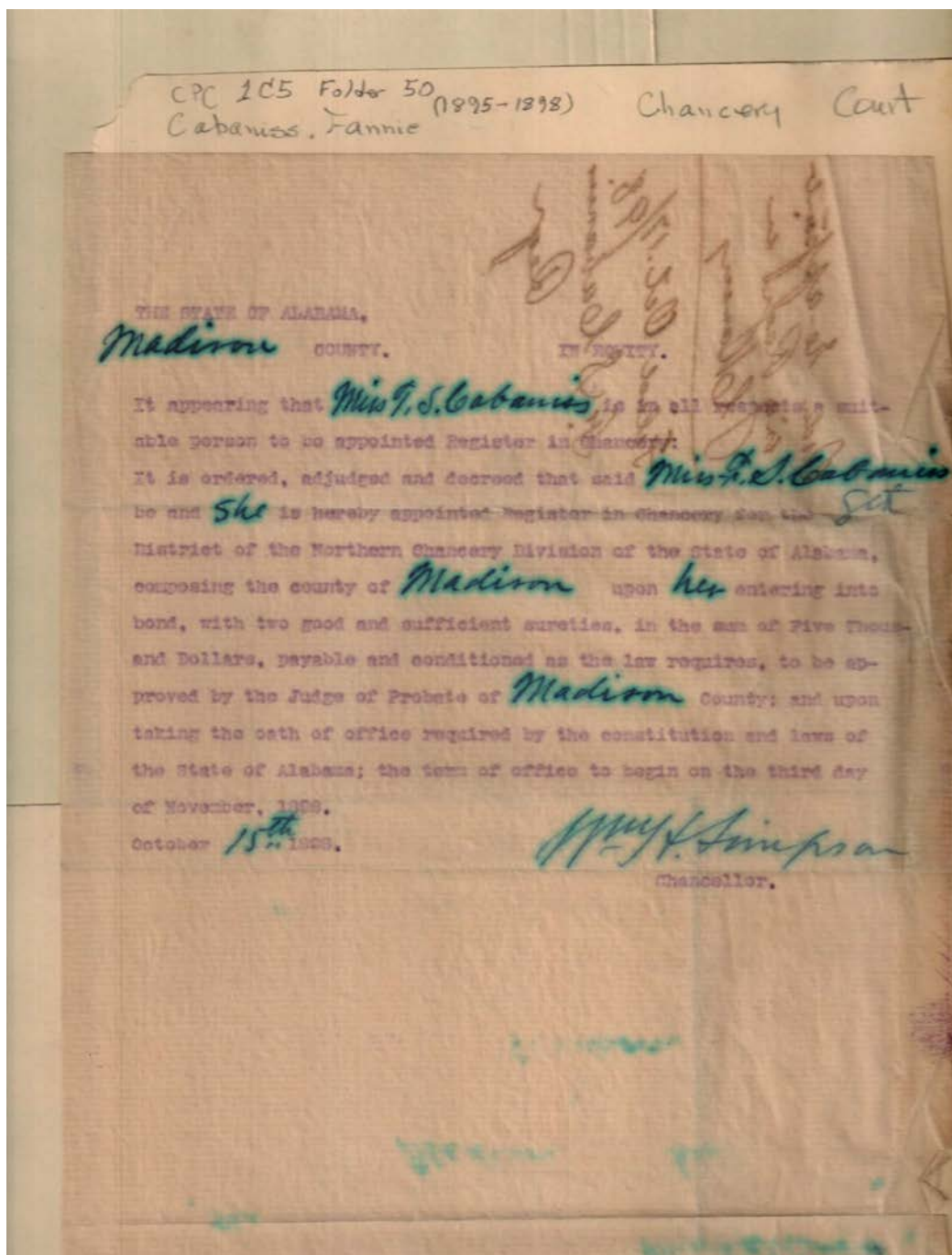

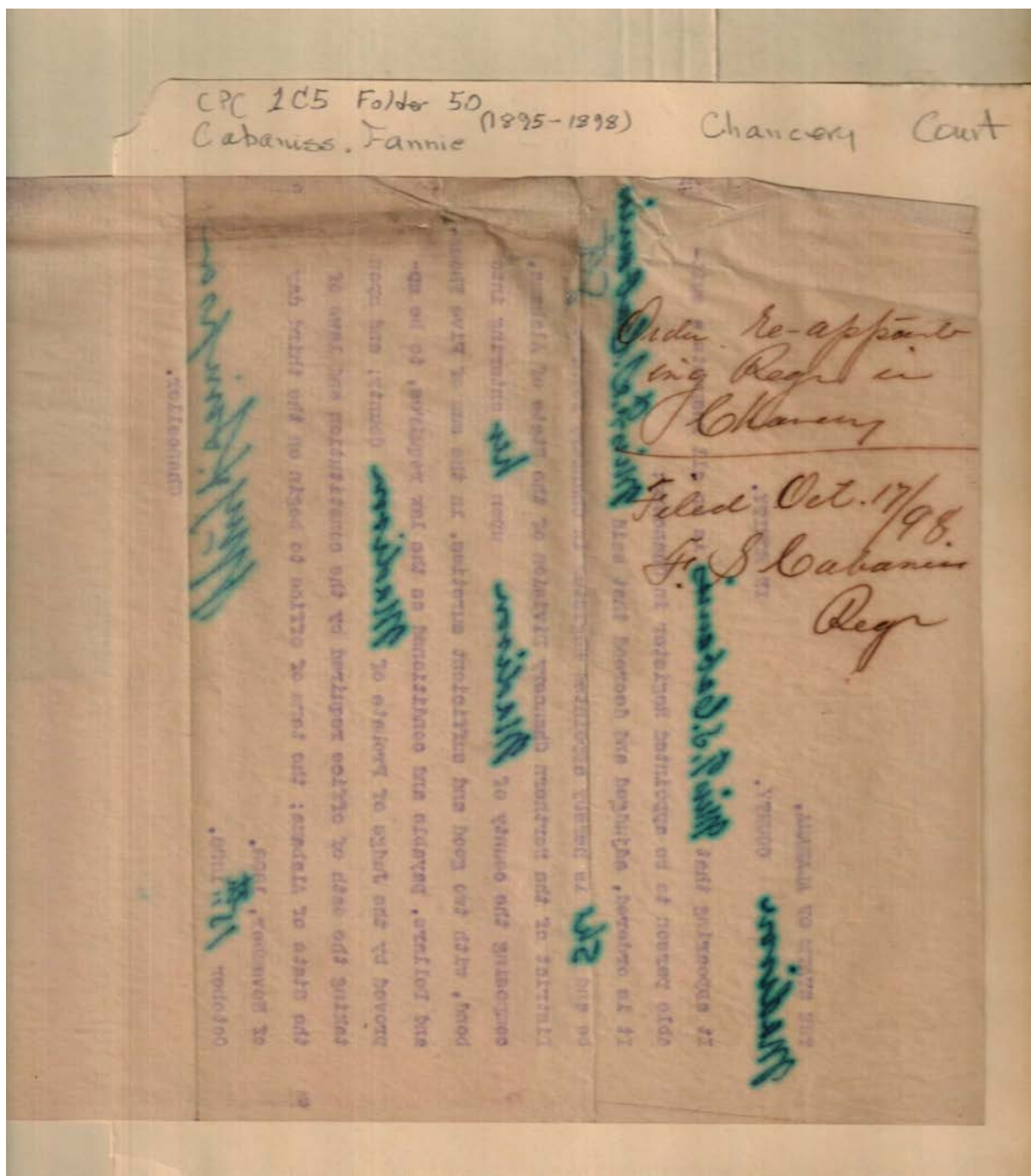
